Series Finales:	3-8	Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley makes his league-leading 14th start of the season tonight. The right-hander is 3-3 with a 4.68 ERA (55.1 IP/30 ER) this season. He took the loss his last time out, pitching five innings in game one of the June 7 twin bill in Jacksonville. Boushley allowed two runs (1 ER) on six hits. The UW-La Crosse product finished tied for the league lead in wins last year, posting a 12-2 record with a 3.25 ERA in 25 starts. The right-hander was originally drafted in the 33rd round by San Diego in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of UW-La Crosse and was acquired by Milwaukee in the Triple-A phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft.

The right-hander is 2-1 with a 3.86 ERA (30.1 IP/13 ER) in 13 games (three starts) at the Triple-A level in 2023. Rodriguez started the season with Triple-A St. Paul in the Twins organization, making six appearances with the Saints. He's also appeared once apiece with Minnesota and Atlanta, posting a 3.38 ERA (2.2 IP/1 ER). Rodriguez has played in 55 Major League games (35 starts) with San Francisco (2018-20), Minnesota (2022-23) and Atlanta (23). He was claimed off waiver by Atlanta on May 27. Rodriguez was originally drafted by Minnesota in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Monsignor Edward Pace High School in Miami Gardens, Florida.

LAST OUTING: Boushley took the loss his last time out, tossing 5.0 innings in the first game of a June 7 twin bill at Jacksonville. He allowed two runs (one earned) on six hits. He walked three and punched out seven, tying a personal season-high. Boushley navigated around trouble in the second and third, stranding five in those frames and allowing just one run.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley is 1-1 with a 2.29 ERA (19.2 IP/5 ER) and 17 strikeouts in four career starts against Gwinnett. He took a no decision in Nashville's 4-3 loss to Gwinnett on May 12, allowing one run in five innings.
