FROM THE DOG HOUSE

A STROMS A BREWIN': Right-hander **Ethan Storm** will take the ball for Charleston in game three of the series. Strom is coming off a tremendous month of June where he posted a 2.70 ERA over 20 innings of work. Across his four starts over the stretch, he completed five-or-more three times. Last week at Augusta, Storm tossed just one inning after a taxing 39-pitch frame that was paced by a 14-pitch two-out walk to Juan Mateo. He was selected in the 13th Round by the Rays last season out of Rock Valley CC (IL).

SETTING THE TONE: Left-hander **Dominic Fritton** set the tone in game one of the series with the Shorebirds, delivering six shutout innings. In the process, he fanned eight and allowed just five base runners. His 85 strikeouts are the most of any left hander in the Carolina League, and third most in Single-A this season. The RiverDogs bullpen slammed the door with three scoreless frames between **Jacob Hartlaub** and **Bryce Shaffer** as the club secured its third shutout victory of the season, and first since 5/28 at Columbia. It marked their first shutout victory of the year to not come via a complete game shutout. At the plate, Cooper Flemming and Brady Marget each notched multiple hits, and delivered back-to-back RBI doubles in the seven the blow the game open.

BACK TO THE FUTURE: Two former Charleston RiverDogs, outfielder **Theo Gillen** and catcher **Nathan Flewelling**, were named to the 2026 Futures Game rosters on Tuesday. Gillen, Tampa Bay's first-round selection in the 2024 MLB Draft, spent the entire 2025 season with Charleston. In 73 games, he batted .267 with a .433 on-base percentage, five home runs and 36 stolen bases. He was recently ranked the No. 9 overall prospect in baseball by MLB Pipeline. Flewelling also spent most of the 2025 season with the RiverDogs, appearing in 102 games and posting a .408 on-base percentage. He enters the Futures Game ranked as MLB Pipeline's No. 76 overall prospect and No. 7 catching prospect.

DRIVIN' TO DELMARVA: The RiverDogs will face the Shorebirds for the first time since 2023 this week. The clubs met in two series that season, with the RiverDogs winning nine of the 12 games. Those matchups featured future stars such as Chandler Simpson and Samuel Basallo. The 572-mile trip between the two ballparks, which takes roughly eight and a half hours by bus, is the RiverDogs' longest road trip of the season.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Charleston RiverDogs clinched the Carolina League South Division First Half Title with a victory over Wilson on Tuesday night, securing a berth in the 2026 Carolina League postseason. The playoff appearance marks Charleston's first since 2024 and its fifth in the last six seasons since rejoining the Tampa Bay Rays organization in 2021. Charleston is seeking its first Carolina League title since 2023, when the club captured its third consecutive championship. The best-of-three Division Series begins on Tuesday, September 8. Thanks to their first-half division title, the RiverDogs are guaranteed to host Game 2, and, if necessary, Game 3, at The Joe on September 10 and 11.

HIGH LEVERAGE HEROS: Charleston has thrived in tight games this season, going 17-12 in one-run decisions and 22-14 in contests decided by two runs or less. Their 17 one-run wins are the second most in Minor and Major League Baseball, placing them only behind Richmond. Part of their success has come via their late-inning success. Additionally, they've tallied eight walk-off wins this year. In fact, eight of their 22 home victories have come in walk-off fashion (36%). They are tied with Spokane for the third most walk-off wins in all of Minor League Baseball this season.
