**LOPEZ LOCKED IN:** Alejo Lopez has hit safely in 19 of his last 25 games since 8/1 (76.0%), batting .363 (33-for-91, 7 2B, 2 3B, 15 R, 20 RBI, 3 SB, .948 OPS). That surge has moved him into the top 10 IL hitters in batting (2nd, .310), OBP (4th, .394), and hits (T-7th, 122) for the season.

**NACHO SUPREME:** Nacho Alvarez Jr. has hit safely in 35 of 49 games (71.4%) on his Triple-A debut, batting .305 (58-for-190, 9 2B, 9 HR, 40 R, 36 RBI, 9 SB, .908 OPS). The Stripers are 7-2 (.778) when Alvarez homers.

**HERE COMES THE HAMMER:** Drake Baldwin has hit safely in 44 of 62 career games (70.9%) with Gwinnett, batting .302 (71-for-235, 9 2B, 11 HR, 36 R, 49 RBI, .898 OPS) with 20 multi-hit efforts. The Stripers are 9-2 (.818) when Baldwin homers.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** The Stripers have stolen 190 bases over 134 games in 2024, tying the club single-season record (190 SB over 148G in 2023). Gwinnett boasts three active players with 20-plus steals totals: **J.P. Martinez** (30-for-38, .789, 7th in IL), **Andrew Velazquez** (28-for-29, .966), and **Alejo Lopez** (21-for-28, .750). Also on the club is **Justin Dean**, whose 53 steals (53-for-60, .883) between Gwinnett and Mississippi rank 10th in MiLB.

**SQUID GAME:** Andrew Velazquez enters play riding the team's longest active hitting streak, a 10-game span since 8/22 (.368, 14-for-38, 2 2B, 1 HR, 8 R, 1 RBI, 5 SB, .885 OPS). "Squid" blasted his team-leading 16th homer on 8/28 vs. Columbus, giving him two more clouts than his previous career high of 14 (set in 2018 with Rays org).

**WINNING WITH WINANS:** Allan Winans threw 4.0 innings (4 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 2 SO) to earn the win in relief in Sunday's 1-0 victory over Columbus. Over 20 games (16 starts) with Gwinnett this season, he's 7-4 with a 3.11 ERA (37 ER in 107.0 IP), 1.15 WHIP, and .234 BAA. Last year, Winans won the IL ERA title (2.85 in 23G) and set Gwinnett single-season records for lowest WHIP (1.08) and BAA (.218) as he was named an IL Postseason All-Star.

**MATZEK RETURNS:** The Braves signed 2021 World Series hero Tyler Matzek to a MiLB deal and assigned him to Gwinnett on 8/31. Matzek went 8-9 with a 3.40 ERA, 1.26 WHIP, .200 BAA, and one save (1-for-4) over 143 regular-season games with Atlanta over four seasons (2020-22, 2024) before being traded to San Francisco on 7/29. The Giants released him on 8/30.

**QUALITY DEBUT FOR DRUE:** Drue Hackenberg delivered a quality start in his Triple-A debut on 8/30 vs. Columbus (ND, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 5 BB, 1 SO). He extended his scoreless innings streak to 22.0 before allowing an RBI single to Angel Martinez in the fifth. Atlanta's second-round pick in 2023 out of Virginia Tech, Hackenberg is 6-5 with a 3.31 ERA, 1.27 WHIP, .220 BAA, and 10.26 SO/9.0 IP ratio (127 SO) across 22 MiLB starts this season.

**(STAT) BOOK OF ELI:** The Braves recalled Eli White on 9/1. Since posting a Gwinnett-record six hits and 14 total bases on 7/3 at St. Paul (6-for-7, 2 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI), he hit .330 (36-for-109, 7 2B, 2 3B, 3 HR, 22 R, 20 RBI, 6 SB, .901 OPS) over his last 27 games with the Stripers.

### MANAGER KANEKOA TEXEIRA

**Kanekoa Teixeira** is in his first season as the manager of the Stripers in 2024 ... Named the eighth manager in Gwinnett history on 1/25/24 ... Is the second former Gwinnett player to manage the club (pitched for the G-Braves from 2014-16), joining Matt Tuiasosopo ... **2023:** Debuted as a Double-A manager with Mississippi, going 62-75 ... Under his leadership, the M-Braves led the Southern League in lowest ERA (3.94) and finished second in both WHIP (1.36) and BAA (.236) ... **2021-22:** Managed High-A Rome, going 56-60 (6th in High-A East) in his first season and 74-54 (3rd in South Atlantic League) in his second season ... Rome made the SAL Playoffs in 2022, losing in the first round to Bowling Green ... **2017-19:** Served as a pitching coach with Rookie Danville (2017-18) and Class-A Rome (2019) ... **2006-16:** Selected in the 22nd round in 2006 by the Chicago White Sox and went on to play 11 professional seasons with six different organizations including the White Sox, New York Yankees, Kansas City Royals, Seattle Mariners, Cincinnati Reds, and Atlanta Braves ... Pitched in the Majors with Seattle (2010) and Kansas City (2010-11), going 1-1 with a 4.66 ERA in 49 relief appearances.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Drue Hackenberg makes his second career Triple-A start in game three of this six-game series at Nashville ... It is his 23rd overall start of 2024 between Gwinnett, Double-A Mississippi, and High-A Rome.

**PROSPECTING:** Is currently ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 9 prospect by MLB.com ... Opened the year ranked No. 10 on the list.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Turned in a quality start in his Triple-A debut on 8/30 vs. Columbus, becoming the **20th different starting pitcher to appear for Gwinnett this season** ... Fired 6.0 innings (4 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 5 BB, 1 SO) in a no-decision ... Lone run allowed in fifth inning snapped his 22.0-inning scoreless streak ... Exited in a 1-1 tie ... Gwinnett won 2-1 on a walk-off single from **Brian Anderson** in the bottom of the ninth.

**2024 SEASON:** Across three levels of the Braves' minors, is 6-5 with a 3.31 ERA (41 ER in 111.1 IP), 1.27 WHIP, .220 BAA, and 10 quality starts in 22 total starts ... Ranks among Braves MiLB top five qualifying pitchers in starts (T-1st), BAA (2nd, .220), strikeouts (T-2nd, 127), ERA (3rd), innings (3rd), and WHIP (4th).

- **Workhorse:** Has gone 6.0-plus innings in 10 of his 22 starts, with all 10 resulting in quality starts ... Posting a 0.99 ERA (7 ER in 63.2 IP) in those outings ... Has made three starts of 7.0 IP, including one scoreless start (6/18 with Rome vs. Greenville).
- **Sweet 16:** Struck out a career-high 16 batters in a no-decision on 7/21 at Pensacola (7.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 0 BB) ... Was the most strikeouts in a game by a MiLB pitcher this season and just the 21st time an MiLB pitcher has fanned 16-plus batters since 2005 ...
