Last Night: Whitecaps 5, Locos 3. West Michigan right fielder Dom Johnson belted a 419-foot home run on Jake Garland's first pitch of the ninth inning, breaking a 3-3 tie, and the 'Caps went on to beat Lansing in the final Copa game of the year in front of 3,122 . Garland tossed $51 / 3$ innings of three-hit relief, holding West Michigan scoreless until the ninth inning after following 20-year-old Luis Morales to the mound. Morales, the no. 2 pitching prospect in the A's system, struck out four in $32 / 3$ innings.

## Lug•Notes

Congratulations: Today's Lansing starting pitcher, 23-year-old right-hander Gunnar Hoglund was named the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week on Monday, honoring his remarkable High-A debut last Saturday night in Dayton: 64 pitches: 5 innings, 0 hits, 0 runs, 0 walks, 7 strikeouts, 1 HBP. In that game, the Lugnuts brought a no-hitter one out into the bottom of the eighth before settling for a 3-2 victory. Hoglund joined Blake Beers (Pitcher of the Week, May 9-14) and Danny Bautista, Jr. (Player of the Week, July 25-30) as Lugnuts to receive weekly awards this year.

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have used 25 position players this year and 26 pitchers (not including Danny Bautista, Jr., who tossed one inning as a position-playerpitching). 16 players have hit at least one home run, 16 players have stolen at least one base, 15 pitchers have made at least one start, 19 pitchers have won at least one game, and 13 pitchers have recorded at least one save.

Two for the Price of One: Lansing leads the league with 111 double plays turned, seven more than second-place Peoria.
Starting Strong: Including Luis Morales' outing yesterday ( $32 / 3 \mathrm{IP}, 5 \mathrm{H}, 3 \mathrm{R}, 4 \mathrm{~K}$ ), Lugnuts starters have allowed 14 runs on 28 hits in the last $482 / 3$ innings while striking out 60 batters during the last 10 games.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April ( $35 \%$ ), nine in 27 games in May ( $33 \%$ ), 15 in 24 in June ( $63 \%$ ), 20 in 24 games in July ( $83 \%$ ), 22 in 27 games played in August ( $81 \%$ ), and one through one game in September.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4 -for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBls, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider ( $7 / 7 / 07$ at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn ( $7 / 26 / 10$ vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares ( $4 / 24 / 17$ vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster. Chronologically, working backwards: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); Gunnar Hoglund (Toronto Blue Jays, 3/16/22, for Matt Chapman); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has two current first-rounders: shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, and the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, 19th overall Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade in March 2022 for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, and 2022 first-round selection, catcher Daniel Susac, are both currently excelling with the Double-A Midland RockHounds in the Texas League

## Today in Lugnuts History

2013: The Lugnuts wrapped up the season with a 61-78 record, scoring eight runs in the bottom of the sixth to beat the West Michigan Whitecaps, 9-4.
2015: Rehabbing Blue Jays ace Marcus Stroman pitched $42 / 3$ hitless scoreless innings, striking out seven and walking one, but the Great Lakes Loons rallied for seven runs with two outs in the ninth, including a three-run homer by Justin Chigbogu ("shi-BAH-goo") to hand the Lugnuts a 7-4 loss at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2019: In the final game of the Lugnuts' 24th season, Sean Wymer tossed an 85-pitch ( 63 strikes) nine-inning complete game and Yorman Rodriguez, Otto Lopez and Griffin Conine all hit solo home runs in a 3-1 victory at Fort Wayne. The game lasted two hours and 14 minutes. Wymer allowed four singles, one run, one walk and two HBPs with two strikeouts.

In a Nutshell: Gunnar's surname is pronounced "HO-glund," with a long 'oh' sound... debuted against Dayton with five nearly perfect innings, striking out seven Dragons on August 26 at Day Air Ballpark... only base runner was a two-out HBP of Trey Faltine in the 3rd inning... honored as the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week... making home debut tonight.

