FRES-NOTES

QUIET START TO JUNE: The Fresno Grizzlies (29-20) were confined by the San Jose Giants (28-21) 7-2 Saturday evening from Excite Ballpark. Fresno suffered their first Saturday road loss of the season (4-1), falling to 12-2 Friday-Sundays away from home. The Grizzlies dropped to 22-6 when scoring first (15-3 on the road) and 20-12 against the California League North Division (16-4 away). Fresno sits 5.5 games back of the Modesto Nuts with 16 contests left to play in the first half. The Grizzlies recorded both of their runs in the top of the second. Andy Perez worked a walk and waltzed home on a balk. Then, Darius Perry added Felix Tena with a single to center. Perry finished the contest with a career-high two hits, which included a double in the eighth. Tena lengthened his hit streak to 10 games after a single in the second. He joins Perez (18 games) as the only Grizzlies batters this year to relish a double-digit hit streak. Fresno southpaw Isaac Coupet (4-2) agonized the defeat after allowing three runs over five frames. Both of Coupet's losses in 2024 have come against the Giants. Kannon Handy, who celebrated his 24th birthday, tossed three innings of relief in his Fresno debut. Handy permitted four runs and struck out a trio of San Jose batters.

GIANT AMOUNT OF MATCHUPS: The Fresno Grizzlies and San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants Single-A affiliate) conclude their six-game series today at Excite Ballpark. This is the third of six series between the clubs in 2024 and the second of three sets in San Jose. In the first series of 2024, the Grizzlies enjoyed their first series sweep of the Giants since the California League Playoffs in 2022. Fresno also swept their first series at Excite Ballpark since joining the league in 2021. The Grizzlies are now 55-46 overall in the regular season (2-3 in playoffs) against the Giants since joining the California League.

FROM FRIEND TO FOE: The San Jose Giants have a few names on their coaching staff that the Central Valley may recognize. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 76.1 innings. Another staff member fans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 21st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington. Ishikawa played eight MLB seasons starting in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2008-10, 2014-15), Milwaukee (2012), Baltimore (2013), New York AL (2013) and Pittsburgh (2014-15). Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. The final coach fans may remember is Giants Manager Ydwin Villegas. The always smiling infielder played for the Grizzlies from 2011-14, appearing in 95 games. Villegas batted .208 and had a .962 fielding percentage.

FARM GROWN: Today, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jace Kaminska. Kaminska was selected by the Rockies in the 10th round (Pick 292) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Nebraska. Kaminska made 14 starts for the Cornhuskers in 2023, going 7-3 with a 4.13 ERA and 1.14 WHIP. Prior to Nebraska, Kaminska pitched for Wichita State and Caney Valley High School in Caney, Kansas.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his new role as the team's leadoff hitter. Since Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 17 times in 32 plate appearances (seven games). In four of those seven games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score nine runs. This includes starting the game off 4-for-6 with a walk. All four hits have been singles with half of them as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped eight bases, picking up two of them in three of those games.

CLUTCH(INCHMAN): Grizzlies' OF/1B Jason Hinchman has provided the clutch hit in all three of Fresno's comeback claw wins in the seventh inning or later this season. Hinchman had a go-ahead two-RBI double in the 7th inning May 9 vs. Modesto, a walk-off two-run homer in the 9th inning May 26 vs. Visalia and a game-tying two-RBI single in the 9th frame May 30 at San Jose.

HILL HOMERS AGAIN: Grizzlies' OF/2B GJ Hill has homered four times over his last six games (May 26-31), giving him a club-high five clouts. Hill went deep in three straight games from May 26-29. Before joining Fresno, Hill had 12 professional longballs (2019-22 in the Diamondbacks system).

TENA IS ON A TEAR: Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak, the longest active streak on the team. He has powered one homer, one triple, one double, eight RBI and three runs in that span. Tena joins Andy Perez (18 games) as the only Grizzlies batters this year to relish a double-digit hit streak.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez has had an outstanding season (47 games), going 52-for-188 (.277 AVG/.322 OBP/.426 SLG/.748 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), four triples, eight doubles, 29 RBI, 21 runs, 13 walks and two stolen bases. Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Perez's triple on May 31 at San Jose was his 11th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him two triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

2023 (pro): Started professional career with the ACL Rockies, appearing in 1 game out of the bullpen...On 5 pitches, allowed 1 hit and struck out 1...Selected by the Rockies in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Nebraska.

2023 (college): Played at Nebraska for 1 season, making 14 starts...Went 7-3 with a 4.13 ERA and 1.14 WHIP...Logged 72 innings, allowing 15 walks while striking out 57 batters...Made 6 starts where he pitched 6 innings or more...In 3 of those starts, he allowed 5 hits or less and no runs, while the offense scored 12 (2x) and 18 runs...On March 11 vs. Illinois State, allowed 3 hits over 7 scoreless innings...On April 29 vs. Minnesota, allowed 5 hits over 7 scoreless frames...Transferred from Wichita State University.

2021-22 (college): Played at Wichita State for 2 seasons...In 2022, appeared in 15 games (12 starts), compiling a 3-9 record with a 5.49 ERA...Struck out 86 batters in 78.2 innings...Went 8 shutout innings April 1 at Houston, allowing 4 hits and fanning 12...In 2021, was named American Athletic Conference Newcomer Pitcher of the Year and All-Conference 1st Team honoree...Appeared in 12 games (10 starts), compiling an 8-1 record with a 2.32 ERA and a 1.13 WHIP...Was 2nd in the conference in wins and ERA for the season...Struck out 51 batters in 62 innings...Tossed 2 Complete Games (April 10 vs. Houston and April 30 vs. East Carolina)...This included the 1st 9-inning, CG by a Shocker freshman since 2009.

Personal: 4-year letterwinner and team captain at Caney Valley High School in Caney, Kansas...Was named the 2019 and 2020 Kansas Gatorade Player of the Year...1st-team All-State honoree and Class 3A Pitcher of the Year as a sophomore and junior...3-time Tri-Valley League MVP...Set the school record for consecutive strikeouts with 29 straight as a junior...Set a single season ERA record as a junior at 0.00...In his career, compiled a 0.51 ERA with a 14-1 record while allowing just 20 hits in 96 innings with 229 strikeouts...In his final season, did not allow an earned run, while going 5-0 with 85 punchouts in 32 innings...Helped his team to sub-state runner-up showings in 2017 and 2018...Also was a 2nd-team All-State basketball player as a senior...Won a Purple Ribbon for his homemade bread loaf at the 4-H baking championship at the Montgomery County Fair (12 years old).
