ABOUT SUNDAY: Despite INF **Branden Fryman** hitting a pair of home runs, the Cyclones dropped the finale of the six-game series on Sunday, losing 6-3 to the Bowling Green Hot Rods. RHP **Mike Vasil** made his High-A debut, striking out seven over four innings. Bowling Green's 1B **Kyle Manzardo** hit a home run on Sunday and finished the series 8-for-17 with a triple and four home runs for the Hot Rods who won the series four games to two.

THIS WEEK: Brooklyn travels to ShoreTown Ballpark for the first time in 2022, facing the Jersey Shore BlueClaws.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley in New York, the Cyclones have completely turned around their power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 16 home runs in the past eight games after just seven over the team's first 34 games. In the span, the Cyclones lead the South Atlantic League in homers.

BMAC ATTACK: OF **Brandon McIlwain** has hits in five straight games, hitting .327 with a .431 on-base percentage with five steals in six tries. The South Carolina resident has two home runs in his past three games and had a 4-for-4 game on Saturday at Bowling Green.

MAY FLOWERS: INF **Jose Peroza's** month of May has reflected the talent of the No. 29 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*. After an April in which the Venezuelan hit .155 with no extra base hits and three walks, Peroza is hitting .283 in May with seven walks, four doubles, and two home runs, including one home run in the Bowling Green series.

THE SUOZZINATOR: Brooklyn OF **Joe Suozzi** has been on another level since going through a development program in early May. Since returning to action on May 19, the Long Island native has hits in six

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate sits in last place in the North Division and the South Atlantic League entering the series. The Cyclones have won five of the first six with the first trip to New Jersey this week. Eight of Philly's top 30 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline*, are in Jersey Shore, including No. 3 RHP Mick Abel, No. 4 OF Johan Rojas, and No. 7 OF Ethan Wilson.

of eight games, hitting .357. The former Boston College Eagle is 10-28 with two doubles, two home runs, four walks, and just six strikeouts. Prior to the stint on the development list, Suozzi was hitting just .111 over his first 13 games with a 42% strikeout rate and three walks prior to the break.

PALM PILOT: OF **Jaylen Palmer**, the Mets No. 14 prospect, according to *MLB Pipeline*, has found his stroke in the month of May with a .776 OPS after a .423 OPS in April. Palmer has hit four home runs in his past 10 games and sits three shy of tying his career-high of seven home runs with Rookie-level Kingsport in 2019. At just 21 years old, Palmer is the youngest player on the team and the highest-rated Mets prospect.

ARM ASSISTANCE: RHP **Mike Vasil** and RHP **Carson Seymour** have joined the team in Bowling Green after earning their respective promotions from Low-A St. Lucie. Vasil, the No. 21 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*, was drafted out of Virginia in the 8th round last season, while Seymour was selected in the 6th round out of Kansas State last year.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State, ranks tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League with 13 doubles, sitting four behind the league leader Luis Mieses of Winston-Salem. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 56 total bases and leads the team with 17 RBIs.

SWACKING TOUR: Nick Zwack makes his fourth start with Brooklyn and first since starting the second game of the doubleheader on Wednesday at Bowling Green.

SWEET STRIKEOUT SUCCESS: Zwack tossed just 12 2/3 innings with Low-A St. Lucie, making two starts and two other relief appearances, striking out 24 batters. The southpaw's strikeout rate was 46% in the Florida State League with a 3.8% walk rate.

YEAR ONE: After his draft selection mid-summer in 2021, Zwack reported to Florida to pitch for the Complex team, making five relief appearances with 13 strikeouts and two walks over just seven total frames.

BIG EAST BEST: Zack earned Big East Conference First-Team accolades after his 2021 campaign for the Xavier Musketeers, tossing a team-high 80 innings. He finished his Xavier career with the 12th-most wins in team history (15) and the sixth-most strikeouts in school history (214).

X MARKS THE SPOT: Xavier has been involved with two Hall of Famers -- Frank Robinson who spent 21 years in the Major Leagues with Cincinnati, Baltimore, Los Angeles (NL), California, and Cleveland. Robinson enrolled in Xavier after his first MLB season. On the pitching side, Jim Bunning, who pitched 591 games in the big leagues, represents the most famous arm out of the small Cincinnati college.

MINNESOTA!: The left hails from Monticello, Minnesota where he played baseball, hockey, and was the quarterback on his high school football team. He is the only player from his high school -- Monticello High School - to ever play professional baseball.
