**RUMBLE PONIES FIND STRIDE, WIN FOURTH STRAIGHT:** Despite the second home run of the season for Jordan Groshans, the Rumble Ponies picked up their fourth straight win in the series and took home a 11-4 decision. After a Groshans home run cut the Ponies' lead to 5-4, Binghamton scored six runs in the top of the 8<sup>th</sup> to put themselves out of sight. A loss for the Fisher Cats today would be the sixth straight, and the current losing streak of five games is tied for the longest one of the year. A loss would also put the Fisher Cats in a tie with the Rumble Ponies for third place in the division.

**MARTIN MAKING STRIDES:** With just 102 plate appearances as a pro, Austin Martin has upped his batting average to .265 and has a .392 OBP. He has 22 hits in 23 games, with five doubles, a triple, and a homer. He also has walked 13 times. Martin has made 11 starts at shortstop (3 errors), and 12 starts in center field (3 assists) for the Fisher Cats. Martin was drafted by the Blue Jays in the first round (5<sup>th</sup> overall) in 2020. He has now reached safely in nine consecutive games—and 21 of his first 22 games.

**TALLEY MARKS:** LJ Talley has driven in a run in each game of this series, and has a four-game hit streak in the process. His career high for hit streaks is 5 games, which he set with Lansing in 2019. Despite joining the team ten games after the start of the season, Talley is second on the team with 18 runs batted in, only trailing team-leader Gabriel Moreno by three.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** June 5, 2016---Jason Leblebajian and Wilkin Castillo each had three hits including a home run in New Hampshire's 8-0 win at Reading. Four New Hampshire pitchers combined on the six-hit shutout – Jason Berken, Chris Smith, Matt Dermody, and Wil Browning.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** Buffalo split a double-header with the Syracuse Mets, winning game one in eight innings 5-4 before dropping the evening fixture 6-3. Dunedin exploded for 12 runs to defeat Bradenton 12-2 and advance to 9-19. Vancouver was outscored 10-2 in the final 6 innings, falling to Eugene 10-4. The Toronto Blue Jays were decimated by the Houston Astros, giving up 16 hits before falling 13-1. Zach Greinke picked up the win for the Astros, his sixth win of the season. The normally rock-solid Hyun-Jin Ryu gave up two home runs and seven total runs, picking up just his third loss of the season.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats get their first look at Binghamton (New York Mets) this week before heading to face a familiar foe, the Portland Sea Dogs, next week.

**ROSTER MOVES: June 4:** RHP Johnny Barbato signed to a minor league contract and assigned to the Fisher Cats. RHP Cre Finrock placed in IL. **June 3:** RHP Sean Rackoski activated from IL. **June 2:** RHP Willy Gaston transferred to Adv. A Vancouver.

**ON THE HILL:** RHP Johnny Barbato makes his season and Fisher Cats debut tonight. Barbato has over 200 games of minor league experience and also appeared 44 times as a reliever in various Major League games. Barbato was signed on June 4<sup>th</sup>.

Opposite Barbato is Cole Gordon, who will be making his first career start. In his time with Brooklyn and Columbia, Gordon made 19 relief appearances. This year, for Binghamton, Gordon has appeared in seven games, all in relief, with an ERA of 4.38. Gordon's last start came in 2018 with Mississippi State, where he was on the roster with current Rumble Pony Will Mangum.
