LAST TIME OUT

WORCESTER, MA (August 28, 2026) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders shutout the Worcester Red Sox 2-0 on Friday night. Alexander Cornielle silenced the Red Sox through eight innings and Brad Hanner tossed the ninth to finish the contest.

Yanquiel Fernández gave the RailRiders their first run of the game in the fourth inning. He slugged his 22nd homer of the season over the mini monster in right field.

In the fifth, Duke Ellis singled to reach. Anthony Volpe followed with an RBI double to score Ellis for a 2-0 advantage.

Ellis and Fernández both had two-hit games.

Cornielle (W, 4-3) worked eight shutout frames allowing just two hits and a pair of walks on 93 pitches. He struck out five batters enroute to pitching the longest start of his career. Brad Hanner (5, 5) earned the save with a quiet ninth inning. Boston's #9 prospect John Holobetz (L, 1-4) allowed the two runs in his five frames.

NEWS & NOTES

IN THE LEAGUE - After a win last night, the RailRiders are tied for third place with Durham in the International League. They are now two and a half games behind the leading Indianapolis with Rochester in between. The RailRiders are 5-5 in their last ten games, are eight contests above .500 on the full season as they reach their 30th win in the second half. Worcester is four and a half games out of first place and have gone 3-7 in their last ten contests.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON - Both the Yankees and the RailRiders held the Red Sox scoreless in their respective wins last night. The RailRiders recorded their ninth shutout victory of the season, holding their opponents to just three hits. The RailRiders have been kept off the board just four times this season. Worcester is 5-8 in shutout situations.

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED - SWB made three challenges on pitches during the game all on the defensive side of things. Mitch Garver checked two behind the plate that were overturned for strikes. In addition, Travis MacGregor challenged a ball that was turned to a strike as well. Two of the three turnovers were strike three that ended an inning.

MERDA MEANS BUSINESS - Hayden Merda got the spot start for the RailRiders on Wednesday and will be called upon to do so today. Merda went two silent frames with just a hit and a walk while striking out four. The right-hander also has a save for SWB. Merda has had 32 outings this season for a 3.67 earned run average. In 41.2 innings of work, he walked just 21 batters compared to 67 strikeouts. Merda, 26 was drafted in the 17th round in 2022 out of Azusa Pacific University.

CORNIELLE IN COMMAND - Righty Alexander Cornielle made the longest start of the season last night, tossing eight full innings of shutout ball. He allowed just two hits and a pair of walks while striking out six. It was a career innings for Cornielle and his most pitches thrown in an outing this season. Cornielle lowered his ERA to 2.83 in a dozen starts, working through 54 frames. The righty has been better each month, working a 1.57 ERA in four starts in August. Cornielle, who joined SWB mid-June, was signed as a minor league free agent on December 17 and began the season on the Injured List. He pitched on a rehab assignment before being activated on June 11 and optioned to Double-A for one appearance.

CORONA'S CHALLENGES - Kenedy Corona has challenged four pitches at the plate in this series and has all of them overturned. He has one of the best rates as a hitter for SWB getting 15 of his 24 total challenges changed. He has a 62.5% success rate.

YANQUIEL GOES YARD - Yanquiel Fernández leads the RailRiders in home runs with 22 and in runs batted in with 71 after another long ball last night. The homers are tied for sixth most in the International League while the RBIs are seventh most. The 23-year-old has upped his batting average to .256 after a good month of August. Fernández was claimed off of waivers by the Yankees from Colorado in January and then was designated for assignment a few days later but was able to be outrighted to SWB.

DUKE'S RECORD PERFORMANCE - Duke Ellis set a new single season record with 46 stolen bases on the season. He broke the record of 44 set by Tommy Barrett in 1989. Barrett did so in 120 games, whereas Ellis marked his in 85 contests. Ellis also holds the franchise record for 87 total with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in 161 games. The prior record was held by Nick Punto who stole 82 bags in 263 games. Ellis's personal record is 57 in a single year done back in 2024.
