FRISCO WALKS 14 IN LOSS TO MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders took two early leads but the Midland RockHounds racked up seven runs in the fifth inning and won 16-4 on Saturday at Riders Field. Frisco (5-6, 36-43) allowed a franchise record 14 walks in the ballgame to go with 18 hits from Midland (8-3, 40-40). Josh Hatcher banged a three-run homer off the waterfall in right field to put Frisco ahead 3-0 in the second inning. Trevor Hauver and Aaron Zavala started the rally despite both encountering 0-2 counts. Hauver drew a walk, Zavala singled, and both scored on Hatcher's homer. Midland tied the score with three runs in the fourth, but Frisco jumped back in front the next half inning. Luisangel Acuña singled to shallow right field to score Liam Hicks, who had doubled to lead off the frame. It was Acuña's 10th single of the series and the first of two singles on the night, putting him at 11-for-21 on the week. He also is now riding a hitting streak of 12 games. Noah Bremer's third start for Frisco in 2023 was a strong one, going 2.2 scoreless innings with two strikeouts. His 54 pitches were the most he had thrown for the RoughRiders since returning from Tommy John surgery. Thomas Saggese collected three hits including a double and is now 9-for-18 versus Midland this week. Jack Cushing (3-3) went five innings with four runs allowed in his start for Midland to take the win. Aidan Anderson (0-2) gave up the go-ahead run in the fifth, allowing five runs. The RockHounds scored seven runs in the fifth, including three runs on a fly ball that dropped in center field amid gusty winds.

WALK SIGN IS ON:

The RoughRiders have had a tough time with their command in this series against Midland. On Saturday, the RoughRiders walked a franchise record 14 Midland batters and on the week, Frisco has walked a Texas Leauge high 34 batters over the five games of the set so far while owning a 9.66 ERA. The RoughRiders' 2.20 WHIP over the last five games is the highest in Minor League Baseball among teams who have played five games.

WELCOME BACK CARTER

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 16 games since his return, he has seven multi-hit games, batting .381 (24-for-63)/.444/.651/1.095 with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBIs and 13 runs scored. Carter is now seventh in the Texas League in batting average (.305) and sixth in OBP (.415).

RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just seventh in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .255, though Frisco is fourth with 311 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 21 games (9-12 record), Frisco is hitting .257 (52-for-202) in those situations.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. He had a 15-game hitting streak ended on Thursday. In that streak, Saggese hit. 443 (27-for-61)/.507/.803/1.310 with five doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, eight walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks. Over his last 28 games, he is hitting .385/.473/.706/1.179 with eight home runs and 25 RBIs. Saggese is currently on an eight-game hitting streak, batting .448 (13-for-29) during that stretch.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League with a .615 average (16-for-26) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.643 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .463 (25-for-54) on the initial offering while his 25 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

SPEED KILLS

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 34 and is on pace for a career-best 62 swipes. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 107 bases in 127 attempts (84 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect hit .300/.336/.460/.796 in June. Currently on an 12-game hitting streak, he is hitting .423/.455/.519/.974 during this stretch, including a four-hit game in game one of the doubleheader on Friday. He is fifth in the Texas League in batting average (.316), third in hits (97), sixth in doubles (19), third in runs (56) and first in steals (34). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (119).

On the season, Frisco's 384 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .355 team OBP is second in the Texas League. The Riders have three in the top nine players in Texas League walk rate this season: **Dustin Harris** (3rd, 15.8%), **Trevor Hauver** (4th, 15.8%) and **Evan Carter** (9th, 14.4%). Though he is not qualified for the standings, **Aaron Zavala** is walking at a 17.7% rate so far this season.

ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrines College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
