RIDERS DROP FINALE TO AMARILLO:

Tekoah Roby held the Amarillo Sod Poodles hitless for four innings but the Frisco RoughRiders fell 3-1 on Sunday at Riders Field. Roby struck out three in four innings without a run allowed. Once he exited, the Sod Poodles (17-22) scored one run in each of the next three innings. The RoughRiders (17-21) still won four of six games in the series. **Marc Church** (2-3) pitched the sixth for Frisco and allowed one run to put Amarillo up 2-1. Amarillo's starter Chad Patrick (1-5) gave up one run in 5.2 innings for the win. Christian Montes De Oca pitched a three-up, three-down ninth inning for the save. The RoughRiders scored the first run of the game in the second inning when **Kellen Strahm** led off with a single, **Dustin Harris** doubled and **Trevor Hauver** recorded a sacrifice fly. Frisco did not score the rest of the game and Hauver's fifth-inning single was the only hit after the second inning. Leading off for the RoughRiders, **Aaron Zavala** drew two walks for the second consecutive game. Zavala has reached base multiple times in each of the four games he has played since joining the RoughRiders this week.

STRENGTH IN ARMS:

After the RoughRiders had the worst ERA in the Texas League over a two-week span, last week against the Amarillo Sod Poodles, Frisco had the best ERA in the Texas League at 2.13 while going 4-2 against Amarillo. The Riders ceded a league-low three home runs and 25 hits (.138 BAA) with a 0.82 WHIP. Frisco's bullpen allowed just allowed five earned runs with a 1.61 ERA.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Liam Hicks** hitting Frisco's sixth grand slam of the season on Saturday. They are the only team with six grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball and the only team with more than four. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese**).

COMEBACK KIDS:

The RoughRiders came back from down six runs on Saturday night to win 8-7 on their first walk-off hit of the season. It was the largest comeback win since they returned from down six at Corpus Christi on 6/18/21 and their first comeback win of more than two runs on the season. It was also their first time they won a game when trailing after the fourth inning this season.

TOP 100 RERANKING:

MLB.com has reranked their Top 100 prospects and the RoughRiders have four Top 100 players that have seen some movement. Outfielder **Evan Carter** is now the No. 11 prospect in baseball (previously No. 36) while pitcher **Owen White** is No. 51, infielder **Luisangel Acuña** places at No. 58 and pitcher **Jack Leiter** is at No. 80. The Rangers fourth-round pick in 2022, pitcher **Brock Porter**, is the No. 81 prospect as well. He is currently pitching for Low-A Down East.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 20 games, he is hitting .365 (31-for-85)/.407/.541/.948 with four doubles, a triple, three homers, 15 RBIs and 15 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .356/.407/.507/.948 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .307/.409/.467/.876 with four doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBIs while walking 13 times. Over the last 20 games, he has raised his average 111 points and his OPS 292 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .308 (49-for-159)/.376/.447/.823 through the first 37 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (49), tied for fifth in doubles (11), eighth in total bases (71) and tied for second in stolen bases (17). Over his last 33 games, he is batting .326/.400/.482/.882. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (120).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 194 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .358 team OBP is third in Double-A. **Dustin Harris** is second in the league with 28 walks while **Evan Carter** is second in OBP (.430) in the league and third in the league with 27 walks.

ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No. 16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Over three starts on May 5th, May 11th and May 17th, Leiter allowed just three earned runs over 17.0 IP (1.59 ERA) while striking out 25 and walking five.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen as a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
