By the Numbers

The Lake County bullpen has pitched 17 straight scoreless innings, dating back to its 7-6 win versus Fort 17 Wayne back on May 1. The Captains' bullpen ranks 4th in the Midwest League with a 3.51 ERA.

All 9 Captains batters have reached safely in its last 2 games versus Fort Wayne this past week. Lake County's offense scored a combined 16 runs, while posting a +15 run differential over those contests.

Since LHP Parker Messick's High-A debut on June 29, 2023, his 108 strikeouts are the most by a pitcher at the High-A level. The 108 next-most strikeouts in High-A are 92 by Bowling Green RHP Duncan Davitt, and the next-highest mark in the Midwest League are the 72 by Cedar Rapids RHP Zebby Matthews

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: Lake County closed a 7-game series against Fort Wayne with a 6-0 win, pitching its second shutout of the season and series on Sunday afternoon at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake.

OF **Guy Lipscomb** drove in a pair of runs with a 2-run single. This extended his RBI streak to 3, which is tied for the longest active streak in the Midwest League. DH Nate Furman also plated a run on an RBI single, stretching his on-base streak to 16 games.

SHUT 'EM DOWN: With a 6-0 win on Sunday and 1-0 win this past Tuesday, Lake County recorded multiple shutouts in the same series for the first time since 8/30-9/4/2022 at Great Lakes (2-0 win on 8/31, 4-0 win on 9/4).

WE COULD BE ZEROS: RHP Austin Peterson recorded his 2nd scoreless start in 6 days, pitching 6 shutout innings on Sunday after a season-high 7.2 scoreless frames in a 1-0 win on Tuesday. The former 2022 9th-round pick out of UConn has now thrown 15.2 straight scoreless innings and recorded 3 straight quality starts.

ANOTHER BULLPEN BLANKING: LHP Steve Hajjar and RHP Zane Morehouse combined for 3 shutout innings in relief. The Captains' bullpen has now pitched 17 straight scoreless innings, dating back to the 7th inning of a 7-6 win against Fort Wayne on Wednesday.

TAKING ADVANTAGE: As a team, the Captains batted .365 (23for-63) with runners in scoring position this past week, which was the best mark in all of High-A.

CONGRATS, CC!: 19-year MLB vet and 2007 AL Cy Young Award winner CC Sabathia was named the 48th member of the Cleveland Guardians Hall of Fame on Thursday. While he did not pitch for ake County, Sabathia went 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA in three starts for its predecessor, the Columbus RedStixx (Columbus, Georgia).

21ST SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the ake County Captains. In 2,758 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,386-1,372 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in ranchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

THAT'S OUR GUY: In this past week's series against Fort Wayne, OF Guy Lipscomb collected a team-best 9 hits and batted a team-best .500 for the series. On Saturday, Lipscomb went 4-for-4 and reached base in all 5 of his plate appearances. His 4 knocks marked a new Minor Leaguehigh, and were the most in his baseball career since 4/3/2022 versus Purdue in his junior season at Belmont. Lipscomb finished the series with .591 OBP, which was the third-best in the Midwest League in this span.

TOP QUALITY: Through 26 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded a Midwest League-best 8 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs). Cedar Rapids has the next-most quality starts by a Midwest League eam so far this season with 4. The other 11 Midwest League teams besides Lake County have a combined 14 quality starts so far this year.

BASH BROS 2.0: Captains INF/OF C.J. Kayfus and INF Alex Mooney. MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, have been the MWL's premier slugging tandem. The duo has accounted for 30.7% of Lake County's run roduction, while hitting 8 of the team's 20 home runs.

ON BASE MACHINES: Captains INFs Maick Collado and Nate Furman are each riding team-high 16-game on base streaks. Their streaks are tied for the second-longest active streaks in the Midwest League, trailing only South Bend's Yohendrick Pinango (20).

