FOR STARTERS: The Trash Pandas continue their road trip on Wednesday morning with game two (1-0) of a six-game series against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field.

Rocket City is currently in the middle of its longest road trip of the 2026 season, spanning stops in Pensacola and Birmingham. The Trash Pandas are 5-2 on the trip so far, highlighted by a 4-2 series victory over the Pensacola Blue Wahoos from May 5-10 at Blue Wahoos Stadium.

FLINT, BULLPEN DELIVER IN 3-2 WIN: Rocket City got back to .500 on Tuesday night with a series-opening 3-2 victory over the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field. The Pandas' bullpen dealt 4.2 scoreless innings, while Tucker Flint drove in two, including a ninth-inning RBI single to put the Pandas up for good. Gustavo Campero was 2-for-4 with a run, and stolen base, while Flint was 2-for-3 with a walk.

ANOTHER ONE-RUN GAME: Tuesday's 3-2 victory marked Rocket City's second straight win in a one-run game after previously dropping seven consecutive such contests on the road. Overall, the Trash Pandas are 3-9 in one-run games this season, with their 12 one-run decisions tied for the most in the Southern League and tied for second-most in Double-A.

BULLPEN BRILLIANT: Over the current road trip, the Trash Pandas bullpen has allowed just one unearned run across 26.0 innings while logging four saves, striking out 26, and walking 10. Over the last 13 games, Rocket City relievers own a Double-A best 1.81 ERA and are 6-for-6 in save opportunities. Since 5/2, Rocket City's pen has allowed just one earned run over 32.2 innings pitched, the top ERA in Double-A at 0.28. Over the first 21 games, the bullpen posted a 5.40 ERA, and six blown saves.

Scoreless Streaks: Leonard Garcia (6G, 9.2 IP), Lucas Mahlstedt (6G, 6.2 IP), Kenyon Yovan (6G, 5.1 IP), and Luke Murphy (5G, 7.0 IP), have streaks without allowing an earned run ongoing.

IN THE NICK OF TIME: Nick Rodriguez had his 19-game on-base streak end on Tuesday. Over the streak which began on 4/17, he hit .306 batting average, and .413 OBP.

GETTING RAUDI: Raudi Rodriguez has reached safely in 23 of 24 games, since 4/12, batting .309, with a .462 OBP. Raudi is the only Double-A player this season with 25+ runs scored, 25+ walks, 10+ steals, and a .400+ OBP.

His 22-game on-base streak was the longest streak by a Panda since 2024 (Gustavo Campero, 27, Tucker Flint 27).

Since 4/21, Raudi leads the league with 19 runs, and is 2nd with a .463 on-base percentage, and .311 batting average over his last 18 games.

THE LEAGUE'S TOP HITTER: Wade Meckler has led the Southern League in batting, and OBP for most of the 2026 season. He led the league in batting, OBP, and OPS in April.

RUN SCORERS: Gustavo Campero has played in 27 of 34 games this season, but leads the league, and is T-3rd in Double-A with 30 runs scored

AGAINST THE BARONS: The Trash Pandas are 4-3 vs. Birmingham this season and hold a 75-69 all-time advantage in the series, including a 39-34 at Regions Field and a 36-35 mark at Toyota Field. Rocket City went 8-16 against the White Sox affiliate in 2025. The North Division rivals will meet 27 times in 2026, with Birmingham visiting Toyota Field again August 4-9. The Pandas will also make two more trips to Regions Field, July 17-19 and August 25-30.

HISTORIC RUN-SCORING START: The Pandas are T-3rd in the Southern League, and rank 11th in Double-A with 186 runs scored (5.5 per game), and scored 4+ runs in 76% of games (26 of 34). **It's the most runs scored through 34 games in club history, and T-15th most in the Southern League since 2005.**

SCORING IS UP IN THE SL: So far this season, Southern League teams are averaging 5.2 runs per game, which is over a run higher than last season through 33 games at 4.0 in 2025. The 12.3% walk rate (1st), and 294 homers (2nd) are among high marks in the SL since 2005.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Wade Meckler leads the league in batting (.351), and OBP (.460), 5th in OPS (.992), 9th in slugging (.529), T-4th in hits (33), and T-9th in walks (19). ... Gustavo Campero ranks 1st with 30 runs ... Tucker Flint is T-4th in doubles (8) ... Nick Rodriguez is T-4th in in doubles (8) ... Raudi Rodriguez is 2nd in runs (27), 4th in walks (27), T-6th in stolen bases (13), 9th in OBP (.416) and T-10th in RBIs (21) ... Harold Coll is T-1st in HBP (6), and T-5th in RBIs (23) ... Jose Gonzalez is 3rd in strikeouts (39), 1st in innings pitched (36.1), 3rd in ERA (3.96), 9th in opponent's batting average (.226), and 10th in WHIP (1.27) ... Ryan Costeiu is T-2nd in wins (3) ... RHP Austin Gordon is 6th in innings pitched (33.1), 4th in opponent's batting average (.207), 6th in WHIP (1.20), and 9th in ERA (4.32) ... Joel Hurtado is T-6th in ERA (3.99) ... Camden Minacci is T-3rd in appearances (12) ... Kenyon Yovan is T-1st in saves (4) ... Luke Murphy is T-1st in saves (4).

