JUMBO SHRIMP WIN ON BALK OFF

Despite multi-hit games by Jake Mangum, Jordan Groshans and Jerar Encarnacion, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell short to the Norfolk Tides 3-1 Thursday night. Colton Cowser (6) sent the first pitch of the game from Jumbo Shrimp (18-16) starter Devin Smeltzer (0-1) over the right-field wall to give the Tides (26-3) an early 1-0 advantage. Jacksonville tied the game in the bottom of the first but Norfolk added two runs later in the game and never looked back.

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 18 of their last 25 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 62 runs, 54 earned, on 114 hits (8.9 H/9) in 115.1 innings for a 4.21 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registering just 85 punchouts (6.6 K/9). However, they have only issued 41 walks during this run, a rate of 3.2 per nine innings.

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late: Jacksonville has registered 134 free passes over the last 26 games since April 11, a figure that ranks third in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 13.0 percent of their plate appearances. The Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games, Jacksonville's 11 walks on April 30 were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

JERARASSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion has been on a tear since the season's second week. Over his last 27 games dating back to April 7, the native of Bayaguana in the Dominican Republic is 30for-101 at the plate, slashing .297/.427/.505/.932 with nine doubles, four homers, 18 RBIs and 23 walks. Encarnacion places amongst the league leaders in several categories this year, including doubles (T-12th, 9), walks (T-14th, 23) and RBIs (T-16th, 25).

WAVE RUNNERS

Last year Jacksonville struggled against their International League East foes, going 39-45. However, against Norfolk, Jacksonville went 11-10, winning the Navy Town Showdown. Although the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .250/.327/.403/.730 with 21 home runs and 93 RBIs, the pitching staff struggled. The Jumbo Shrimp hurlers compiled a 5.03 ERA was the third-worst ERA among 2022 opponents. Norfolk hit .233 against Jacksonville pitchers, plating 102 ER in 182.1 innings. The Tides' 21 home runs against Jumbo Shrimp pitchers was the third-most hit against the pitching staff out of the 10 teams Jacksonville faced in 2022. The 2021 Navy Town Showdown series also featured Jacksonville's record-setting game where the offense put up 20 runs on June 4, 2022, the most in a game since 2005.

KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, Charles Leblanc went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot at the plate since. Over the last 11 games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 14-for-41 (.341) with two doubles, home run, five RBIs and a remarkable 15 walks for a .518 on-base percentage. On the campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (27) nearly as much he has struck out (28). Leblanc ranks second in the International League in walk percentage (22.0 percent) and tied for fifth in total walks (27). His swingingstrike rate of 7.4 percent is tied for th 19th-lowest out of the circuit's 133 qualified hitters.

'PFN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. That stretch saw the club's bullpen fan 35 batters (10.7 K/9) but walk 23 hitters (7.1 BB/9). However, in the 13 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 19 runs, 13 earned, on 25 hits (3.5 H/9) in 64.1 innings for a 1.81 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 68 strikeouts (9.5 K/9) against 38 walks (5.3 BB/9) during this recent run. Jacksonville's scoreless inning streak reached 14.1 innings before Joesph Ortiz homered with two outs in the eighth against RHP Nic Enright.

ABOUT RONALD

-Before coming to the United States, Bolaños played for Mayabeque of the Cuban National Series. He signed with the San Diego Padres as an International free agent on August 11, 2016.

-The Padres selected Bolaños' contract and promoted him to the major leagues for the first time on September 2, 2019. He made his major leagues debut on Spetember 3rd vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks, allowing two runs over six innings pitched.

-On July 16, 2020, Bolaños and outfielder Francy Cordero were traded to the Kansas City Royals in exchange for LHP Tim Hill.

-On April 16, 2023, Bolaños signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

-Entering the 2023 season, Bolaños has pitched in 18 major league games, including five starts with Kansas City and San Diego. In those games, he is 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA. Over 48.0 innings, he has yielded 49 hits and struck out 43 against 29 walks.

-When he was signed by San Diego, the then-19-year-old was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 20 international prospect in the 2016 class and ranked by Baseball America as the fourth-best Cuban pitcher available.

-In 2014, he played in the COPABE 18U Pan American Championship in Mexico.

-The Cuban-native came up as an outfielder before converting to a pitcher.

2023 SEASON

2022 SEASON

-With Triple-A Omaha, went 0-1 with a 3.52 ERA in four starts. Over 15.1 innings, yielding 17 hits and struck out 16 against four walks. However, over 24 relief apperences with the Storm Chasers, he posted an 0-3 record with a 7.63 ERA. In those relief apperences, he allowed 42 hits in 26.2 innings and struck out 18 against 14 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Bolaños began the year with Triple-A Omaha and made four starts before joining the Royals on June 4th. He closed the season with the Storm Chasers.

2020 SEASON

- Made a pair of starts, July 26 at Cleveland and Aug. 1 vs. the White Sox... Took the loss in his first start, allowing two unearned runs on three hits and a walk over 2.0 innings.

-Became the third Cuban-born pitcher to start a game for the Royals, joining Onelki García (2017) and Zip Sánchez (1988).
