TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve wrap up with the Erie SeaWolves for the first of three series between the clubs this season. Jaden Hamm and Troy Melton lead the pitching staff for the SeaWolves with Max Anderson and Trei Cruz highlight the position player group.

On the mound, Troy Melton takes the ball for Erie. Melton has pitched four times against Altoona, recording a 5.19 ERA in 17.1 innings. Melton was Detroit's 4th round pick in 2022 out of San Diego State where he was collegiate teammates with Pirates farmhands Mike Jarvis and Wyatt Hendrie. He was the Mountain West's Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2022 and he shared the award with Air Force's Paul Skenes. Melton's father, Charles, played college soccer at the University of Arizona and growing up in the Anaheim-area, he told SDSU Sports Information that his favorite athlete while growing up was Mike Trout

ENTER SANDMAN: Closer Cam Sanders has dazzled in his 12 outings with the Curve this season. His .083 batting average against ranks 1st among Double-A relievers (min. 10.0 IP), he is also 1st in saves (8) among minor league players. Sanders has been unscored upon in 11-of-12 outings this season and became the first Curve reliever to pick up 7 saves in a calendar month (April) since **Matt Eckelman** saved 8 games in June of 2019. **Justin Kaye** (June, 2005) and Matt Peterson (June, 2007) hold the record for saves in a month by a Curve pitcher with 9.

WE'RE AT THE DOTEL HOTEL: Starter Wilber Dotel matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts on Sunday, May 4 against Akron. It was the first 10-K performance by the Curve since Thomas Harrington struck out 10 Somerset Patriots last July 20, 2024. For the season, he holds a 22.1% K-BB% after he recorded an 11.2% mark in 2024 with Greensboro. Additionally, he has increased his First Pitch Strike% from 42.6% in 2023 to 51.1% in 2025 and has struck out 7 or more batters in 4-of-his-last-5 starts. <u>In his last 5 outings, he's struck out 34 batters in 22.2 IP.</u> He ranks 3rd in the Eastern League in stikeouts (41) and 8th in IP (31.1).

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen). Overall, Curve starters held a 1.08 WHIP, 2nd among Double-A staffs and 3.02 ERA, 3rd among Double-A clubs through play on May 10.

JEBBING: Utilityman Mitch Jebb had a 15 game on-base streak end on Friday, May 9. During the hot streak he hit .393 (22-for-56) with 4 2B, 5 BB and 7-7 SB. His .383 on-base percentage this season is 10th in the Eastern League.

CAPTAIN JACK: Infielder Jack Brannigan is on a lengthy on-base streak of his own; 16 games, entering play on Sunday, May 11. He's picked up 14 hits and walked 8 times during this stretch, recording a .749 OPS.

SCAN THIS BARCODE FOR OUTS: Lefty Hunter Barco tossed 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, the longest stretch franchise history. Barco was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April. Barco was one of 2 qualified pitchers in the minors with a 0.00 ERA at the time of his promotion to Triple-A on May 6.

A YOUNG MAN'S GAME: Infielder Termarr Johnson opens as the youngest position player in the Eastern League at 20 years old, just two days younger than Reading's Aidan Miller. Among Double-A players, he is the 7th-youngest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's Ethan Salas (SD, 18.8 years old). Johnson <u>has reached base safely in 32-of-42</u> games with the Curve and has a hit in 21-of-28 games to begin the season.

THE PIRATES ARE THIEVES: Altoona enters play on Sunday, May 11, 3rd among Double-A clubs with 52 stolen bases in 58 tries. Mitch Jebb leads the club with 12 steals, 6th among Eastern Leaguers.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10).
