#### **GWINNETT MISCUES LEAD TO ONE-RUN WIN**

Behind a seven-strikeout performance from Robby Snelling, who made his Triple-A debut, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp came from behind to beat the Gwinnett Stripers 3-2 in front of 7,960 fans on Friday. Jacksonville (71-76, 36-36) trailed Gwinnett (72-76, 37-36) 2-1 starting the bottom of the eighth inning. Dalvy Rosario peppered a leadoff single. Jakob Marsee followed with a sacrifice bunt off of lefthander Hayden Harris (L, 1-3). A wild pitch and a sacrifice fly pushed the Jumbo Shrimp ahead 3-2.

#### SLIP 'N SLIDE

Despite owning a 5.89 ERA through the first 15 games in August (third-worst in the International League). Jacksonville balanced that with the second-best batting average (.283) while going 8-7. On Monday, August 19, the Jumbo Shrimp were just 5.5 games behind first-place Columbus for the top spot in the IL. Since then, the Jumbo Shrimp have been free falling in the standings, falling to 9th in the International League. In their last 29 games, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .235/.304/.343/.647, which ranks 17th, 18th, 18th and 18th respectively. On the flip side, despite posting a 13-16 record, the pitching staff's ERA ranks 8th (4.46) and they're holding opponents to the 9thhighest batting average against (.251).

### ONE RUN TO RULE THEM ALL

After Friday's 3-2 win, Jacksonville has now played in 53 one-run contests in 2024 and their 15th in their last 36 games. The Jumbo Shrimp are 9-6 in one-run games during this stretch. Jacksonville is being outscored by their opponents 174-140 since beating Toledo 7-6 on August 11.

#### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 32-39 (.451) record. Jacksonville has scored only 298 runs at home (4.1 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring over half-run more per game on the road, totaling 344 (4.6 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered 346 runs (4.6 per game), the ninth-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the eighth-fewest runs of any team at home (349, 4.8 per game). Thus, their run differential is -2 on the road, but -49 at home.

#### STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 12 wins during the month of August, nine came by three runs or fewer, including six by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 53 games this season decided by one run (25-28) the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 94 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 63.9 percent of the club's 147 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 49-44 (.527) in those tightlydecided contests.

#### LADIES FIRST

When Gwinnett opened the scoring on Friday against Jacksonville, it marked the 22nd consecutive home game for the Jumbo Shrimp in which the visiting team scored first. This streak, which dates back to July 30, has surprisingly seen Jacksonville go .500 in its contests at 121 Financial Ballpark. with a 11-11 record. Over the Jumbo Shrimp's 72 home games thus far in 2024, their opponent has scored first in 50 contests (69.4 percent). Jacksonville is 18-32 (.360) in those affairs.

### IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

Over the last 29 games, Jacksonville's offense has really struggled against opposing bullpens. The relief corps of Nashville, Norfolk, Louisville, Charlotte and Gwinnett have combined to surrender only 43 runs, 35 earned, on 96 hits (7.0 H/9) in 123.0 innings (2.56 ERA, 126 K, 46 BB) against the Jumbo Shrimp over this 29-game run. From the sixth inning on during this stretch, Jacksonville is a woeful 77-for-372 (.207) at the plate, scratching across only 36 runs in 96 innings.

## **SHRIMP BITES**

With Gwinnett scoring first on Friday, opponents have opened the scoring against Jacksonville in 18 of the last 26 games. In 12 of those contests, opponents have scored in the first inning...Jacksonville has had 87 different players take the field in 2024, setting a new club record from (2022, 79)...After Robby Snelling's start last night, the Jumbo Shrimp have had 28 different starting pitchers, a club record. With Dane Myers returning to the Jacksonville lineup on Tuesday, his 1-for-3 game extended his on-base streak to 23 games

#### **ABOUT YONNY**

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for \$10,000 as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.

-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first 14 2/3 innings without allowing an earned run.

-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 752 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a 1-0 lead. That is how the game finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.

-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tendered Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.
