FRISCO, TX - After hitting just two home runs through the first 10 games of the 2022 season, the Naturals exploded on Wednesday for three homers as they beat Frisco 7-2 to even the series at one game each.

The first five runs of the game all scored on the Naturals' three long balls - totaling 1,367 feet worth of home runs. First baseman Robbie Glendinning connected on his first of the year in the second inning, a solo shot that traveled 457 feet and hit off the video board in left-center field to put the Naturals up 1-0. In the third inning, center fielder Nick Loftin drove his first of the season over the fence, a 444-foot two-run shot that landed past the outfield berm and pushed the Naturals back ahead at the time, to 3-1 Seuly Matias added insurance in the fifth inning. The Naturals right fielder connected on a 466-foot

- two-run homer that completely left the stadium, Matias' first of the season that stretched the score to 5-2. Loftin, Matias and Glendinning each had two hits and each drove in multiple runs. Six Naturals hitters scored a run, while seven recorded hits and all nine reached base at least once, with six collective walks.
- Drew Parrish earned his first win of the season the first win recorded by a Naturals starting pitcher this year - and improved his record to 1-1, allowing just one earned run on one hit across 5.0 innings, while striking out four ... right-handers Yefri Del Rosario and Zach Willeman combined for the final four innings, keeping Frisco off the board without a chance to come back ... Del Rosario struck out two and stretched his season to 8.1 scoreless innings across three appearances.

The Naturals are 4-4 all-time when playing on April 21

On April 21, 2016, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Tulsa Drillers, 5-2 at Arvest Ballpark behind a 5-run fifth inning. Third baseman Hunter Dozier led the way offensively, going 2-for-4 with a double, run scored and two runs batted in. In the third inning, **Bubba Starling** singled home **Ramon Torres**, then Dozier singled home Adalberto Mondesi and Starling. After Dozier and Orlando Calixte pulled off a double steal, Zane Evans doubled them both in to cap the five-run frame.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, nine players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher **Tyler Cropley**, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- RHP Alec Marsh started Tuesday and will go ahead on Sunday, April 24th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP Drew Parrish tarted yesterday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa starts Friday, April 22nd, for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** starts Saturday, April 23rd for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in Baseball America's 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher"</u> in the system.
- SS Maikel Garcia is rated as having the "Best Infield Arm" in the system.
- RF Seuly Matias is rated as having the <u>"Best Outfield Arm"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa is rated as having the <u>"Best Control</u>" in the system.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

NOTES

Shortstop Maikel Garcia drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and despite having not drawn just one walk in his last five games and 25 plate appearances, is still second in the Texas League in base on balls with 11.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on Wednesday 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 52 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 25 times, for a cool .481 on-base percentage (14 hits + 11 walks) ... his OBP ranks fifth in the league and is the best among gualified Naturals hitters ... he is the only Natural that has reached base in all 11 games this season and one of just two players in the Texas League with a 11-game reached base streak this year, along with San Antonio's Esteury Ruiz.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leader in many categories, including 5th in on-base percentage (.481), 7th in hits (14), 2nd in walks (11) and 3rd in steals (6).

STREAKY STARTS

While Maikel Garcia is the only Naturals hitter that has reached base at least once in all 11 games the team has played, he is not the only Natural that has reached base in every game they have played. 39 41

- SS Maikel Garcia has reached base in all <u>11 games</u> he's played started the season hitting .341 (14-for-41) with 2 doubles and 11 walks, giving him a .481 on-base percentage.
- INF Robbie Glendinning has reached base in all eight games he's played started the season hitting .240 (6-for-25) with 1 double, 1 home run and 8 walks, giving him a .441 on-base percentage.
- Prior to Tuesday, INF/OF Nate Eaton and 2B Michael Massey had both reached base in all eight games they'd played this season and OF Tucker **Bradley** had reached base in all six games he'd played to start the season, but all three of those streaks ended Tuesday as Eaton, Massey and Bradley all failed to reach base ... pinch-hitting in the 9th inning and striking out, Bradley's team-best six-game hitting streak ended as well, though Garcia is only one behind him right now at five games.

SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!

On April 9, right-handed pitcher **Collin Snider** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: Scott Barlow, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).

 - Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.


