## LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Alumni Report, MLB: 2017 Lugnuts star Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., ranks 1st in the Major Leagues in batting average (.318), 1st in home runs (46), tied for 4th in RBIs (104), 3rd in on-base percentage (.409), 3rd in slugging percentage (.615), 2nd in OPS (1.024), 1st in hits (175), 1st in total bases (338) and 1st in runs scored (118). Fellow 2017 Nut **Bo Bichette** is 2nd in runs scored (112) and tied for 2nd in base hits (172).

That's Commitment: Lansing Lugnuts broadcaster Adam Jaksa called the Lugnuts' 6-4 win over the Whitecaps on Friday night, flew to Baton Rouge and called the Central Michigan/LSU football game, then flew right back to Lansing to broadcast today's season finale.

Taking Over Late: The Lugnuts have beaten the Whitecaps in four straight games thanks to excellent late offense. In Game 2 of Wednesday's doubleheader, the Nuts scored an insurance run in their final at-bat to cap a 6-2 victory. On Thursday, the Nuts scored one run in the sixth, two in the seventh and two in the eighth, totaling five runs in their final three at-bats, for an 8-1 win. On Friday, the Lugnuts again scored in each of their final three at-bats: one run in the sixth, two in the seventh and one in the eighth for a 6-4 win. And last night, Lansing plated two runs in the fifth, one in the sixth and one in the seventh for a 5-3 win. The Whitecaps' bullpen has allowed 13 runs in 12 2/3 in those four games.

**Up the Ladder:** In the Double-A Central last night, **Max Schuemann** stole his 50th base of the year -- 34 with the Lugnuts followed by 16 with the Midland RockHounds. Schuemann, who is slashing .319/.397/.417 in Midland, has only been caught stealing five times in 2021.

**Welcome to Lansing:** 20-year-old **Jalen Greer** made his debut Friday with a walk and a run scored in four plate appearances. Greer joined the Lugnuts from the Arizona Complex League Athletics, becoming the 859th player in franchise history as well as the record-setting 55th different Lugnuts player to see action this season. He has already played third base and right field for the Lugnuts in his first two games.

Land of Lincoln... and Lugnuts: Greer is a native of Chicago. He becomes the seventh player on the Lugnuts' roster from Illinois, joining Garrett Acton, Reid Birlingmair, Jonny Butler, Charlie Cerny, Brett Harris and William Simoneit, plus pitching coach Don Schulze.

**Tough Actin' Acton:** Reliever **Garrett Acton** struck out the side Thursday night in the 9th, continuing a remarkably impressive run: In his last six relief appearances, batters are 0-for-19 with 18 strikeouts against Acton. In total, he has whiffed 33 batters while walking just three in 16 1/3 innings with the Lugnuts after a call-up from Low-A Stockton. In Acton's last 36 innings, spanning two levels and beginning on June 4, he has limited the opposition to 14 hits and five runs (1.25 ERA), with 61 strikeouts against only nine walks. Acton was signed as an undrafted free agent in 2020 after serving as closer at the University of Illinois, where he led the nation in saves in 2019 and set the Illinois career record for saves in 2020.

Truth in Advertising: Shortstop Drew Swift has lived up to his surname with 12 steals in 13 attempts in just 31 games with the Lugnuts, matching his college total of 11 steals in 172 games spanning four seasons at Arizona State University. Swift stole his 12th bag yesterday, giving the Lugnuts 157 stolen bases this year in 183 attempts.

Withers vs. Cancer: Reliever Brandon Withers is working with Vs. Cancer, with an official <u>Pledgelt.org</u> page to raise money to battle against Pediatric Brain Cancer with every strikeout he records in September. So far: four appearances this month, 8 2/3 innings total, 12 strikeouts recorded.

