On the Road Again

The Fightin Phils hit the road and continue a six-game series at the Akron Rubber Ducks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. It is the ninth-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and third-of-six at Canal Park. The Rubber Ducks took four-of-six from Reading at FirstEnergy Stadium from July 9-14, and currently lead the season-series 6-2. This is Reading's first trip to Akron since Apr. 12-16, of the 2022 season.

Late Rally Falls Short

Three runs in the ninth inning were not enough as the Fightin Phils fell 8-6 to the RubberDucks on Wednesday night. Taijuan Walker started and was strong over five innings, allowing two hits and one run with three strikeouts. Christian McGowan lasted just 1.1 innings in relief and was roughed up for seven runs, dropping him to 0-2. Reading put up 15 hits offensively, which is their second-most in a game this season. Justin Crawford, Otto Kemp and Robert Moore all had three hits, while Gabriel Rincones Jr. and Ethan Wilson each chipped in two. Crawford and Rincones Jr. also each had two RBI a piece.

Crawford's Cruising

Justin Crawford had another three hits and two RBI in Wednesday night's game for the Fightin Phils. The Phillies No. 3 Propsect has been on a roll since making his Double-A debut on July 19 at Portland. Over 13 games since then, Crawford is slashing .345/.390/.436, with an .826 OPS. Crawford's added six runs, five doubles, eight RBI and seven stolen bases over that stretch as well. He's also currently on a eight-game hitting streak, dating back to July 26. Over the hitting streak, Crawford is hitting .353, which ranks as the 10th best batting average in the Eastern League over that stretch. Crawford's also had five multi-hit games over his 13 contests with Reading, including a trio of three-hit games as well.

Mr. Otto-Matic

Otto Kemp turned in another strong perfromance for the Fightin Phils on Wednesday night. Kemp had three hits, including a triple, run scored and RBI. Kemp is up to .271, with nine homers and 29 RBI since his call-up on June 11. He's been strong in August so far, slashing .350/.381/.500, with an .881 OPS. Since June 11, Kemp is tied for the Eastern League lead in home runs and is tied for seventh in RBI.

Wonderful Wilson

Ethan Wilson turned in another strong perfromance on Wednesday night, going two-for-five. So far in August, Wilson is slashing .412/.474/.882, with a 1.356 OPS. He's added three runs, two doubles, two home runs and four RBI. Wilson's had two hits in three-of-five games so far this month.

Welcome to the Bakeshow

Andrew Baker perhaps turned in his best outing of the season on Tuesday night. Baker struck out five over two-perfect innings. It set a new career-high in strikeouts for Baker, surpassing his previous high of four, which he did four times in his career, dating back to 2021. Baker has not allowed a run in his last two outings.

Defense Delivering

The Fightin Phils defense has been rock solid since the conclusion of the All-Star Break. Reading ranks second in the Eastern League in fielding percentage since July 19 at .987. The R-Phils have committed just eight errors, which is tied for second fewest in the league over that stretch. Additionally, the Fightin Phils have turned 21 double plays since July 19, which is tied for the most in the Eastern League over the stretch.

All nine Reading starters have at least one hit.

The Ducks

Akron enters tonight after finishing in third place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for the first half with a 37-32 record. They are first in the Southwest Division with a 24-11 record in the second half of the season. Akron most recently split a six-game series with Harrisburg at FNB Field. Following this week, Akron heads to Erie. Akron's roster features six players ranked amongst the Cleveland Guardians' top-30 prospects: Chase DeLauter (1), Kahlil Watson (13), Petey Halpin (14), Parker Messick (20), CJ Kayfus (25) and Dayan Frias (26).

Duck on the Bump

Righty Aaron Davenport makes the start tonight for Akron. This season, he's 6-4, with a 2.72 ERA over 20 starts. Davenport's pitched 106 innings, allowed 87 hits, walked 35 and struck out 102 hitters. He last pitched August 3 at Harrisburg, suffereing the loss, as he allowed two runs on six hits over five innings, but did strike out a season-high 10 hitters. Davenport was solid at Reading on July 13, but suffered the loss, allowing just one run on one hit over five innings, with four strikeouts. Davenport spent all of 2022 and '23 with High-A Lake County, going 6-10, with a 5.73 ERA over 24 appearances/19 starts in 2023. The Guardians drafted Davenport in the sixth round of the 2021 draft out of Hawaii. He pitched at Hawaii from 2019-21, while also pitching on the Cape in 2019 and 2021.
