YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Sea Dogs, 8-6, in 11 innings. Trailing, 6-2, through four innings, the Flying Squirrels closed the deficit to three in the sixth with a run. In the eighth, **Diego Rincones** hit a game-tying, three-run homer to force extras. In the top of the 10th, **Casey Schmitt** hit an RBI double and **Jacob Heyward** added a run with a sac fly to open an 9-6 lead. **Cole Waites** worked through the final two innings without allowing a run.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from June 21-26 to close out the first half. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' first trip to Portland since June 4-6, 2019, when Richmond won two-of-three in a the series.

WE ARE HEADED NORTH: The Flying Squirrels are in the second leg of a 12-game road trip to New England, their first visit to the league's two northernmost cities since the 2019 season. The two series against New Hampshire and Portland are the Flying Squirrels' only two sets this year on the road against Eastern League Northeast Division Richmond does not visit Binghamton, Hartford, Somerset or Reading this season, although all four of those teams have played or will play in Richmond.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 12-25 to open the second half. They have lost 17-of-the-last-23 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost eight and split four this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,164 strikeouts (11.0 per game) and rank fourth with 135 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 25-31 on the road this year. Richmond is 24-22 in games decided by two-or-less runs. They are 13-21 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, including a 4-7 record in road games.

THE SEA DOGS are leading the Northeast Division second-half standings by 1.5 games over Somerset. They have won five-of-their-last-seven games after dropping the previous five straight. Portland's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including RHP Bryan Mata (7), RHP Thad Ward (14), 3B Alex Binelas (20), INF/OF/C Stephen Scott (23), SS Christian Koss (24), OF/INF Cedanne Rafaela (25) or OF Wilyer Abreu (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Wil Jensen** makes his fifth Double-A start and his second against the Sea Dogs. He started the series-opener on Tuesday and allowed three runs over six innings, his second straight quality start. Last week in New Hampshire, Jensen worked six scoreless, one-hit innings with no walks and five strikeouts in a win. That performance earned him the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week Award, which was announced on Monday. Jensen began the season with High-A Eugene, going 6-3 with a 2.84 ERA in 15 starts and three relief outings. Over his last four High-A starts, Jensen went 4-0 with a 1.46 ERA (4 ER/24.2 IP) and struck out 30 batters. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Jensen ranked tied for second in the Northwest League in wins (6) and tied for seventh in strikeouts (77). After four years at Pepperdine, Jensen signed as an undrafted free agent with the Giants in 2020. Jensen was born in Phoenix but grew up near Salt Lake City. **For more on Jensen, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Brayan Bello makes a rehab start for the Sea Dogs. He has been on the injured list for the Red Sox since August 4 with a left groin strain. He began the season with Portland and went 4-2 with 1.60 ERA in six starts before being promoted to Triple-A on May 17. Bello made his MLB debut for the Red Sox on July 6 at Fenway Park against the Rays and allowed four runs over four innings in a loss. For the year, he has pitched five games for Boston, including three starts, going 0-3 with a 8.47 ERA. He last pitched on August 3 at Houston and recorded two outs. Bello signed with the Red Sox as an international free agent in 2017. He first reached Double-A with Portland last year, going 2-3 with a 4.66 ERA in 15 starts. He was also selected to pitch in the All-Star Futures Game last year at Coors Field. Bello is currently rated by MLB.com as the No. 3 Red Sox prospect.

GOING UNDER: With Wednesday's loss, the Flying Squirrels' overall record dropped under .500 for the first time since August 19, 2021, when they were 46-47. Last year, the team climbed back over .500 to finish the season with their first winning record since 2015. In the team's history, the Flying Squirrels have posted winning records in 2011, 2014, 2015 and 2021. Thursday's loss pushed Richmond two games under .500 for the first time since August 18, 2021, when they were 45-47. Wednesday's defeat in Portland dropped the Flying Squirrels to three games under .500 for the first time since August 17, 2021, when they were 44-47.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (296,258) and average attendance (6,172). Richmond is 13th of the 120 MLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

THE STARTING LINE: Over the last 13 games since July 29, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 3-2 with a 2.31 ERA (16 ER/62.1 IP) with 86 strikeouts and 28 walks. Over those 13 starts, Flying Squirrels pitchers have held opponents to one-or-less runs in eight of them, including six scoreless starts.

STRIKING OUT THE SEA DOGS: On the year, Richmond starting pitchers have posted their four highest strikeout totals against the Sea Dogs. From June 24-26, Richmond starters **Kai-Wei Teng**, **Bryan Brickhouse** and **Kyle Harrison** each struck out 11 batters in three straight games. Those outings were the first 11-strikeout performances by Richmond pitchers since **Conner Menez** recorded 11 strikeouts against the Yard Goats on August 19, 2018. On Wednesday, **Matt Frisbee** struck out 13 Portland batters, breaking the Flying Squirrels single-game franchise record. Of the seven outings by Richmond pitchers with 10+ strikeouts this year, five have been against Portland.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 135 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League. Last Sunday in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 175 home runs. **Sean Roby** is tied for third in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond.

MARTY PARTY: **Brandon Martorano** posted a seven-game hit streak from July 28-August 11, which was snapped with an 0-for-5 game on Friday night. In his last eight games since July 28, Martorano is batting .348 (11-for-31) with a homer, three doubles and six RBIs. He has hit in the leadoff spot in four-of-his-last-five games played, including a 4-for-5 game last Thursday night and a two-hit game on Saturday, both at New Hampshire. In his four games this year batting first in the order, Martorano is batting .348 (8-for-23) with two homers and four RBIs.

BACH TO FORM: In his last 10 games, **Brett Auerbach** is batting .300 (12-for-40) with four homers, three doubles, 12 RBIs and nine runs scored. He opened last week's series with a four-hit game on Tuesday at New Hampshire, including a homer. He went deep again last Wednesday, his third straight game with a home run. On Sunday, Auerbach picked up four hits again, including a homer and three doubles, and drove in six runs. On Monday, Auerbach was announced as the Eastern League's Player of the Week for August 2-7. He is hitting .125 (2-for-16) with one RBI in this week's series at Portland.

FITZ ON FIRE: Over his last 23 games since July 10, **Tyler Fitzgerald** has homered eight times. He now has 18 homers this season, which ranks tied for the third-most in a season in franchise history, even with **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lissón** (2014) and trailing only **David Villar** (20 - 2021) and **Sean Roby** (23 - 2022). On the current road trip, Fitzgerald is batting .293 (12-for-41) in nine games with two homers, two doubles and eight RBIs.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin' Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is tied for third in the EL in homers. He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duval** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked third in batting average (.284). **Sean Roby** is tied for in homers (23) and is ninth in SLG (.471). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in OBP (.367), ninth in walks (50) and sixth in stolen bases (24). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for ninth in homers (18).

WHERE THE SEA DOGS RANK: In the Eastern League, Christian Koss is ranked seventh in batting average (.278), tied for fifth in RBIs (64), second in hits (105) and sixth in total bases (166). Tyler Dearden is seventh in OBP (.371). David Hamilton is first in triples (8) and first in stolen bases (51).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Casey Schmitt** (6), **Ryan Murphy** (15), **Cole Waites** (21) and **Ricardo Genovés** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Waites is listed as having the "Best Fastball." Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), Schmitt (13), **Tristan Peters** (25) and Genovés (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 23 overall prospect.
