YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox came out of the All-Star Break with an 8-6 win in 10 innings against the playoff-bound Erie SeaWolves. Despite just two hits through the first seven innings of the game, Chesapeake scored six runs in the final three innings to come back and win. Adam Retzbach collected two doubles and a game-high three RBI. Max Wagner drove in the go-ahead run in the 10th while Creed Willems and Anthony Servideo both recorded two-run singles late.

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems has been red hot in the month of July. The Orioles No. 11 prospect leads the league with a .385 (15-for-39) batting average (min. 35+ plate appearances) and is fourth in the league with a 1.057 OPS. Willems is on a nine-game hit streak, which is tied for the longest active streak in the league, and has collected a hit in 10 of 11 games this month. The 22-year-old is the first Baysox player to hit 10 homers this season.

TRIMBLE IS NIMBLE

OF Reed Trimble is on a career-best 19-game on-base streak, which is the longest on the team this season and is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. The 25-year-old is slashing .244/.385/.415 in the month of July after slashing .187/.265/.387 in the month of June.

LATE GAME RETZ

C Adam Retzbach is 3-for-7 in the eighth inning or later this month. All three hits have either tied the game or put the Baysox in front. On July 3, he hit a three-run go-ahead homer in Richmond in the eighth. On July 11, he hit a game-tying RBI single in the ninth to force extras vs Reading. His double in the eighth yesterday helped force extras.

EXTRA ALFREDO PLEASE

IF Alfredo Velasquez has settled in since joining the team in early June after IF Frederick Bencosme was placed on the injured list. The 20-year-old Venezuelan is batting .343 this month (12-for-35), which is sixth-best in the Eastern League (min. 35+ plate appearances). He has also reached base in nine of 10 games this month.

CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

Chesapeake won its 11th extra inning game last night, which is now the most in full-season Minor League Baseball. Chesapeake has won 19 one-run games this season - which is tied for the most in the Eastern League. The Baysox have played 34 one-run games this season, which is the most in all of Double-A.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 3.17 ERA, which is fifth-best in Double-A and eighthbest in full-season MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 424 hitters, which is sixth-most in Double-A and the second-most in the Eastern League.

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie SeaWolves - Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers - are playoff bound for a fourth straight season after clinching the first half in the Southwest Division with a 45-24 record. Erie is seeking its third straight Eastern League title. Erie's active roster includes 10 of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB.com - IF Kevin McGonigle (No. 1), OF Max Clark (No. 2), 1B/C Josue Briceno (No. 4), C Thayron Liranzo (No. 5), OF Roberto Campos (No. 21), IF Max Anderson (No. 22), RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 25), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 26), RHP RJ Petit (No. 29) and RHP Yosber Sanchez (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Troy Watson makes his fourth start of the season for Erie. The 28-year-old started the season in the bullpen for his first 22 outings but has been summoned into the rotation due to injuries. As a starter, Watson holds a 1.93 ERA in 14 innings pitched. In his most recent start on July 11, he threw five scoreless innings with four strikeouts in Harrisburg. The Gunter, TX native was in the Blue Jays system for seven years before being traded to the Tigers during the trade deadline last season.

Leads Orioles system and is 11th in MiLB in K (103). 13.50 K/9 is 3rd-best in MiLB. Named EL Pitcher of the Week for 6/30 - 7/6 after pitching first career complete game shutout with 7.0 scoreless IP and 6 K and just 1 H allowed on 7/2 @ RIC. First Baysox 7-inning CG since '23. Allowed just 1 ER through first 13.2 innings at Double-A. Struck out eight in 6.0 innings of one-run ball on 6/7 @ AKR to earn win in Double-A debut. Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 6/3. ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League BaseballTM teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
