**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve open the second half of their season with a six-game set against the Akron RubberDucks.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Charles McAdoo homered again and Po-Yu Chen spun 5.0 innings of 1-run ball as Altoona earned their 5th straight win at Bowie, 7-2, on Sunday.

**A NICE NUMBER REMAINS:** Altoona finished the first half with a 29-40 record, in 6th place in the SouthWest Division and the worst mark by an Eastern League team. The Curve, however, have played their best baseball in the last three weeks, picking up wins in 13-of-16 games to finish the First Half. The Curve's 29-40 mark was the just the third time in 25 seasons of play that Altoona has won fewer than 30 of their first 69 games in a season (2001 - 29 wins, 2004 - 24 wins).

**HE WILL McADOO:** Infielder Charles McAdoo made his Double-A debut with a bang on Saturday, June 23 at Bowie. McAdoo made a terrific play in the first inning in the field and then went 2B, BB, 2R HR in his first three at-bats for the Curve. McAdoo has homered in both games he has played for Altoona. He batted .336/.415/.561 with 15 2B, 4 3B, 9 HR, 52 RBI and 14-17 SB in 60 Games to start the year with Greensboro.

**BUBBA'S BURGERS:** On Friday, June 21 at Bowie, June 21 at Bowie, **Bubba Chandler** struck out a career-high 10 batters in 7.0 scoreless innings against Bowie. After allowing a leadoff double in the first, Chandler struck out 7 straight hitters and retired 16 straight men. He allowed 2 baserunners in the 6th before finishing off his career-long outing. Since his return from the IL on May 29, Chandler has walked just 3 batters in 22.2 IP with 27 strikeouts, recording a 2-2 record with a 2.78 ERA (7 ER / 22.2 IP) with a 0.97 WHIP. It was the third 10 strikeout game by a Curve pitcher this season after **Braxton Ashcraft** recorded a pair in May and early-June. Chandler was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week, the first to receive the honor since **Mike Burrows** and **Quinn Priester** took home weekly honors during the 2022 season.

**FEELING PEACHY:** Infielder **Kervin Pichardo** turned in a massive effort at the plate on Thursday, June 20 at Bowie, aiding the Curve to a 10-8 win in 12 innings. Pichardo picked up a career-high 4 hits as part of a 4-for-5 day at the plate with a homer and 3 RBI in the win. Pichardo has been one of the Eastern League's top hitters in the month of June during which he's hitting .361/.400/.492 with 2 2B, 2 HR and 7 RBI in 18 games. Entering play on Tuesday, July 25 he's got a hit in 11 straight games, the longest active streak in the Eastern League and ranks 9th in the league in batting average (.338), T-3rd in hits (24) and T-6th in runs (16) during the calendar month.

**A BIG ADDITION:** Finishing off his third week with Altoona, utilityman **Yoyner Fajardo** has reached base safely in 9 straight games, during which he's batting .361/.455/.389 with 1 2B, 4 RBI, 7 BB, 6-6 SB.

**SLAMMIN' SAMMY:** Outfielder **Sammy Siani** led the Curve to a 6-4 comeback win over Bowie on Wednesday, June 19. With a solo homer, and a run-scoring single as part of a 3-for-5 day at the plate, Siani also added a critical diving catch in right field in the 5th inning to support the Curve bullpen. In his last 8 games (June 14), Siani is batting .323/.417/.581/.998 OPS with 1 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR and 5 RBI, 5 BB and 3-3 SB.

**PETEY'S BIG FLIES:** Outfielder **Dustin Peterson** recorded his fourth career two-homer game in Altoona's 6-4 win over Richmond on Sunday, June 9. Peterson recorded the second multi-homer game by a Curve batter this season (Aaron Shackelford - April 9) and the 129th instance in franchise history. Peterson is batting .286/.375/.514/.889 with 2 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI during his current 9-game on-base streak (6/9 - Present).

**THE CHEN CHRONICLES:** Righty **Po-Yu Chen** overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as the calendar flipped to June. Chen fired a career-high 8.0 innings and struck out 9 on June 7 at Richmond to lead the Curve to a 3-1 win. Chen allowed just one run in three straight outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.67 ERA (10 ER / 33.2 IP) with 29 strikeouts.

**K SPELLS TROUBLE:** Altoona has struck out at least 10 times at the plate in a game 33 times this season in 69 games.

**THE RUBBERDUCKIES:** Greg DiCenzo takes over for the 'Ducks after spending last season as the Bench Coach at Triple-A Columbus. 2024 is Dizenzo's fourth season working in the Guardians system after spending 12 years as the Head Coach for Holy Cross where he led his team to 20 or more wins 10 times. Akron has several top prospects in their lineup including OF Chase DeLauter, OF Petey Halpin, INF Milan Tolentino and INF Kahlil Watson.

**THE FIRST QUACKER:** Ryan Webb takes the ball on Wednesday night for the 'Ducks. Webb was Cleveland's 4th round pick in 2021 out of Georgia, and has pitched twice against Altoona this season, during which he's allowed 6 runs in 10.2 IP. Webb has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 9 of his 13 starts this season, leading to a 3.09 ERA. He led all pitchers in the Arizona Fall League with 36 strikeouts last October. Webb appears to be a huge Atlanta Falcons fan and is rightly perplexed by their draft day decisions according to his Twitter account.

Features a four-seam fastball, slider and change-up

**CAREER TRANSACTIONS:** Drafted by the San Diego Padres in the 6th round in 2019 out of Vanderbilt... Traded to the Pirates in the 3-team deal between San Diego, the New York Mets and Pirates that netted RHP David Bednar, LHP Omar Cruz, OF Hudson Head and C Endy Rodriguez that sent RHP Joe Musgrove to San Diego and LHP Joey Lucchesi from San Diego to New York...

**CURVE CUTS:** Drake Robert Fellows... Went 13-2 with a 4.09 ERA in his final season for the NCAA Champion Vanderbilt Commodores... Majored in sociology at Vandy... At the time of the draft MLB Pipeline wrote: "His pitches may be better, but Fellows hasn't harnessed them as well as he had previously. He has been hit harder and battled his control more than in his first two seasons. He'll need to regain his previous command to reach his ceiling as a No. 4 starter, but teams do value his competitiveness and long track record of success in the Southeastern Conference"... **Was diagnosed with anaplastic large cell lymphoma in the summer of 2019 after winning the National Championship with Vanderbilt, was declared cancer-free after treatments that summer and fall... Underwent Tommy John surgery in August of 2021 and missed the entire 2022 season and much of 2023...** Attended Joliet Catholic Academy in Joliet, Ind... Grew up on the south side of Chicago competing with Pirates OF Jack Suwinski and Guardians INF Owen Miller... Was ranked as Perfect Game's top pitcher in the state of Indiana in their 2016 High School class... Son of Robert and Annie Fellows, has two brothers, Carter and Jaden... Signed with the Padres for a bonus of \$260,000, slightly under the slot recommendation of \$289,000... Shared a clubhouse with several future major leaguers at Vandy, including RHP Kyle Wright '17 (Braves/Royals), C Jason Delay '17 (Pirates), JJ Bleday '19 (Athletics) and RHP Collin Snider '17 (Royals/Mariners) as well as RHP Kumar Rocker...