WELCOME BACK KYREN: INF Kyren Paris was activated to Rocket City's roster on 5/1, and has reached safely in nine of his first 10 games, including six RBIs. The 24-year-old played in 150 games for the Trash Pandas from 2022-24, batting .239 with 26 doubles, 19 home runs, 60 RBIs, and a .375 OBP. He set the franchise single-season record with 44 stolen bases in 2023, when he posted a .393 OBP with 14 homers and 79 runs scored over 113 games. He made his MLB debut for the Angels in 2023, and has appeared in 80 Major League games.

SCORING CHANCES: The Trash Pandas lead the league, and are 2nd in Double-A with 447 plate appearances with runners in scoring position, ranking 6th in Double-A with a .392 OBP, and 146 RBI. Rocket City is 3rd in Double-A with 60 plate appearances with the bases loaded, ranking 8th with a .400 OBP, 40 RBIs, and 11 walks.

BIG LEAGUE EXPERIENCE: With the addition of INF Kyren Paris, four current Pandas carry MLB experience.

2026 GAME INFORMATION

MAKING THE JUMP FROM LOW-A: INF Harold Coll, INF Nick Rodriguez, and OF Raudi Rodriguez are all making the jump from Low-A to Double-A, bypassing High-A Tri-City altogether.

LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: RHP Coleman Crow became the 49th player in franchise history to make their Major League debut, doing so during the Milwaukee Brewers' game on on April 17 in Miami. Crow joins fellow pitching alums **Walbert Urena** (3/26 for LAA) and **George Klassen** (4/5 for LAA) on making their MLB debuts this season. Originally selected by the Angels, Crow was acquired by Milwaukee in December 2023 after prior stints in the Angels and Mets organizations. Crow spent part of the 2022-23 season with Rocket City, where he ranked among the franchise's career leaders in innings pitched (152), strikeouts (159), wins (11), and starts (27). He earned Southern League Pitcher of the Week honors three times in 2022 and was named Pitcher of the Month in June of that season. Notably, Crow threw six hitless innings in a combined no-hitter on April 8, 2023, vs. Chattanooga, in a seven-inning game at Toyota Field. The infamous game included Rocket City issuing five walks, four hit batters, and committing an error, allowing seven runs without surrendering a hit—one of the rare instances in professional baseball history of a team throwing a no-hitter and losing. RHP **George Klassen**, 24, made his Major League debut with the Los Angeles Angels on Sunday against Seattle at Angel Stadium, becoming the 48th former Trash Panda to reach the Majors, and second so far in 2026. A native of West Bend, Indiana, Klassen worked 2.2 innings, allowing two runs while striking out four, and the Angels went on to win the game 8-7 in 11 innings. Ranked as the Angels' No. 4 prospect by MLB Pipeline, Klassen was a key member of Rocket City's 2025 rotation, earning a Futures Game selection and ranking among the franchise leaders in starts during his first full Double-A season. **Walbert Urena** became the 47th player in franchise history to make his Major League debut, doing so during the Los Angeles Angels' Opening Day win over the Houston Astros on March 26.

HIGH SCHOOL TEAMMATES REUNITE: RHP Camden Minacci, and INF Nick Rodriguez reunite in Rocket City after being teammates at Tampa Jesuit High School. Minacci was the Florida 6A Player of the Year in 2020, and Rodriguez, a year younger, graduating in 2021. Both played under head coach Miguel Menendez.

2026 SCHEDULE: The complete 138-game schedule will run from April 3 to Sunday, September 13 ... The first half of the season will conclude with a six-game series against Montgomery at Toyota Field from June 16-21. The regular season will wrap up with another six-game series at Chattanooga, scheduled for September 8-13. The final home series at Toyota Field will take place from September 1-6 against Montgomery.

GLOBAL BASEBALL SERIES: The Trash Pandas picked up a 6-3 win over Japan's Toyota Red Cruisers on April 1 at Toyota Field. **Tucker Flint** led the way offensively, homering twice and reaching base four times. The victory capped the three-game Global Baseball Series in front of a crowd of 4,355. The Red Cruisers are the official industrial team for TOYOTA Japan.

