RIDERS COMEBACK SNUBBED WITH 6-3 LOSS TO TRAVS:

A three-run ninth inning propelled the Arkansas Travelers over the Frisco RoughRiders Wednesday night at Riders Field, 6-3. Frisco scored three runs in the sixth through eighth innings, including solo home runs from **Ezequiel Duran** and **Jonathan Ornelas**, both hitting their second of the year. The RoughRiders received a five-inning outing and eight strikeouts from **Avery Weems** (1-2) from the bullpen, both career highs for the left-handed pitcher. The eight strikeouts from Weems stand as the most from any Riders pitcher this season. Travelers reliever Devin Sweet (2-2) earned the win, but gave up the game's tying run in the bottom of the eighth before Arkansas plated three in the top of the ninth. Arkansas starter Stephen Kolek struck out six in a scoreless, five-inning start to keep the Riders off the scoreboard until his departure. After the end of the fifth inning, an incoming rain cell delayed the game for 25 minutes before passing. Arkansas scored first in the opening frame with a Zach DeLoach base hit to drive in Patrick Frick and make it 1-0. The Travelers tallied two more in the second inning with back-to-back RBI hits from Joe Rizzo and Jake Scheiner. On the first pitch after the delay, Josh Stowers met a line drive at the left-field wall and secured the catch while crashing into the fence to complete the out. The Riders quickly issued the game's action back in motion with Duran's second home run of the year in the bottom of the sixth to trim the Arkansas lead to 3-1. In the seventh, Frisco inched closer with a lead-off single from **Jordan Procyshen**, followed by an RBI double from **Justin Foscue** to make it a 3-2 game. The Riders tied it in the home half of the eighth on the Ornelas home run to increase his average to .370 over his first 20 games played.

START ME UP:

As the calendar turns to May, the RoughRiders starting pitchers have started to go deeper in ballgames. In their last nine games, the Riders have had a starter go at least five innings in six contests while a starter has accomplished the feat in five of the last seven as well. Both **Cole Ragans** and **Zak Kent** have pitched 5.1 innings, the longest starts this season for Frisco. Over the last seven games, starters own a 4.55 ERA (16 ER, 31.2 IP).

ROAD WARRIORS:

The RoughRiders have played 11 games at home and 12 games on the road so far in 2022. While they are just 4-7 at home, Frisco is 10-2 on the road this season, the best road record in all of Minor League Baseball. Pitching has been dominant away from Riders Field, owning a 3.94 ERA on the road and holding opponents to just a .223 BAA and five home runs over the 12 games. The Riders have the third-best road ERA in the Texas League and the fourth-best road OPS (.805) in the league. At home, Frisco's pitching staff has a 5.09 ERA (fifth in the Texas League) and the Riders have given up 15 home runs in 11 games.

J.P. STANDS FOR JUST PERFORM:

Outfielder **J.P. Martinez** exploded for three-straight games with a home run and collected has back-to-back three-hit games for Frisco before going 1-for-4 with a double on Thursday. Over his last 16 games, Martinez is hitting .313 (20-for-64)/.413/.484 with two doubles, three home runs, seven RBIs, 14 runs, nine stolen bases and 10 walks.

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonny Ornelas** has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. On Wednesday in Midland, he tied his career-high with four hits and has batted .397 (29-for-73)/.408/.521/.934 in his last 18 games and .455 (20-for-44) with 1.126 OPS over his last 11 games. He has five games with at least three hits this season to lead the club. Ornelas is also the youngest player on the Riders and the 21-year-old is the 10th-youngest in the Texas League.

DUSTIN BUSTER:

After starting the season 0-for-8, **Dustin Harris** hit safely in the next 11 games before going 0-for-3 on Tuesday against Midland. Harris hit .366 (15-for-41)/.404/.488/.892 over his streak with a double, a home run and 10 RBIs. The 11-game hitting streak was the second-longest streak in the Texas League, trailing only Zack Gelfo of Midland (14 games). Harris owned 15-game on-base streak where he owned a .394 on-base percentage until going 0-for-4 on Saturday. That on-base streak was tied for the fifth-longest streak in the Texas League. The No. 6 prospect in the Rangers system was the Tom Grieve Ranger Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, hitting .327/.401/.542 with 20 home runs and 25 steals between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.

THE VIPER STRIKES AGAIN:

Known as "The Viper" since his college days at Alabama, Frisco reliever **Chase Lee** has struck quickly and often this season. Over his nine outings, Lee has allowed just four hits (.121 BAA) while not allowing a run and going 3-for-3 in save opportunities. In his 10.2 innings, Lee has whiffed 14 while walking just five.

ALLOW ME TO REINTRODUCE MYSELF:

Riders reliever **Seth Nordlin** was flat out dominant in his outing against Northwest Arkansas on Friday. Nordlin threw four shutout innings, retiring all 12 batters he faced with four strikeouts. After throwing a first-pitch ball on his very first offering, Nordlin threw 22-straight strikes over the next three innings. Overall, he threw 34 pitches, 29 for strikes. Ever since his first game of the season when he allowed four runs, Nordlin has gone 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA over 11.1 IP. During that span, opponents are just hitting .061 (2-for-38) against him while he has whiffed 10 and walked five.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 974 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While RHP **Jack Leiter** headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad as the No. 1 prospect, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. INF **Justin Foscue**, who joined the club after sustaining an injury during spring training, is the No. 5 prospect. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. LHP **Cody Bradford** is the No. 20 prospect. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season. RHP **Zak Kent** slots in as the No. 21 prospect by MLB.com.

ABOUT JUSTIN

-SA Hallsville High School in Hallsville, Texas (a little over two hours from Frisco toward the Louisiana border). Thought he was going to play in junior college before owning a 1.49 ERA his senior year. He received an offer from University of New Mexico. Helped Hallsville to a 5A regional quarterfinal appearance in 2016 as a senior.

-At New Mexico, Slaten was a three-year player with two spent in the starting rotation. After owning a 7.02 ERA his sophomore season, Slaten went 5-5 with a 2.51 ERA while striking out 98 in 82.1 innings to earn 2nd-Team All-Mountain West Conference honors.

-His third-round selection (86th overall), made Slaten the highest New Mexico pitcher taken in the MLB draft since Kevin Andersh was taken in the first round (18th overall) by the Pirates in 1984.

-After being acquired in the offseason by the Rangers, catcher Mitch Garver is the only former Lobo on Texas. Garver was drafted out of New Mexico in 2013 by the Twins.

2022 SEASON

-First appearance for the Riders came out of the bullpen on Opening Night, throwing a scoreless inning with a pair of strikeouts.

-Pitched first shutout outing among Riders starters on April 28th at Midland, going five shutout innings. The Riders trailed 1-0 into the ninth before scoring six runs in a 6-1 victory.

2021 SEASON

-Finished the 2021 season as the No. 29 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Ended the year with the 5th-most strikeouts (110) and 10th-most innings (82.1) among Rangers minor leaguers in his 20 games (19 starts) with High-A Hickory.

-Over last 12 games, Slaten went 4-4 with a 4.14 ERA to conclude the year.

-Entered the season as the No. 15 prospect in the system by Fangraphs.

2020 SEASON

-Struck out 17 of 44 (38.6 percent) batters faced in the Fall Developmental league while allowing just two runs over 10.2 innings.
