These are the final meetings of the year in the 18-game season series between the two clubs; Lansing is 4-9 vs. Lake County this season after winning the opener yesterday.

Last Night: Locos 7, Picantes 6. In an all-Copa matchup, Lansing built a 7-2 lead and held off Lake County on Tuesday night in front of 2,912. Knuckleballer **Devin Kirby-Williams** gave up two runs in five innings, striking out four, and DH **Jake Reinisch** went 3-for-4 with an RBI single and an RBI triple to give Lansing its fourth straight win.

Lugnut League Leaders: SS Ali Camarillo is tied for 5th in the Midwest League in doubles (21), tied for 7th in base hits (87) and 10th in batting average (.286); promoted P Zane Taylor is 1st in ERA (3.22) and batting average against (.234); P Samuel Dutton is tied for 1st in innings pitched (96 1/3); and P Steven Echavarria ranks 5th in innings (87 2/3) and 5th in average (.261).

Debut Day: Yesterday marked the Lansing debut of A's No. 8 prospect **Breyson Guedez** ("GED-es"), who finished 0-for-4. It also saw the professional debuts with the Class-A Stockton Ports of A's 2026 first-rounder **Drew Burress** (1-for-3, walk, homered in his first at-bat); fourth-rounder **Roman Martin** (2-for-4, two singles); fifth-rounder **Alex Hernandez** (0-for-4, four strikeouts); and sixth-rounder **Alex Sosa** (1-for-4, RBI single, two strikeouts, stolen base) in a 5-4 loss to San Jose.

MLB Trade Deadline: Three former Lugnuts were traded at the deadline. 2015-2016 Lansing outfielder **Lane Thomas** was traded by the Kansas City Royals to the Atlanta Braves; 2022 Lugnuts outfielder **Colby Thomas** (no relation) was traded by the A's to the Philadelphia Phillies; and 2025-2026 Lugnuts starter **Kyle Robinson** was traded for the second time this season, dealt by the Pirates to the Angels.

July's Best: With July concluded, the Nuts were led by...

- **Jared Sprague-Lott** posted an .847 OPS, batting .306/.423/.424, with a team-leading 20 runs, 36 total bases, 8 steals and 17 walks in 22 games.
- **Ali Camarillo** hit a team-leading .313, tying Sprague-Lott with 26 base hits in 22 games, drawing 12 walks compared to nine strikeouts.
- **Abel Mercedes** recorded a 0.00 ERA, allowing two unearned runs in seven appearances while giving up just two hits in 27 batters faced.

Home Cooking: The Lugnuts have won four straight games at home to improve 25-22 in Lansing this year, compared to 18-35 on the road. That's a better home record than West Michigan (23-30), Fort Wayne (21-28) and Lake County (26-25).

Major League Lugnuts: Nine former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics. Bolte, Jump and White join **Brady Basso**, **Hogan Harris**, **Luis Morales**, **Jack Perkins**, **Jacob Wilson**, **Lawrence Butler** and **Tyler Soderstrom** on the Athletics' current roster, meaning that former Lugnuts comprise 40% of the A's 25-man roster.

Induction Day: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted on July 26 into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

AUGUST 5 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: 19-year-old Miguel Castro made his Lugnuts debut at Fort Wayne, allowing a first-inning home run to TinCaps prospect Trea Turner en route to allowing five runs on three hits and one walk, striking out five, in four innings. The Lugnuts lost, 7-1.

2015: In his Lugnuts debut, Clinton Hollon allowed a leadoff single to Wisconsin and then pitched hitless ball the rest of the way, retiring the final 19 batters he faced, as the Nuts beat the Timber Rattlers, 2-1, at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2019: The Lugnuts split a doubleheader at Bowling Green, losing 3-1 and winning 6-3. In Game 1, Troy Watson tossed a six-inning complete game but was outpitched by Caleb Sampen's six innings, and Ruben Cardenas homered to boost the Hot Rods. Let's talk about Game 2: Cobi Johnson fired five hitless innings, walking three and striking out seven. The Lugnuts brought that no-hitter and a 3-0 lead to the sixth. With one out, Jonathan Aranda busted up the no-hit bid with a two-run homer. Four batters later, Seaver Whalen broke out of a 3-for-49 slump with a two-out game-tying RBI single. But the Lugnuts countered with three runs in the seventh on a throwing error by lefty Michael Costanzo and a two-run wild pitch by Costanzo, scoring both Otto Lopez from third and Reggie Pruitt from second.