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has een one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in strikeouts (132, T-2nd), ewest walks (26, 1st), wins (9, 1st), WHIP (1.15, 3rd) innings pitched (129.0, 2nd), and ERA (3.52, 5th).

SATURDAY NIGHT'S ALRIGHT: Saturday night's 10-1 win versus Fort Wayne marked the first time since at least 2005 that the Captains scored 10+ runs in the first 2 innings of a single game. Lake County had scored 9 hrough 2 innings 3 previous times (9/6/2023 vs. Lansing, 4/24/2016 at ansing, and 4/23/2011 vs. Bowling Green). The Captains' 10 runs scored were their 2nd-most in a game this year (12, 4/20 vs. Lansing), while their +9 run differential was its largest in a single game this season.

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: Six players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in Round 3, C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.

LAST TIME OUT: Back on May 1 vs. Fort Wayne, Messick did not record a decision in an eventual 7-6 walk-off win. The left-hander pitched a season-high 6 innings for his second consecutive start, allowing a career-high 8 hits (tied) and no walks, while throwing 6 strikeouts in 87 pitches (60 strikes). After 3 scoreless innings, the TinCaps scored four runs in the top of the fourth courtesy of a leadoff home run, then an RBI double and a pair of RBI singles with two outs in the half-inning.

2023 AGAINST THE DRAGONS: Messick made one start against the Dayton Dragons in 2023. In Game 2 of a doubleheader, the left-hander recorded then-High-A-bests of 5.1 innings pitched, 3 hits allowed, and 1 earned run allowed, while issuing two walks and throwing 10 strikeouts in 88 pitches (54 strikes). This marked Messick's first career game with double-digit strikeouts in his Minor League career.

BEST SINCE BIBEE: Messick's 1.77 ERA through 3 starts this season was the lowest by a Captain through three starts in a season since RHP and 2023 American League ROTY Finalist Tanner Bibee posted a 0.00 ERA through 3 starts in 2022.

MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Messick ranks tied for 3rd in the Midwest League with Cedar Rapids RHP Andrew Morris in strikeouts (33), 3rd in innings pitched (26.1), and 10th in ERA (2.73). Since his High-A debut on 6/29/2023 vs. Fort Wayne, Messick's 108 strikeouts are the most in all of High-A.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Messick is currently Cleveland's No. 21 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Per Baseball America, "He throws from a low release point, which helps him get swings and misses on his fastball. His tumbling changeup is his best pitch and gives him a strong weapon against right-handed hitters."

2023 IN REVIEW: Messick started his first career 13 games with Single-A Lynchburg from April 7 to June 10 before starting 11 of 13 games with High-A Lake County from June 29 to September 9. Messick finished second in the Cleveland player development system with 136 strikeouts and a 3.77 ERA. In his final 7 starts for the Captains, he posted a 2.52 ERA, 48 strikeouts, 12 walks and a .211 opposing average in 35.2 innings of work. Overall, Messick also recorded 6 quality starts (4 with Single-A Lynchburg, 2 with Lake County). He was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week after earning his second career Minor League win, pitching a career-high 7 innings and allowing career-lows of 1 hit (since tied), zero runs (tied), and zero walks (tied), while throwing a then-career-high 7 strikeouts on May 10 against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (CHC).

FLORIDA STATE PHENOM: Messick had a stellar college career at Florida State. In 2020, as a true freshman, he was named a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American. Then, in 2021, as a redshirt freshman, Messick became just the second-ever player to be named ACC Pitcher & Freshman of the Year in the same season. He was also named a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award, as he finished with a .225 batting average, 9 hits, one home run, and 5 RBI on the season as a hitter. Messick's 2021 performance led to him being named a 3rd Team All-American by four different publications, as well as pitching for the 2021 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team. Finally, in 2022, he led Florida State with 144 strikeouts, as he was the only ACC pitcher named a finalist for both the 2022 Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy. Messick was also named a 2022 1st Team NCBWA All-American. When his collegiate career ended, Messick was FSU's all-time leader with a 6.7 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
