Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Columbus Clippers play the finale of a five-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. Nashville has won the first four games of the series, including a 9-2 victory last night. Right-hander Victor Castaneda starts for the Sounds against right-hander Cody Morris for the Clippers.

Victor Castaneda: 23-year-old Victor Castaneda makes his second start for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander went 5-7 with a 5.20 ERA in 20 starts with Advanced-A Wisconsin. He allowed 90 hits and 37 walks to go along with 114 strikeouts. Castaneda made his Triple-A debut in a start at Gwinnett on September 19. He pitched 4.0 innings and allowed one run on four hits with six strikeouts. In 2019, he went 4-2 with a 4.50 ERA in 32 games (1 start) with Single-A Wisconsin. The 23-year-old is rated the 30th-best prospect in the Brewers organization and was signed by Milwaukee as an undrafted free agent on July 4, 2017.

Cody Morris: 24-year-old Cody Morris starts for the Clippers in the finale of the series tonight. The right-hander is 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA in 8 games (7 starts) with Columbus in 2021. Morris last pitched on September 19 in a start at Toledo. He allowed three runs on three hits and struck out seven. In 32.0 innings this year, Morris has allowed 23 hits and 10 walks to go along with 45 strikeouts. Cleveland selected Morris in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 59, Third: 5, Fourth: 47, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Triple-A Final Stretch: Tonight is game five of the Triple-A Final Stretch – a 10-game postseason-like tournament. Among the 30 teams in Triple-A Baseball, the team with the best record over the 10-game stretch will be crowned the Triple-A Final Stretch Champion. Nashville is 4-0 during the Final Stretch, tied with Durham for the best record.

Vs. Columbus: Nashville has enjoyed a lot of success against Columbus this season. The Sounds won the first seven games between the two clubs and have won six of the last nine meetings since then.

Crooked Number: The Sounds scored seven runs on five hits in the fifth inning of last night's win. It was fifth time Nashville has scored at least seven in an inning and first since they scored eight in the first frame on August 22 at Memphis.

All They do is Win: With a 67-56 record and six games remaining, the Sounds have clinched a winning record for the 26th time in franchise history. The last was in 2018 when Manager Fran Riordan steered the club to a 72-68 record. In 21 seasons as Manager at the Triple-A level, Rick Sweet has led his club to a winning record 15 times.

Home Sweet Home: The Sounds continue to enjoy success at home in 2021. The club is 40-24 at home compared to 27-32 on the road. The 40-24 mark is the fourth-best home record in the Triple-A East, behind Durham (45-20), Toledo (40-20) and Buffalo (42-22).

In the Danger Zone: Despite a record that is 11 games above .500 at 67-56, the 2021 Sounds team is in danger of setting the lowest team batting average in franchise history. With six games remaining, the Sounds are hitting .242 as a team, the sixth-worst mark among all Triple-A teams. The lowest team batting average in franchise history is .251 set by the 1988 team that went 73-69.

League Leader: Following Wednesday night's start, Josh Lindblom is now the Triple-A East League leader in ERA at 3.16 (35 ER/99.2). Lindblom has had a sub-3.00 ERA for most of the 2021 season but didn't have enough innings to qualify as the league leader. Lindblom is expected to make one more regular start next week against Indianapolis. The Sounds have had six ERA league leaders in franchise history: Rodney Bolton – 2.88 in 1995, Rodney Bolton – 2.88 in 1993, Chris Hammond – 2.17 in 1990, Stefan Wever – 2.78 in 1982, Andy McGaffigan – 2.38 in 1980 and Scott Brown – 2.40 in 1979.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
