DES MOINES, IOWA – The Omaha Storm Chasers lost game one of a Wednesday afternoon doubleheader with the Iowa Cubs 6-5 on a wild pitch in extra innings, before bouncing back to win game two 5-1 at Principal Park.

- In Game 1, Omaha jumped out to an early 3-0 lead ... **Nick Pratto** singled home two in the 1st inning, then **Nick Loftin** singled in a run in the 2nd.
- Omaha starter **Daniel Lynch IV** cruised through the first three innings in Game 1, only allowing a solo homer to **Owen Caissie** in the 4th inning, with 3 strikeouts.
- After an error played an Omaha run in the top of the 5th, Iowa stormed back in the bottom half, playing 4 runs on 4 hits and a walk off MLB rehabber Carlos Hernandez ... Hernandez only got two outs and **Walter Pennington** allowed the two inherited runners to score, he otherwise finished the inning, with Iowa up 5-4.
- Devin Mann** homered in the 6th inning to tie the game at 5-5 ... **Sam Long** stranded the winning run in the 7th to work **Dan Altavilla** out of trouble, but Omaha couldn't score in the top of the 8th and a wild pitch lost the game in the bottom of the 8th.
- In Game 2, the Storm Chasers came out the gate strong once again and took an early lead, scoring five runs in the first two innings ... a double steal plated a run in the 1st inning, then **Devin Mann** singled in **Nick Loftin** ... in the 2nd inning, **John Rave** doubled in two, then scored on a Loftin single for a 5-0 lead.
- Zach Davies** compiled a strong start in Game 2 and earned his first win of the year ... over 5.0 scoreless innings (the longest scoreless outing by an Omaha starter this year), he struck out four while limiting the I-Cubs to a walk and three singles.
- Major League rehabber **Jake Brentz** allowed a run in the bottom of the 6th behind Davies on an RBI for Iowa's only run of the day ... **Will Klein** threw a 1-2-3 bottom of the 7th to finish off the win for Omaha, maintaining his 0.00 ERA.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### DOUBLE TROUBLE

Yesterday was Omaha's second doubleheader of the season ... the Chasers have split both doubleheaders they've played in 2024, both have been on the road as well.

- Last year, Omaha only played one double-dip, on July 2 vs. Iowa and split it.
- The Storm Chasers split a doubleheader with Columbus on April 4, losing Game 1 3-0 before bouncing back in Game 2 with a 5-4 win.
- Omaha has won or split its last 13 doubleheaders, dating back to May 2019 ... the Chasers have won or split their last 8 road doubleheaders.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 150 to 121 this season, a +29 run differential.

- A +29 run differential ranks as the 2nd-best in the International League and is tied 5th in Triple-A ... Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY) leads the IL at +42 while Tacoma (SEA) leads the Triple-A level with a +46 run differential.

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- Omaha's 3.98 ERA (53 ER in 120.0 IP) ranks 4th out of the 20-team International League and 5th among the 30 Triple-A teams ... the Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .205 average (90-for-440), which is the 3rd-best mark among Triple-A teams, as is the .657 OPS against Omaha's relievers.
- Will Klein** was called up last Thursday by the Royals and made his MLB debut Sunday ... he opened the year with 12.0 innings without allowing an earned run ... he's thrown the 2nd-most innings of any IL pitcher to not allow an ER this year.
- Walter Pennington** leads the bullpen with a 7.1-inning scoreless streak currently over his last 4 games since April 16 ... **Dan Altavilla** and **Will Klein** have each recorded three consecutive scoreless games and **Evan Sisk** has two in a row.

#### THE MANN OF THE HOUR

- Devin Mann** sneakily might be the hottest hitter on the Storm Chasers right now.
- Mann has reached in 15 consecutive games, the longest on-base streak for an Omaha hitter this year, the 2nd-longest active streak in the league ... since April 4, he is hitting .340 (18-for-53) with a 1.029 OPS ... he has hits in 11 of 15 games in this stretch.
- Mann has reached base in 16 of 18 games with Omaha (89%), after reaching base in 31 of 37 games last year with Omaha (84%).

#### ALEXANDER THE GREAT

- Infielder **CJ Alexander** has been one of Omaha's top hitters early in the season, leading the team in many categories.
- Alexander has 8 of Omaha's 12 hardest-hit balls this season, including the 2 hardest ... he had a 110.4MPH double in Game 1 yesterday, Omaha's hardest-hit ball this year.
- CJ leads Omaha in homers (5), hits (27), doubles (8), extra-base hits (14), total bases (52) and runs scored (21) ... he also leads qualified Chasers hitters in slugging percentage (.571) and OPS (.904).
