RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (17-19, 53-49)

AT

Lake Elsinore Storm (21-15, 61-41)

RHP Edgardo Henriquez (2-3, 4.24 ERA) vs. LHP Drew Pomeranz (0-0, -- ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes open a critical road trip tonight in Lake Elsinore (San Diego Padres) with game one of a six-game series at The Diamond. The Quakes return home next Tuesday to face Modesto. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the 19th of 30 head-to-head meetings between the two teams and the 13th of 18 here at The Diamond. The Quakes are 6-6 here in Lake Elsinore and 8-8 overall against the Storm in 2022.

LAST GAME: The Quakes failed to split the six-game series with Inland Empire, as they dropped Sunday's finale at LoanMart Field by a final of 10-3. Quakes' pitching struggled, issuing ten walks and hitting a batter. Jimmy Lewis (0-1) gave up three runs on two hits with two walks over 2.1 innings in his first appearance for the Quakes in 2022. Inland Empire got two hits and three RBIs from Edgar Quero, who smacked a go-ahead homer in the fifth inning. Rancho mustered just six hits, with Yuniar Garcia and Nick Biddison each recording a two-hit game. Inland Empire reliever Julio Goff (7-8) got the win with four innings of relief.

SECOND STRAIGHT SERIES LOSS: The Quakes dropped four of six in each of the last two series (at San Jose and vs Inland Empire) and are now four games behind Inland Empire in the Second Half Standings. If the Quakes can't win the second half, they'll be rooting for the First Half Champion Lake Elsinore Storm to do so, as that would mean the Quakes would need to finish with the next best overall record. Currently, the Quakes (53-49) are tied with Inland Empire (53-49) with identical overall records.

PLENTY O' MOVES: The Quakes made a roster move earlier today, as infielder Kenneth Betancourt was transferred to Double-A Tulsa and catcher/first baseman Griffin Lockwood-Powell was activated from the Injured List. Rancho made a total of nine roster moves on Thursday, after making six on Wednesday. Thursday's additions included the activation of catcher Yeiner Fernandez from the Temporary Inactive List and four players who were all drafted in the 2022 draft. Catcher Dalton Rushing (second rounder), outfielder Nick Biddison (fourth rounder), infielder Sean McLain (fifth rounder) and outfielder Kyle Nevin (11th rounder) all made their debuts last night. Gone from the active roster are infielder Hector Martinez (released) catcher Jorge Puerta and Javier Armas (sent to the ACL), and catcher Marco Hernandez (placed on the Developmental List). Congratulations goes out to Damon Keith and Austin Gauthier, who were promoted to Great Lakes of the High-A Midwest League on Wednesday.

NEW GUYS ALREADY CHIPPING IN: The Quakes have added several new players to the roster who are already contributing. Bubba Alleyne is 6-for-15 (.400) with five runs scored in four games, while Dalton Rushing is 5-for-10 (.500) with three RBIs over three games so far. Kyle Nevin got in the hit column on Saturday night for the first time in three games, as he recorded his first two hits as a pro and his first RBI in the 9-4 win. Sean McLain homered on Friday and Taylor Young had the game-winning hit on Thursday. Nick Biddison was the last "new" Quake to get in the hit-column, going 2-for-4 on Sunday.

EDGARDO HENRIQUEZ: Right-hander Edgardo Henriquez makes his 14th appearance and his 13th start of the year, his second appearance and second start against Lake Elsinore. In one prior start against the Storm, he's 0-0, allowing just one hit over four scoreless innings. In his last start, he allowed one run on four hits over two innings in a no-decision versus Inland Empire on August 3. Henriquez was signed by the Dodgers in 2018 out of Venezuela.

DREW POMERANZ: The Storm will open the series with rehabbing San Diego Padre LHP Drew Pomeranz making his first rehab start for the Storm and just his second rehab of the year. In his first rehab appearance (ACL Padres), he struck out two of the three batters he faced on August 5. Pomeranz hasn't pitched for the Padres since 2021, when he went 1-0 with a 1.75 ERA in 27 relief outings. Pomeranz has seen time with seven different big-league clubs and is currently in his second stint as a Padre, after signing with them during the 2019 off-season. Pomeranz was originally the fifth overall pick (Cleveland) in the 2010 draft out of Mississippi. Pomeranz is expected to be followed by originally-scheduled starter Duncan Snider.
