**LAST TIME OUT:** The New Hampshire Fisher Cats came back from down seven to win 11-8 over the Reading Fightin' Phils in a seven-inning rain-shortened victory on Thursday night. New Hampshire scored 10 runs in the sixth and seventh innings in a come from behind victory. It's their third straight comeback win and it's the largest comeback win in team history. With Reading ahead 8-6 in the bottom of the seventh and the rain continuing to pour, **Damiano Palmegiani** launched a go-ahead three-run home run, his 14<sup>th</sup> home run of the season, to give New Hampshire a 9-8 lead. Another **Will Robertson** RBI double extended the lead and he scored on a wild pitch to make it 11-8 Fisher Cats before inclement weather stopped the game with two outs in the seventh. On the mound, starting right-hander **Michael Dominguez** threw 4.1 innings and struck out four in his home debut and **Adrian Hernandez** picked up the win after 1.1 scoreless innings of relief, including two strikeouts.

**COMEBACK KIDS:** New Hampshire is on a four-game winning streak and yesterday was their third straight comeback win. Prior to last night, the Fisher Cats had never come back from a deficit of six or more runs to win the game in team history. New Hampshire has come back from margins of two, three, and seven in the last three games. The last time New Hampshire won five in a row was from May 4 (Game 2) – May 9 against Harrisburg and Reading this season.

**DRAMATICS BY DAMIANO:** In the pouring rain last night, **Damiano Palmegiani** drove in the go-ahead runs with a three-run homer off the hotel in left-center in the seventh. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect had a five-RBI night, including a two-run double in the sixth. It's Palmegiani's second five-RBI night of the season and both performances have come against Reading. It's his third five-RBI game of his career. He continues to lead the active roster in home runs (14), RBIs (58) and multi-hit games (24).

**STEWARD THE SWIPER:** OF **Steward Berroa** is second in the Eastern League in stolen bases after stealing his 40<sup>th</sup> on the season Wednesday, one shy of Portland's Corey Rosier for the league lead. The last Fisher Cat to lead the league in stolen bags was former Fisher Cat Anthony Gose, who stole a team-record 70 bases in 2011.

**HIGH DRIVES FROM HIRALDO:** After recording just six RBIs all of July, IF **Miguel Hiraldo** has driven in seven RBIs in his last five games to start the month of August. The 22-year-old has hits in seven of eight games this month and is on a five-game hit streak after doubling in a run last night.

**RICKY RETURNS:** LHP **Ricky Tiedemann** makes his return to the Fisher Cats after spending the last three months on the injured list with a bicep injury. The Blue Jays No. 1 prospect made two rehab starts with Class A Dunedin and struck out 15 in six innings pitched. His last start with New Hampshire was on May 4 (Game 1) against Harrisburg where he struck out three in 3.2 innings.

**RAKING VS READING:** C **Phil Clarke** is hitting a team-high .375 with a homer and four RBIs in nine games played. IF **Damiano Palmegiani** is hitting .333 with four home runs and 15 RBIs in 13 games while IF **Miguel Hiraldo** has 11 RBIs in 11 games vs Reading this season.

**THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (August 11, 2011)** —The Fisher Cats made it back-to-back shutouts of Erie with a 3-0 win in Manchester. Chad Jenkins went the first 6.2 innings, and Yohan Pino and Clint Everts finished up. After two scoreless outings at Double-A, Erie's Drew Smyly took the loss. He gave up a first-inning run on a Travis d'Arnaud grounder. Kevin Howard knocked in the other two with a double in the eighth.

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** Toronto (65-52) will open a series at home against the Cubs tonight. Jays split a four-game series at Cleveland, falling 4-3 to the Guardians on Thursday afternoon. Whit Merrifield doubled home Cavan Biggio, and then scored on a Brandon Belt single in the seventh to make it 4-3, but the Jays couldn't overcome the early deficit...Buffalo (53-56) was rained out at Worcester. The teams have a doubleheader at Polar Park today...Vancouver (63-59) scored two runs in the eighth to rally past Tri-City 3-2. Peyton Williams had the go-ahead RBI single. The Canadians received a strong start (6.0 IP - 0 R) from Devereaux Harrison...Dunedin (49-56) broke a 3-3 tie with a pair of runs in top of the eighth in a 5-3 win at Lakeland.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats continue their six-game home stand against the Reading Fightin' Phils until Sunday. Promotions for the weekend include Wizards & Wands Night Saturday, presented by Belletetes, and a Cooler Bag Giveaway Sunday, presented by Coke Northeast, with Kids Run the Bases Postgame, sponsored by the New Hampshire Liquor Commission Division of Enforcement.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Injured in a start for the Fisher Cats on May 4. Missed over two months with a bicep injury. Has made three rehab starts in the FCL and Florida State League without allowing a run. Struck out nine over three innings last Friday for Dunedin.

**v. READING** – First appearance

**2023:** Opened 2023 campaign with a nine strikeout performance over three scoreless frames against Portland (4/13). Struck out six at Somerset (4/19) working into the fourth inning for the first time with New Hampshire. Injured 5/4 in start vs. Harrisburg and missed over 2-1/2 months.

**2022:** Made four starts with the Fisher Cats before the Blue Jays shut him down last August. Did not allow a run in three of the four three-inning starts he made with New Hampshire.....Made eight starts with Advanced-A Vancouver, earning a pair of wins in consecutive starts June 4 and June 10. Given a break after having two of his least successful starts in July...Opened his first pro season with Class A Dunedin, where he made six starts, allowed no more than two runs in each of his six starts. Worked five innings in all six of them.

**Obtained:** Selected by the Blue Jays in the 3<sup>rd</sup> round of the 2021 draft (Golden West Junior College). Signed for \$644,800.

**Personal:** Ranked the No. 33 overall prospect by MLB.com (was ranked 28th overall in May rankings). He is the second ranked LHP pitcher in the overall MLB rankings and remains the top overall prospect in the Blue Jays system.
