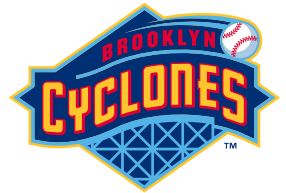

LAST TIME OUT: Winston-Salem tallied 5 runs in the bottom of the 7th to rally and defeat Brooklyn, 6-4, on Saturday night...RF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed a solo home run in the 2nd...CF **Jaylen Palmer** provided a 3-run double in the 6th to put the Cyclones up, 4-1...The Dash tied it in the 7th on a 2-run homer by LF **D.J. Gladney** and took the lead on a 2-run blast by 3B **Wes Kath**...RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out a career-high 7 in a no-decision for Brooklyn...LHP **Brooks Gosswein** also punched out 7 in a no-decision for the Dash...RHP **Dylan Burns** earned his first win and LHP **Jake Palisch** added his first save...RHP **Joshua Cornielli** suffered his first loss for the Cyclones.

FULLY LOADED: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

PARADA POWER: C **Kevin Parada** is off to marvelous start in his first full professional season...The No. 11 pick in last year's MLB draft has reached base in all 8 games played in Brooklyn...Parada has coaxed more walks (9) than strikeouts (8) in 38 plate appearances...The Pasadena, Calif. native enters Sunday's series finale leading the league in runs scored (9)...He is also tied for 2nd in the circuit in walks (8).

CAN'T STOP CONSUEGRA: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has felt right at home in Winston-Salem this week...During the series, Consuegra is 8-for-20 (.400) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, and 10 RBI...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 4 hits and fell one RBI short of matching his career-best with 4 RBI on Thursday...Consuegra's 4-hit game was the first for a Cyclone since C **José Mena** tallied 4 vs. Wilmington last September 1...The Dominican native's previous 4-hit night came with Brooklyn on July 13, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Coming into Sunday, Consuegra is tied for the SAL lead in home runs (3) and RBI (10)...He is 2nd in extra-base hits (6) and total bases (22), tied for 3rd in hits (10), 7th in slugging (.688), and 8th in OPS (1.109).

RED HOT RAMÍREZ: OF **Alex Ramírez** comes into the weekend riding a season-high 3-game hitting streak...The 20-year-old is 6-for-his-last-13 (.462) with 4 runs scored, a double, a home run, 5 RBI, and 2 walks...Ramírez has collected multiple hits in consecutive games and has registered at least 1 RBI in each game during the streak...The outfielder is tied for 8th in the SAL in hits (9) and tied for 9th in total bases (14).

KING CÉSAR: INF **César Berbesi** has bounced back from an injury-plagued 2022 in style...The 23-year-old has reached base in each of his first 6 games in 2023...Berbesi is 8-for-21 (.381) at the plate with 7 runs scored, a triple, and 4 RBI...Berbesi enters Sunday's finale 3rd in the SAL in on-base percentage (.567)...He is also tied for 4th in walks (8) and runs scored (7), and tied for 5th in batting average (.381)...Berbesi has walked 74 times compared to only 83 strikeouts in 102 career games.

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn travels to North Carolina for their first matchup against the White Sox' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast 10 of the Pale Hose top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...RHP **Norge Vera** (8), RHP **Jonathan Cannon** (11), RHP **Kohl Simas** (13), OF **Wilfred Veras** (17), INF **Wes Kath** (18), OF **Terrell Tatum** (24), INF **Loideli Chapellí** (26), and RHP **Andrew Dalquist** (28) are all on Winston-Salem's active roster...INF **Colson Montgomery** (1) and RHP **Jared Kelley** (14) are currently on the injured list...The Cyclones went 7-5 in their first 12 matchups against the Dash in 2022...Brooklyn won 4-of-6 from Winston-Salem at Truist Park from September 6-11, the final series of the regular season.

GRAB SOME PINE: Brooklyn pitching racked up strike outs in bunches on Friday night...Cyclones pitchers combined to whiff a season-high 17 Winston-Salem hitters in an 8-3 victory...RHP **Raimon Gómez** punched out a career-high 7 over 3.0 frames to start...LHP **Daniel Juárez** (5), RHP **Manny Rodriguez** (3), and RHP **Jace Beck** (2) united to retire 10 in relief...The 17 K's are the most for Brooklyn pitching since they reached that number in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The 17 strikeouts are tied for the most by a pitching staff in a South Atlantic League game this year...Aberdeen and Greenville also struck out 17 on April 8 and 15, respectively.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)...Including 2023, holds a career record of 108-97 (.527).

NEW DRAFT CLASS: The New York Mets' 2022 MLB draft class brings six arms and three bats to Coney Island in 2023...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2nd round), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6th), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (8th), RHP **Paul Gervase** (12th), RHP **Cameron Foster** (14th), and RHP **Jordan Geber** (UDFA) all begin the season on pitching coach **Victor Ramos'** staff...C **Kevin Parada** — the No. 11 overall pick — joins INF **Chase Estep** (9th) and INF **Brad Malm** (UDFA) headlining the offensive firepower.

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss in his season debut on Tuesday at Winston-Salem...Surrendered a career-high 5 runs (4 earned) on 4 hits over 4.1 innings...Walked 3 and struck out 6...Yielded a 2-run home run in the 4th to 2B **Loidel Chapelli**...Threw 83 pitches (51 strikes)...Produced 14 swings-and-misses...Relieved by RHP **Paul Gervase** with the bases loaded and 1 out in the bottom of the 5th and Brooklyn trailing, 3-2...2-of-3 bequeathed runners scored...The 'Clones brought the tying run to the plate in the 9th, but fell to the Dash, 5-3.

TOP PROSPECT: Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 7 overall on the Top 30 list...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by *Baseball America*...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

2022: Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts...Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

VOLUNTEER SERVICE: Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.

LORETTO LIGHTNING: Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 first-round pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP **Ryan Weathers**...Ryan's father, **David**, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
