A Trip to the Capital

Reading finishes a six-game series at Harrisburg with game six today. Reading holds the edge in the season series 6-5. The Fightin Phils need one more win this weekend to clinch both this week's series and the season-series over Harrisburg.

Looking Back

After falling down 7-1 early, Reading battled back but ultimately fell 7-6 to Harrisburg. The Senators jumped out early to a 7-1 lead in the third. Nick Ward, Max McDowell and Madison Stokes all had two hits, and Stokes drove in two runs. Reading had five doubles on the night, which matched a season high. But, the R-Phils were just 4-15 with runners in scoring position last night. Josh Hendrickson started and suffered the loss, going five innings, allowing seven runs on eight hits, with four strikeouts. Andrew Schultz (2.0 IP) and Jordi Martinez (1.0 IP) combined to allow no out of the bullpen.

Max Do Well

Max McDowell is swinging a red-hot bat as of late, since his return from Triple-A Lehigh Valley on August 16. His three hits Thursday night matched a season high and he's now had a hit in seven-straight games, which is a new season high for McDowell. Over his last five games, he's hitting .571 and .438 across his last ten. Against Harrisburg in 2023, McDowell is hitting .357, which included a walkoff homer on May 26.

Putting the Fight in Fightins

Reading's win Friday night was just the second time this season where Reading won a game when trailing after eight innings. Before Friday night, the R-Phils were 1-49 in such situations, with the other win actually coming against Harrisburg on May 26 in Reading. It also marked just the sixth time Reading's won this season when being outhit (prev. 5-35) and 14th win when scoring less than five runs (prev. 13-49). Reading nearly matched its largest comeback last night in six runs, which also came against Harrisburg on May 26.

Reading remains in the playoff hunt, just 2.5 games back of a spot with 19 games to play. Since Somerset won the first half title, if the Patriots remain in first place, then the second place team in the Northeast Division will earn the final playoff spot. The two teams ahead of Reading are still on the schedule. Portland comes to Reading from Sept. 5-10 and Reading ends the season in Binghamtom from Sept. 12-17.

Around the Organization

The Phillies rolled the Cardinals again with a 12-1 victory last night and will go for the series-sweep today. Lehigh Valley dropped both games to Scranton in a doubleheader yesterday. Darick Hall, Kody Clemens, Dustin Peterson and Cal Stevenson all homered. Jersey Shore fell to Wilmington 4-3 as Bryan Rincon had three hits. Clearwater fell 6-2 to Lakeland as Aidan Miller stayed hot with another double. The DSL Phillies won game three of the quarterfinal series over the DSL Angels 2-0. They'll now advance to the DSL semifinals.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 27, 2012: At Reading, the Phils beat Binghamton, 4-1, behind a strong performance by Trevor May and another homer run by Darin Ruf. May fans 9 while surrendering just one run on two hits over 8.0 innings for his 10th win. Ruf's homer is his 18th in August, doubling his total from the season's first four months and drawing him to within one of Ryan Howard's all-time franchise mark of 37.

Hey Harrisburg

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 24-26 record in the second half and 55-63 record overall. Last week, the Senators took just one-of-five from Richmond, while dropping the last-four games. Next week, Harrisburg will begin a 12-game road trip at Binghamton, then Altoona. Currently, 10 of Washington's top-30 prospects are on Harrisburg's roster: Dylan Crews (1), James Wood (2), Brady House (3), Robert Hassell (8), Trey Lipscomb (14), DJ Herz (16), Cole Henry (19), Israel Pineda (22), Mitchell Parker (26) and Jacob Young (30).

Lefty DJ Herz goes for Harrisburg for the second time this week. Against Reading on Tuesday, Herz went four innings and allowed no runs in a no decision, with six strikeouts. Between Harrisburg and Tennessee (Cubs) in 2023, Herz is 2-2 with a 3.60 ERA over 18 starts (75 IP, 52 H, 43 BB, 104 SO). He was traded from the Cubs to the Nationals on July 31 of this season. Chicago selected him in the eighth round in 2019 out of Sanford High School in Fayeteeville, North Carolina. Herz currently ranks as the Nationals' No. 16 overall prospect, according to MLB Pipeline.
