TULSA DRILLERS (24-37) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (36-25)

RHP PETER HEUBECK (1-3, 4.61 ERA) vs. RHP MAX RAJCIC (2-3, 4.24 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals take on the Drillers (LAD) in the 5th game of a 6-game series and 12-game homestand ... are 4-0 in the series, have won 5 in-a-row and 10 of last 11 games.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Springfield enters the day in 1st place in the North Division, 4.0 games ahead of NWA/WCH ... magic number to win the 1st Half title is 5 with 8 games to play ... at 36-25, SGF is a season-high 11 games above .500 and holds the best record in the Texas League.

KING OF THE NORTH: SGF is vying to win back-to-back 1st Half titles for the first time in franchise history ... 2024 team clinched on final day of the half with a 37-32 record ... SGF has won four 1st Half titles all-time (2007, 2009, 2016, and 2024).

RAJCIC CARPET RIDE: RHP Max Rajcic makes his 12th start of the season and 2nd vs. TUL ... in 2 starts last week at FRI allowed only 2 ER on 6 hits over 11.2 IP ... struck out 12 and issued 2 walks ... in start on 6/3 did not allow a hit until the 6th inning ... completed a season-high 6.0 IP in last start on 6/8 ... pitched 5/21 at TUL and allowed 3 ER on 5 hits in 3.1 IP in no decision.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield rallied for 3 runs in the 8th to beat Tulsa, 6-4, Friday ... IF Trey Paige hit the go-ahead double after IF Jeremy Rivas tied the game with a base-hit ... C Leonardo Bernal started the winning rally with a single and went 3x3 on the night with a 3-run HR ... LHP Pete Hansen gave up only 2 hits over 6.0 IP in a no-decision, the 3rd-straight game of just 2H over 6.0+ IP for Cardinals starters.

FEEL THE BERN: C Leonardo Bernal ranks tied for 1st in the Texas League with 11 HR after his 3-run blast Friday ... also leads the TL with a .952 OPS and ranks 2nd with 39 RBI ... is batting .472 (17x36) with 5 HR, 14 RBI, a .500 OBP, and a 1.472 OPS in June.

X MAN: LHP Ixan Henderson lowered his league-leading ERA to 1.95 on Thursday after allowing 1 run over a season-high 6.2 IP ... struck out 5 and allowed only 2 hits ... also leads the TL with 70 strikeouts and a .204 OBA ... in last 3 starts, has allowed 1 ER over 19.0 IP (0.47 ERA).

WETHER HEATING UP: IF JJ Wetherholt recorded his 15th multi-hit game of the season Thursday ... leads TL with a .439 OBP and is 1st among active TLers with a .319 average and 2nd with a .914 OPS ... is batting .500 (15x30) in June with 10 walks and a .634 OBP.

KNOW THE DRILL: Tonight's game is the 11th of 18 vs. TUL and the 5th of 6 at Hammons Field ... SGF is 8-1 in the season series ... has outscored the Drillers, 66-33 ... Cards pitching has held TUL hitters to a .179 AVG.

LAST IN THE PAST: The Cardinals are 23-9 in 32 games since dropping to last (5th) place in the North Division at 12-16 on 5/7 ... are 15-5 over last 20 games and 10-1 in June.
