THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 1985, Bryan Kelly tossed the first nine-inning no-hitter in Sounds history as he blanked Oklahoma City. He is one of four Sounds to throw a nine-inning no-hitter in team history.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Louisville Bats play game five of a six-game series tonight. The Bats snapped the Sounds' four-game winning streak in empathic fashion with an 11-1 win in front of a sellout crowd of 10,818 fans at First Horizon Park Friday night. Left-hander Aaron Ashby starts for Nashville against right-hander Hunter Greene for Louisville.

Aaron Ashby: 23-year-old Aaron Ashby makes his 16th appearance (eighth start) for the Sounds tonight. He last pitched in a start at Gwinnett on July 11. He worked 4.0 shutout innings, allowed four hits and struck out six. In Ashby's 2019 campaign, he went 5-10 with a 3.50 ERA in 24 games (23 starts) with Advanced-A Carolina and Single-A Wisconsin. He was named the Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a Mid-Season Midwest League All-Star. He spent 2020 at the Brewers Alternate Training Site. The Missouri native was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 4th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

Hunter Greene: 21-year-old Hunter Greene starts for the Bats tonight. The right-hander is 1-3 with a 5.24 ERA in five starts with Louisville. In 22.1 innings, he has allowed 22 hits and 12 walks to go with 25 strikeouts. Greene last pitched on July 11 against Memphis. In 5.0 innings, he allowed one run on six hits and struck out two. Prior to 2021, Green had played just one full season in 2018 with Single-A Dayton. He went 3-7 with a 4.48 ERA (34 ER/68.1 IP) in 18 starts. Cincinnati drafted him in the 1st round (second overall) in the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft and is the second-best prospect in the Reds organization, according to MLB.com.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 33, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Different Roles: Aaron Ashby makes his second start with Nashville since June 4 at Charlotte. As a reliever, the left-hander is 3-1 with a 11.77 ERA (17 ER/13.0 IP) in eight games. In his seven starts, he is 2-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER/27.2 IP) and 45 strikeouts. Ashby is 3-1 with a 1.71 ERA (5 ER/26.1 IP) on the road versus 2-1 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) at home.

Home is Where the Sounds Are: The Sounds will play 19 home games at First Horizon Park over the next 27 days. They host Louisville for six games from July 13-18, Columbus comes to town for six games July 27-August 1 and Toledo visits Nashville for a seven-game series August 3-8. The Sounds have already played 34 (22-12) home games in 2021 - tied for most in the Triple-A East behind only Iowa's 34 home games at Principal Park.

Wilson Makes First Pitching Appearance: In last night's 11-1 loss, outfielder/infielder Weston Wilson made his first professional pitching appearance in the ninth inning (1.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 0 K). He is the first position player to pitch for Nashville since July 23, 2019 vs. Oklahoma City (Matt Davidson).

Come Early, Come Often Game: Last night's crowd of 10,818 was the ninth sellout of the season at First Horizon Park. The Sounds lead all of Minor League Baseball with an average of 7,511 fans a night. The next closest is Triple-A El Paso with 6,560.

Starter 6+ Innings = Winning Formula: Starting pitcher Josh Lindblom recorded a season-high in innings pitched (6.2) and pitches (100) Thursday night. Lindblom threw at least 6.2 innings in affiliated baseball for the first time since June 26, 2014 with Sacramento vs. Las Vegas (7.0). The Sounds are 9-4 when their starting pitcher throws at least 6.0 innings.

Another Shutout: The Sounds notched their sixth shutout of the season on Wednesday night and their third in the last nine games. Prior to those nine games, the Nashville staff has recorded three shutouts in the first 52 games of the season. The six shutouts is the second-most in all of Triple-A Baseball behind only Durham's nine.

Walk-Off Galore: Derek Fisher's walk-off single in the 11th inning gave the Sounds their eight walk-off win of the season Thursday night. Nashville has posted three walk-off wins in the month of July, all against Louisville.

Milner Shuts the Door: Reliever Hoby Milner tossed a third of an inning Thursday night and is yet to allow a run with the Sounds in 15.2 IP. The left-hander has recorded four saves and is holding opponents to a .082 batting average.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,071-1,945. The 2,071 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

LAST OUTING: Ashby tossed 4.0 shutout innings on July 11 at Gwinnett. The left-hander allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four. He threw 63 pitches (45 strikes) in the Sounds 7-0 win.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Ashby is making his second career appearance against Louisville. He faced the bats on July 3 at First Horizon Park and gave up season-highs in hits (six) and runs (seven) in 0.2 innings pitched.
