LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox fell one run short of collecting their second-consecutive win on Thursday night, falling to the Richmond Flying Squirrels 5-4. Bowie trailed 3-0 after the first inning, but recovered to tie the game at three by the third inning, thanks in part to Andrew Dashcbach's third home run of the season. Richmond used single runs in the fifth and seventh innings to push back ahead, while holding Bowie to just 1-for-16 at the plate with runners in scoring position. Richmond strung together five-consecutive base hits against Drew Rom in the first inning to plate the first three runs of the game. Rom would only be able to finish three innings thanks to an inflated pitch count.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Richmond and Bowie meet for the second time this month, after the Squirrels took two out of three at Prince George's Stadium over the opening weekend of the season. Richmond has only managed .500 ball since Opening Weekend, however, after taking four-of-six from Altoona in their first homestand of the year, but having the inverse happen on their recent road trip to Erie. While they did play fewer innings because of a doubleheader, Richmond struggled with Erie's league-leading pitching, scoring only 20 runs over the course of the six-game series.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Gray Fenter makes his second start of the season for Richmond, and fifth appearance overall. Very familiar with the Orioles organization and the Bowie Baysox, Fenter is a former top-30 prospect in the system, and spent all of the 2021 season on the Baysox roster, pitching mostly in the rotation. With Bowie, Fenter went 6-4 on the mound with a 5.47 ERA, striking out 86 batters, walking 48, and giving up 12 home runs. Fenter faced the Baysox in a relief role on April 9, when he walked three batters and allowed two hits with a run in one inning pitched. Fenter was notable for his fastball that could touch 97 in high school, which drew the Orioles to draft him in 2015, but Tommy John surgery in 2016 cut a couple of ticks off of the speedometer.

DASCH-ING THROUGH THE SNOW

Bowie first baseman Andrew Daschbach swatted his third home run of the season on Thursday evening in Richmond to break a four-game hitless skid, and plating two runs to cut into Richmond's 3-0 lead. Despite going only 1-for-16 over his previous six games entering Thursday, he still drew nine walks against 11 strikeouts. Both of Daschbach's previous home runs this season came in the Binghamton series. Sandwiched between the home runs, Daschbach struck out 11 times at the plate, including a five-strikeout day on Thursday. Daschbach was known for his strikeouts in 2021, his 144 strikeouts were the second-most in the Orioles system, behind only Kyle Stowers (171)

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie had an early handle on one-run games this season, but have dropped their last two. With four of their last seven games coming down to just one run, the Baysox are 3-2 overall on one-run games. It's looking like the Baysox may see plenty of one-run games this season, as their five one-run games are the fewest in the Southwest Division. Despite just under half of their games being decided by three or fewer runs, Bowie's +20 run differential is the second-highest in the league, mostly thanks to their 20-6 win over Akron on 4/19 and their 10-0 win over Richmond on 4/27.

INTO THE GROUND

Bowie's patience at the plate has been a constant pain for opposing pitchers. Three of Bowie's main infielders have seen more pitches than almost every other player in the Eastern League. Andrew Daschbach currently leads the League with 347 pitches seen, Jordan Westburg is sixth with 310, and Gunnar Henderson is seventh with 305.

BUSY BATTERIES

This series between Bowie and Richmond should stand to see plenty of strikeouts as it continues through the week. Richmond is second in the Eastern League with 205 strikeouts at the plate, Bowie is not too far behind at 201, the third-most in the League. Bowie has been climbing the charts recently, however, as they lead the League with 107 strikeouts since April 18, including two different games where they struck out 17 times.