2025 SEASON IN REVIEW: The Trash Pandas, managed by **Andy Schatzley** concluded their fifth season with a 45-92 record, finishing fourth in the Southern League's North Division, 35.5 games behind the champion Birmingham Barons. Rocket City went 24-45 at Toyota Field and 21-47 on the road, being outscored 637-445 for a -192 run differential. In the first half, the Trash Pandas posted a 24-44 record, placing fourth, 15 games back of the Chattanooga Lookouts. The team went 13-26 at home and 11-19 on the road, ending the half on a nine-game losing streak, including a seven-game sweep by Chattanooga, a new club record. Rocket City scored 219 runs while allowing 310. The second half saw the team finish 21-48, again fourth in the

division and 22 games behind Birmingham. The Trash Pandas went 11-19 at home and 10-29 on the road, scoring 226 runs while surrendering 327.

NEW TO THE ANGELS ORGANIZATION: **Elijah Dunham** (NYY), **Jose Gonzalez** (TEX), **Eybersson Polanco** (Rule 5, BOS), and **JJ D'Orazio** (ARI) are all making their Angels organizational debut this weekend.

NEW COACHING STAFF: **Joe Kruzel** was named manager of the Rocket City Trash Pandas prior to the 2026 season, becoming the third manager in franchise history following **Jay Bell** (2021) and **Andy Schatzley** (2022-25). Kruzel enters the role with more than 30 years of coaching experience at the professional and collegiate levels. The 2026 season marks his first year managing in the Angels' system after serving four seasons in a developmental leadership role. His all-time managerial record is 473-472. Joining Kruzel in Madison this season are **Daren Brown** (Coach), **Tim Leveque** (Pitching Coach), **Doug Henry** (Assistant Pitching Coach), **Tony Jaramillo** (Hitting Coach), **Dylan Culwell** (Athletic Trainer), **Chase Galloway** (Assistant Athletic Trainer), **Matt Gabriel** (Strength and Conditioning Coach), **Tristan Saglime** (Game Planning Strategist), and **Joe Wike** (Video Assistant).

ANGELS PROSPECTS: The veteran team currently has four players among the Angels' top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: RHP **Chris Cortez** (No. 12), OF **Raudi Rodriguez** (No. 15), RHP **Joael Hurtado** (No. 22), and RHP **Austin Gordon** (No. 26).

Raudi impressed in 2026 Spring Training, batting .350 with an .835 OPS as a non-roster invitee. Last season, he dominated Low-A Inland Empire in 2025, hitting .281 with 49 extra-base hits and an .842 OPS across 125 games, earning multiple honors in 2025, including five Player of the Week awards, two Player of the Month selections, and the Angels Kenny Myers Memorial LAA Minor League Player of the Year. He also starred in the Arizona Fall League, batting .433 and earning AFL All-Star and Fall Stars Game MVP honors.

Hurtado pitched the majority of 2025 with Rocket City, going 5-6 with a 2.70 ERA (86.2 IP - 26 ER) and 56 strikeouts in 18 games (all starts). He led the staff in the first two months, recording five quality starts and 54.2 innings pitched. Before being shut down for load management in June, he ranked among the League leaders in starts, innings pitched, wins, ERA, WHIP, and groundouts.

In Gordon's first pro season in 2025 with Tri-City, he was 4-5 with a 5.44 ERA over 84.1 innings pitched, 27 walks, and 95 strikeouts.

BUILDING THE BRAND: From January through August 2025, the Trash Pandas generated 41.3 million social media impressions—an average of 5.2 million per month—ranking second among all Double-A clubs and ninth across Minor League Baseball. The team's combined audience on Facebook, Instagram, Tik Tok, and X grew by 10% this year to 356,000 followers. Since debuting in 2021, the Trash Pandas have surpassed 200 million total impressions, establishing themselves as one of the most consistently engaging brands in MiLB. In addition, The Trash Pandas hit the West Coast in 2025 with four games (July 31 vs. Birmingham, August 14 vs. Knoxville, August 28 vs. Columbus, and September 10 vs. Chattanooga) televised and streamed live on FanDuel Sports Network West during the second half of the 2025 season.

THE 2025 ROSTER AND HISTORIC MOVEMENT: The Trash Pandas made a club record 128 roster moves during the 2025 season, reflecting a busy and ever-changing lineup. The moves were distributed throughout the year with eight in April, 13 in May, 28 in June—including 11 on June 17—plus 17 in July, 24 from August 1-6 (16 on August 2), six on June 2-3, and 16 in September. These frequent changes shaped the team's roster and contributed
