Indianapolis Indians (Pittsburgh Pirates) at Coolray Field, the only series between the two clubs this season. Tonight is Family Value Tuesday, presented by Coolray Heating & Cooling (\$2 hot dogs, \$1 desserts).

VS. INDIANAPOLIS: Gwinnett is 31-21 (.596) all-time vs. Indianapolis at Coolray Field, and enters play riding a sixgame home winning streak over the Indians dating back to 4/23/19 (outscoring IND 36-16). The Stripers have won five straight overall against Indianapolis since 6/1/19 (outscoring IND 29-14). In 11 season series vs. Indianapolis since 2009, Gwinnett is 3-4-4 (2-0 since 2018).

STIFLING STARTERS: Stripers' starters (Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller, and Huascar Ynoa) have combined to post a 2.61 ERA (20 ER in 69.0 IP), 9.78 SO/9.0 IP ratio (75 SO in 69.0 IP), and six quality starts over the last 12 games (team is 5-7). The group has allowed 54 hits and just 19 walks in that span.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 617 in 60 games (10.28 SO per game). That's three more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 614 SO in 60G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (2nd, 73), Tucker Davidson (8th, 53), and Huascar Ynoa (T-13th, 50) all rank in the IL top 15 in strikeouts.

**DIFF'RENT STREAKS:** Preston Tucker enters play looking to extend an 11-game on-base streak. He's batting .306 (11-for-36, 2 2B, 2 HR, 3 R, 5 RBI, 9 BB, .972 OPS) during the streak since 5/27, his second of 10-plus games this year (had 13-game streak from 4/24-5/12). Braden Shewmake has a five-game hitting streak since 6/7, batting .333 (6-for-18, 2 2B, 2 R, 2 RBI, 1 SB, .794 OPS).

GOSSELIN GETS THE CALL: Today, the Atlanta Braves selected the contract of INF Phil Gosselin from Gwinnett (replacing injured 2B Ozzie Albies). Gosselin hit safely in 23 of 29 games from 5/1-6/12, batting .312 (34-for-109, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 16 RBI, .885 OPS) in that stretch. He ranks 14th in the IL with a .297 average (54-for-182, 13 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 24 RBI, .831 OPS) in 49 games.

- GWN Career: In 284 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), he's batting .295 (309-for-1046, 64 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 106 RBI, 11 SB, .769 OPS).
- 300 Club: He is one of seven in Gwinnett history with 300 hits, joining Sean Kazmar Jr. (675), Jose Constanza (437), Rio Ruiz (356), Todd Cunningham (334), Joey Terdoslavich (308), and Ernesto Mejia (302).

**DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING:** Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 35 of 42 games (83.3%) with the Stripers this season, batting .252 (30-for-119, 5 2B, 16 R, 10 RBI). He currently ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-9th, 13) and walks (T-10th, 31).

**TONIGHT:** The Stripers begin a six-game series vs. the **MULLDOZING:** Tonight's scheduled starting pitcher **Kyle** Muller is 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER in 13.0 IP), 1.08 WHIP, .213 BAA, and 11.77 SO/9.0 IP ratio (17 SO in 13.0 IP) over his last two starts, both quality outings.

- IL Leaderboard: He currently ranks among the IL top 15 in strikeouts (2nd, 73), ERA (4th, 3.09), BAA (T-11th, .239), WHIP (12th, 1.27), and innings (T-13th, 55.1).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 8-7 with a 3.27 ERA (49 ER in 135.0 IP), .230 BAA, and 166 strikeouts (11.07 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 27 starts.

WATERS STARTS IT WITH A BANG: Drew Waters tripled on the first pitch thrown by RHP Bryan Hoeing on 6/11 at Jacksonville, his third extra-base hit on the first pitch of a game this season. He also hit first-pitch leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (off LHP Wes Benjamin) and 5/11 at Durham (off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff clouts of his Gwinnett career.

- 2022 with GWN: In 27 games overall, Waters is batting .262 (27-for-103, 5 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 16 R, 9 RBI, 1 SB), including .471 against LHP (4 2B, 1 HR, 1.176 OPS) and .159 against RHP (1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, .492 OPS).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .249 (153-for-614, 32 2B, 2 3B, 16 HR, 103 R, 57 RBI, 32 SB, .712 OPS) in 156 games.

FORD IN THE FOLD: On 6/10, the Atlanta Braves claimed 1B Mike Ford from the Seattle Mariners and optioned him to Gwinnett. He is set to join the club during this homestand. The Stripers will be Ford's fifth team this season, as he's already played for Triple-A Tacoma (SEA), Triple-A Sacramento (SF), and both Seattle and San Francisco in the Majors. Ford is a career .197 hitter (12 2B, 17 HR, 46 RBI, .707 OPS) in 118 MLB games with the Yankees (2019-21), Mariners (2022), and Giants (2022).

TUIASOSOPO REACHES 100-WIN MARK: Matt Tuiasosopo earned his 100th win as a Triple-A manager on 6/9 at Jacksonville (won 5-1). He is the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 wins, joining Dave Brundage (293 from 2009-12), Brian Snitker (161 from 2014-16), and Damon Berryhill (221 from 2017-19).

**DEMERITTE RETURNS:** Travis Demeritte returned to the Stripers lineup on 6/1 vs. Louisville (1-for-4, 2 R), his first game since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 162 of 190 games (85.3%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .284 (186-for-655, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 128 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .944 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

#### MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

**PROSPECTING:** Muller is currently ranked as the Atlanta Braves' No. 3 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the top-ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's active roster.

**2022 WITH GWINNETT:** 4/5 at MEM: Was the Stripers' Opening Night starter (ND, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 7 SO in 2-1 loss), making him the first player in Gwinnett history to start consecutive season openers (also on 5/4/21 at Charlotte) ... 4/5-4/23: Made four starts (1-1, 3.66 ERA, .214 BAA) before being recalled by Atlanta on 5/1 ... 5/14 at DUR: Tied his career high with 12 strikeouts, but took the loss (6.0 IP, 6 H, 4 ER, 2 HR), pitched opposite his older brother Chris (1.0 IP, 2 BB, 2 SO with DUR in 6th) for the first time in his professional career ... 6/2 vs. LOU: Tossed a season-high 7.0 innings (4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 SO), falling one out shy of his career high (7.1 IP).
