#### **DAVALILLO SPINS GEM, RIDERS DROP ROCKHOUNDS:**

The Frisco RoughRiders downed the Midland RockHounds 4-1 on Thursday night at Riders Field. In the bottom of the first inning, **Frainyer Chavez** hit an RBI single to put Frisco (19-23, 57-53) ahead 1-0. The RoughRiders later surged for three runs in the bottom of the eighth frame. **Aaron Zavala** uncorked a two-RBI double before **Sebastian Walcott** towered a bloop RBI single to center, putting Frisco ahead 4-0. Midland (17-25, 56-55) got a run back in the top of the ninth when Jared Dickey lined an RBI double to make the score 4-1. **David Davalillo** (2-2) earned the win, tying a season-high with seven innings. Gage Jump (5-4) was tagged with the loss, yielding an unearned run.

#### POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ, OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

Frisco's bullpen has struggled this season, but has been great to start August. In 12 games, the Riders bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 2.35 ERA, but they are 7-for-10 in save opportunities.

#### ROTATION ROTATING

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). Frisco's starting ERA of 3.84 in the second half is second in the Texas League, while it is 3.54 since the start of July, which is also second in the league. In the last 15 games, Frisco has a 2.32 ERA for starters which is second in the league and they're also second with a 2.05 ERA in 11 August games. **Jose Corniell** (11.2 IP, 0 ER), **Leandro Lopez** (14.1 IP, 4 ER) and **David Davalillo** (38.2 IP, 7 ER) have been incredible to start their Double-A careers.

#### **BROKEN BATS:**

For the first time since midseason 2023, the RoughRiders were blanked in back-to-back games on offense on Sunday and Tuesday. Frisco ended their scoreless streak with **Aaron Zavala**'s two-run double in the 10th on Wednesday, stopping the streak at 29 consecutive innings without a run. In the first 12 games in August, Frisco has scored just 38 total runs while hitting .207/.309/.276/.585 as the plate as a team with three home runs. Zavala has scored or driven in 14 of the 38 runs in the month for Frisco.

#### **THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT**

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.982) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (69). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .984 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A. They committed two errors on Saturday, just their ninth game since May 1st committing multiple errors.

#### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

**Aaron Zavala** walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

#### HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO:

In their last 29 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 22 of the 29 games, but they are 15-14. The Riders have blown 10 saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.99 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they allowed 54 earned runs, they also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

#### WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.2 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.4 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.

--Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Made only relief appearace of the season on 7/9 vs. NWA, coming out of the bullpen behind MLB rehabber Tyler Mahle.

#### 2023 SEASON

- -In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.
- -He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.
- -In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.
- -Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.
- -Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

#### 2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

- -115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).
- -Induced ground balls at an over 50% rate in 2022 with both Down East and Hickory.