New Talent Infusion: The Lugnuts have five 2021 Athletics acquisitions on their roster in infielders Brett Harris (drafted in the 7th round, Gonzaga) and Drew Swift (8th round, Arizona State), outfielder Jonny Butler (14th round, North Carolina State), and pitchers Kyle Virbitsky (17th round, Penn State) and Jack Owen (undrafted free agent, Auburn).

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Six former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher Ty Tice '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Conner Greene '15 (Baltimore), pitcher Kirby Snead '16-'17 (Toronto), infielder Otto Lopez '19 (Toronto) and infielder Kevin Smith '18 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Snead most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs:** On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Welcome to the Pros: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Jack Owen, Kyle Virbitsky and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, infielder Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their professional debut with the Lugnuts this season.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 19 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Osvaldo Berrios, Reid Birlingmair, Charlie Cerny, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Jorge Juan, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Jack Owen, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka, Kyle Virbitsky and Brock Whittlesey.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher Drew Millas and pitchers Richard Guasch and Seth Shuman were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher Yan Gomes and utilityman Josh Harrison.

Lugnuts rallied to win 4-3 on a William Simoneit grand slam on an 0-2 pitch with two outs in the 7th... 85 pitches. 49 strikes.

- Game 1, Sept. 8 at Fort Wayne... allowed three first-inning runs (consecutive RBIs from Tirso Ornelas, Brandon Valenzuela, Justin Lopez) and then blanked the TinCaps for the remainder of 5 1/3 innings, earning the victory in a 7-3 Lugnuts win... Brock Whittlesey recorded the final five outs... 84 pitches, 53 strikes.

**PRBHS History:** Founded in 2002 by Ed Correa, who first used the Los Angeles Dodgers' Dominican complex in Las Palmas, DR, in 1999 as what would become the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School three years later... produced Carlos Correa (1st overall in 2012), Hiram Burgos, Joe Jiménez, Vimael Machin, Jesmuel Valentin and Christian Vázquez... this year produced one draftee, Astros 16th-rounder Gaby Nieves... in 2017, when Berríos was drafted, he was one of four players drafted from PRBHS.

Puerto Rican Baseball: Puerto Rico has produced four Hall of Famers thus far in Roberto Clemente, Iván Rodríguez, Roberto Alomar and Orlando Cepeda, with 1996 Lugnuts outfielder Carlos Beltrán and current catcher Yadier Molina each with their own Hall of Fame cases... today's Major League stars from Puerto Rico are led by Javier Báez and Francisco Lindor of the Mets, José Berríos of the Blue Jays, and Carlos Correa of the Astros... Lindor, like Osvaldo Berrios, was born in Caguas.

Pro Debut - 2017 in AZL: Made professional debut on July 1, 2017, vs. AZL Giants, allowing three runs on five hits in 1 2/3... final appearance of the year was his best (3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) vs. AZL SD1 on September 2... gave up .302 avg. to lefties, ... base-stealers were 4-for-6.

2018 in AZL: Relieved Daulton Jefferies in the second game of the season, tossing 3 2/3 innings (6 H, 1 R, 5 K) vs. AZL Giants Black... pitched six-inning gem (3 H, 1 R, 4 K) on the 4th of July vs. AZL White Sox... gave up just two earned runs in final 17 2/3 innings... limited righties to .252 avg./.628 OPS while lefties hit .348/.860... base-stealers were 6-for-6.

2019 in AZL and the NYPL: Opened season with AZL A's Gold, making four appearances... in first game of the year, appeared in relief on June 17 and struck out six AZL Cubs2 in 3 2/3 innings, allowing only one hit... tossed five-inning gem (4 H, 1 R, 4 K) on July 1 vs. AZL Dodgers, earning promotion to Short-Season A Vermont... finished the year with best outing for the Lake Monsters, August 29 vs. Connecticut in Game 2 of doubleheader (5 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 4 K)... with Vermont, gave up .326 avg./.855 OPS to right-handed hitters while lefties hit .241/.770... base-stealers went 1-for-1 in the AZL and 7-for-9 in the New York-Penn League.
