Earn It: The Nashville pitching staff leads Triple-A with a 3.70 ERA. Buffalo checks in at second with a 3.96 ERA. The Sounds also lead Triple-A with eight shutouts.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-hander Ethan Small is the No. 8 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Lindblom turned in one of his best outings of the season his last time out in the series opener. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings and limited the Stripers to just two hits and one walk. Lindblom threw 53 of his 81 pitches for strikes and recorded five strikeouts.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is his third start against the Stripers in 2022. He faced them in Gwinnett County on April 15 and got a no decision (5.1 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 4 K) and in the series opener (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K). Lindblom faced Gwinnett five times in 2021, including four starts. He went 2-2 with a 3.38 ERA (24.0 IP/9 ER), walked 5 batters and struck out 26. He also pitched against Gwinnett twice during the 2017 season with Indianapolis and went 0-0 with a 2.08 ERA (4.1 IP/1 ER).
