WEDNESDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats silenced the Somerset Patriots for a second night in a row, defeating the reigning Eastern League champions by a score of 2-1 on Wednesday night from TD Bank Ballpark. New Hampshire held Somerset to just one run on two hits in the game, despite collecting only one hit themselves. On the mound, right-hander Chad Dallas made his sixth Double-A start since being promoted to New Hampshire in mid-May. The 22-yearold threw 6.2 innings, allowing just one run on two hits and one walk while striking out seven, picking up the win. As they did yesterday, the Fisher Cats grabbed the first run of the game in the first inning against Somerset starting right-hander Yoendrys Gomez. A sacrifice fly off the bat of Will Robertson brought home Leo Jimenez, his 29th RBI of the season, which is third-best on the team. Mickey Gasper hit a solo homer off Dallas to tie up the score in the sixth but the Fisher Cats would retake the lead in the seventh. After Somerset right-hander Ian Hamilton gave up a walk to load the bases, **Orelvis** Martinez drove in his 45th RBI of the season with a sacrifice fly to center-field, bringing home Zac Cook. In the bullpen, right-hander Fitz Stadler threw a scoreless inning of relief with three strikeouts. Right-hander TJ Brock recorded his fourth save of the year, his third four-out save, to remain perfect on the year in saves to save opportunities.

ONE HIT WONDER: Wednesday was the 19th time in franchise history where the Fisher Cats have been one-hit in a game but it was the first time it ended in a New Hampshire win. Fisher Cats pitching has held Somerset to just two runs on four hits through these first two games of the series. Coming into this week, Somerset was the second-highest run scoring team in the league.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Fisher Cats have been a far better road than home team so far in this first half, posting the best road winning percentage in the Northeast division (.621). In 29 away games so far this season, New Hampshire's pitching staff has posted the second-lowest road ERA in the league at 3.43 behind Bowie (3.32).

TOP OF THE BOARD: Orelvis Martinez ranks in the top 10 in numerous offensive categories in the Eastern League and in all of Double-A. The Blue Jays No. 4 prospect is second in home runs (second in all of Double-A), and third in RBIs (10th in all of Double-A). Martinez is one homer shy of the league lead behind Hartford's Hunter Goodman. Steward Berroa is tied for second in the league in steals (tied for sixth in all of Double-A), four shy of the league lead behind Portland's Ceddanne Rafaela.

NOT A VIRGO BUT A LEO: In 18 games this month of June, Leo Jimenez is hitting .313 (20-for-64) with 10 extra base hits (seven doubles, three home runs) and 13 RBIs. Tuesday was his fourth multi-RBI performance of the month after previously having just two in April and May combined. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect leads the team in extra base hits and RBIs this month.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (June 22, 2022) - The Fisher Cats walked off Altoona 5-4. In the bottom of the ninth, Rafael Lantigua singled, John Aiello walked and Spencer Horwitz singled to load the bases with no outs. Orelvis Martinez hit a sacrifice fly to win the game. It was one of five walk-offs for New Hampshire in 2022 – and so far, the only game-winner for Martinez.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (41-35) earned a series win in Miami with a 6-3 win yesterday afternoon. A five-run second inning would be all the Jays, and Kevin Gausman, would need. Cavan Biggio went 2-for-3 with a double and an RBI. Jordan Romano notched his 22nd save working around a hit and a walk in the ninth. Toronto is off today ahead of a home series with Oakland...Triple-A Buffalo (31-40) lost at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the Triple-A battle of Jays-Yankees. LJ Talley had a pair of hits and Casey Lawrence fell to 2-6 despite a quality start (6.0 IP, 1 ER, 5 K)...High-A Vancouver (37-27) fell 5-1 at Eugene last night. Catcher Jommer Hernandez had three hits for the Canadians. In his second start, Ryan Jennings allowed two runs in 4.0 IP. 23-year old was Toronto's fourth round pick in 2022 (Louisiana Tech)...Class A Dunedin (32-33) won 11-5 over Clearwater in a game called in the ninth (rain). Brody Rodning earned the win in relief with a scoreless frame, and has now pitched six scoreless innings in five outings as he works back from an injury.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats will finish the first half of the season this week against the defending Eastern League champion Somerset Patriots. The next homestand starts Wednesday, June 28 against Portland - which will feature four Fireworks Nights, including July 3.
