TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Salt Lake Bees will play game two of the series on Wednesday night with first pitch scheduled for 7:05 p.m. at Dell Diamond. Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Max Scherzer is scheduled to toe the rubber for Round Rock against Salt Lake RHP Davis Daniel.

STARTING THE SERIES RIGHT

The Express earned an 8-5 win on Tuesday over the Bees in the series opener. Salt Lake RF Jason Martin hit a solo homer in the first inning. In the third, C Chad Wallach singled then scored on a single from LF Jordyn Adams to make it a 2-0 game. DH Elmer Hernandez hit a solo home run in the third for the E-Train. RF Sandro Fabian and LF Dustin Harris both scored in the fourth thanks to RBI singles from SS Jonathan Ornelas and 3B Jantzen Witte, respectively. The Bees put one on the board in the sixth and seventh to take a 4-3 lead. DH Willie Calhoun scored in the sixth thanks to a bases-loaded walk for CF Bryce Teodosio and SS Elliot Soto was plated in the seventh after an Express error. Fabian put the E-Train in front, 5-4, in the bottom of the seventh inning with a two-RBI single. In the eighth, Salt Lake 2B Cole Tucker tied the game at five when Soto sent him home on a sacrifice bunt. Round Rock surged ahead in the home half of the eighth thanks to a two-RBI single off the bat of Hernandez and a groundout from Crim that sent Hill across home plate. Express RHP Yerry Rodríguez struck out three straight Bees batters to secure the 8-5 final score.

HAPPY SCHERZ-DAY

Texas Rangers RHP Max Scherzer is expected to make a rehab start on Wednesday at Dell Diamond. Scherzer is returning from off-season back surgery. He is a two-time World Series Champion, three-time Cy Young Award winner and eight-time All-Star. The right-hander is MLB's active leader in strikeouts (3,367) and he is 11th on the all-time strikeouts list as one of only 19 players to reach 3,000 or more career strikeouts in MLB history.

LAMBIN VS SCHERZER

Express Bench Coach and Acting Manager this week, Chase Lambin, is very familiar with RHP Max Scherzer. The last time Scherzer made a start in the minors that was not on a rehab assignment came on May 25, 2010 with Triple-A Toledo. He went 7.0 innings with seven strikeouts en route to a win. Lambin batted fifth that day for the Syracuse Chiefs and went 2-for-3 including a double off Scherzer. After Scherzer left the game, RHP Jay Sborz, the older brother of former Express RHP Josh Sborz, tossed the final 2.0 innings. Lambin took Sborz deep with a two-run homer.

SCHERZER HAS STUNG THE BEES

This is not the first time RHP Max Scherzer has faced the Salt Lake Bees. The righty has made only 36 appearances in the minors since he was drafted in 2007, but the first start of his Triple-A career came against Salt Lake in 2008. He made two starts that season against the Bees while he was with Triple-A Tucson. In his first outing, he went 5.0 innings of shutout baseball with two hits and seven strikeouts. In his second outing he went 5.1 innings with three earned runs and seven strikeouts.

SANDRO STAYS HOT

Express OF Sandro Fabian is riding a four-game hitting streak and is 9-for-17 in that span. This season, Fabian leads the club in batting average, (.391), on-base percentage (.426), slugging percentage (.563) and RBI (18).

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

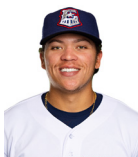
