TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: Altoona opens the season with a three-game set against Chesapeake Baysox. The Baysox are managed by Roberto Mercado, who's in his second season leading the Baltimore Orioles Double-A affiliate. Their roster features several Top 30 prospects, including Enrique Bradfield Jr.

On the mound, righty Alex Pham takes the ball in the series opener for the Baysox. Pham was Baltimore's 19th round pick in 2021 out of the University of San Francisco where he played four seasons and ranks 7th in program history with 213 strikeouts. He made 5 starts against the Curve last season, going 2-1 with a 3.51 ERA, he struck out 27 batters in 25.2 IP and held the Curve to a 0.94 WHIP.

**2024 IN REVIEW:** The Curve totaled a 62-76 mark during the 2024 season, marking the 11th time in franchise history that Altoona finished with a record under .500. Since the cancelled 2020 season, Altoona has had a winning record just one time (2022) in four seasons.

Returners **Kervin Pichardo** (Team MVP) and **Sammy Siani** (Unsung Hero) return to the Curve lineup.

PROSPECTS PARTY: Seven Curve players are ranked among the Pirates Top 30 according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America. Termarr Johnson (No. 4 MLB/No. 5 BA) headlines the group, which also features LHP Hunter Barco (No. 7/No. 10), INF Jack Brannigan (No. 11/No. 14), INF/OF Mitch Jebb (No. 13/No. 14), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 14/No. 15), RHP Alessandro Ercolani (No. 21 BA), RHP Wilber Dotel (No. 27 BA).

THE TRACKS TO PITTSBURGH RIDE THROUGH ALTOONA: Five alumni went on to make their major league debut during the 2024 season. RHP Jared Jones (3/30, PIT), RHP Paul Skenes (5/11, PIT), C Grant Koch (5/29, PIT), LHP Luis Peralta (8/24, COL) and RHP Mike Burrows (9/28, PIT) all reached the major leagues for the first time.

In 2025. RHP **Thomas Harrington** (4/1, PIT) and LHP **Omar Cruz** (4/1, SD) have both made their major league debut, totaling 219 alumni who have gone onto the major leagues.

A YOUNG MAN'S ARRIVAL: Infielder Termarr Johnson joined the Curve on Tuesday, August 27, 2024 and at 20 years, 2 months and 16 days, <u>Johnson became the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve, behind Jose</u> Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve. At High-A Greensboro in 2024, Johnson helped the Grasshoppers earn a First Half title and batted .238/.372/.385/.757 with 17 2B, 1 3B, 13 HR, 46 RBI and 20-24 SB. He earned 78 walks in 110 games played. He ranked first in the SAL in walks (78) and runs scored (73), fifth in OBP (.372) and eighth in hits (94).

Johnson's first Double-A hit was a two-run homer off New Hampshire's Nick Fraze on Wednesday. August 28. Johnson's 85 walks last season were 9th-most by a minor league player and he reached base safely in 9-of-14 games with the Curve.

SAMMY SLAMS IN THE SECOND HALF: Outfielder Sammy Siani turned a corner at the plate in his final 36 games of the seson. From July 30 to the end of the season, he batted: .295/.372/.394/.766 with 6 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 11 RBI, and 5-7 SB.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

### **ALTOONA CURVE COACHING STAFF**

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

### Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

### Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

### Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and joins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

### Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.