Prospecting: Hoglund is ranked the A's no. 19 prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 55 , his curve at 50 , his slider at 50 , his change at 45 and his control at 60 . They write, "The A's haven't seen much of Hoglund, the 19th overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft, since acquiring him last year from Toronto as part of the return for Matt Chapman while he was still recovering from Tommy John surgery. Returning to the mound in July 2022, he logged just eight innings combined in the ACL and with Single-A Stockton before a biceps strain kept him out the rest of the season. The A's hoped to finally get a good look at the right-hander in 2023, though he didn't pitch until late May and was on a strict innings limit.

fastball, curve, slider, change
"The pure stuff Hoglund possesses when healthy is rivaled by few in the A's organization. It includes a fastball that sits $92-95 \mathrm{mph}$, though the velocity on the heater was a couple of ticks below that just before the biceps issue. He also brings a hard slider that he throws around $84-86$ mph as his main secondary pitch, while his low-80s changeup and curveball are useful in providing a different look against hitters."

Entering the Draft, Part I: Hoglund was first selected 36th overall by the Pirates out of Fivay High School in Port Richey, Fla., in 2018, but, as Pipeline writes, "the two sides had differing views of his post-Draft physical, which killed any chances of a deal." Gunnar's career high school stats: . 312 avg., seven home runs, 16-10, 1.31 ERA, $310 \mathrm{~K} \ldots$ as a senior, he was $7-0$ with a 0.27 ERA... he also starred on the basketball court... while he played athletically at Fivay, he attended Dayspring Academy.

Life as a Rebel: Onward to Ole Miss, where Gunnar served as the Rebels' Sunday starter as a freshman in 2019 ( 68 IP, 5.29 ERA, 14 BB, 53 K)... sophomore season was ended early by COVID-19, though he ascended to Saturday starter and had posted a 1.16 ERA with four walks and team-leading 37 strikeouts in four starts (23 1/3 IP) before the season was truncated... earned bachelor's degree in May 2020... entering 2021 was considered one of the nation's top pitchers and was named consensus Preseason All-American, but had season ended early by torn UCL on May 7, 2021; at the time, was ranked in SEC Top 5 in strikeouts (96), K/9 IP (13.79) and WHIP (0.91); overall, was 4-2, 2.87, 11 GS, $622 / 3,40 \mathrm{H}, 17 \mathrm{BB}, 96 \mathrm{~K}, .178$ avg. ... posted double-digit strikeouts in five of first six starts.

Entering the Draft, Part II: Hoglund had entered the season as a top-five draft prospect, but slipped to MLB Pipeline's No. 22 draft prospect due to his UCL tear.. Toronto rolled the dice on him with pick 19 in 2021, signing him for $\$ 3,247,500 \ldots$ director of amateur scouting Shane Farrell said, "We're really excited about how it shook out for us, knowing some of the different strengths of the Draft and especially how it relates to Gunnar. His trajectory along the year, he was pitching his way into a top-10 pick. Unfortunately, the injury kind of derailed that. We were extremely fortunate for him to be there when we selected today. He's a strong, physical kid with above-average control and command of his fastball and an above-average slider as well," Farrell said. "The changeup is a pitch that was good for him in high school, and we saw a little bit less of it at the college level, but l'm sure that will develop more as a pro. We saw a tick up in fastball velocity this year, combining that with an upper-level ability to command the ball on both sides of the plate and command the slider off the fastball. That's what really drove us to make this selection."

Onward to Oakland: But Hoglund did not throw a single pitch in the Blue Jays' organization. After missing the rest of the 2021 season due to his recovery from Tommy John surgery, he was traded on March 16, 2022, with former Lugnuts Zach Logue, Kevin Smith and Kirby Snead to the A's in exchange for third baseman Matt Chapman...he made his professional debut on July 23, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out five batters while allowing one unearned run in two innings for the AzCL A's against the AzCL Cubs... after three scoreless innings on July 30 vs. the Cubs, he was moved up to Stockton for one start, twirling three innings and allowing one unearned run against Modesto on August 6.

2023 Season: Gunnar's 2023 debut was pushed back to May 29, when he joined Stockton's rotation and allowed four runs on six hits in three innings vs. Modesto... he made 11 more starts for the Ports, firing four perfect innings against Lake Elsinore on July 29 and topping out at five innings in his Ports finale on August 19.. on August 22, he was promoted to Lansing, replacing Stevie Emanuels.
