#### LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox were held scoreless for a second night in a row against the Akron RubberDucks in a 6-0 loss on Saturday. The RubberDucks blasted three solo home runs on the night, including two from Alexfri Planez and one by Petey Halpin. Akron also scored two unearned runs in the fifth. Akron starting pitcher Tommy Mace threw six scoreless innings and the Baysox mustered only four hits on the night in the defeat. Bowie starter Seth Johnson lasted just three innings, gave up a pair of solo homers, two walks and struck out three to receive the loss.

#### REVIEWING THE RUBBERDUCKS

Entering this week, the Akron RubberDucks own the best record in the Eastern League at 18-9. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians has won 12 of their last 13, including at one point winning 10 in a row. A league-low 2.38 ERA has helped the RubberDucks win their last two series against Altoona and Richmond. Four of the Guardians' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- IF Kahlil Watson (No. 14), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 25) and IF Dayan Frias (No. 29).

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Rodney Boone makes his fourth start of the season and his sixth overall appearance. Boone is off to a respectable start in his first season at Double-A. In 25.1 innings pitched, he has struck out 20 batters and walked just seven with a 2.84 ERA and a 0.91 WHIP. Opponents are batting just .184 against the southpaw. The 24-year-old has spent the last two seasons in High-A Lake County. In two seasons with the Captains, Boone posted a 4.88 ERA in 31 appearances, threw 145.2 innings with 164 strikeouts over 53 walks. The left-hander was drafted in the 8th round of the 2021 Draft out of UC Santa Barbara.

#### SCORING STRUGGLES

The Baysox have been held scoreless for 23 consecutive innings, which is the longest scoreless streak by the team this season. The last run scored by Bowie was in the third inning of Thursday's win when Dylan Beavers plated home Austin Hays with a double to left. Since Bowie dropped 17 runs in eight innings in the series opener on Tuesday, Bowie has scored just four runs over the last 35 innings.

#### ON-BASE BOWENS

After going 1-for-4 last night, 1B **TT Bowens** now owns a batting average of .333, good for third in the Eastern League behind Binghamton's Rhylan Thomas (.347) and Hartford's Zac Veen (.337). After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is amongst the league leaders in several offensive categories. The 25-year-old is is tied for second in RBI (22), is third in slugging percentage (.575), fourth in OPS (.973), and fourth in XBH (13).

#### THE FABULOUS FABIAN

After a slow start to the season, OF Jud Fabian has picked it up since the calendar turned to the month of May. The Orioles No. 12 prospect leads all Eastern League hitters in May with four homers and is tied for second in RBI with nine. Fabian's six homers on the season lead the team and he has now swatted 21 career home runs in 89 Double-A games.

#### RELIEVERS STAY READY

After six more innings and six more strikeouts from Baysox relievers last night, Bowie's bullpen continues to lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (149.2) and strikeouts (190). 15 of the 16 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Opposing hitters are batting just .208 against the Baysox bullpen, which is good for the eighth-lowest average in all of Double-A.

#### YOU GOOD PHAM

RHP Alex Pham makes his seventh start of the season and his 16th career start with Bowie. The Orioles No. 24 prospect is coming off his best start of the season in the series opener against Akron on Tuesday. The righty spun five innings of one-hit, one-run ball with no walks and six strikeouts to pick up the first win by a Bowie starting pitcher this season. It's the first time this year where Pham did not issue a walk all game. This will be his fourth career start against the RubberDucks

#### HOME SWEET HOME

The Baysox are the first team in the Eastern League to have won 12 games at home. At home this season, the Baysox are first in runs scored (111), first in hits (158), first in walks (88), first in home runs (25), and second in OPS (.789).

2023: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after delivering 5.0 IP, matched season-high 6 K over 1 H and 1 R allowed. Did not walk a batter for first time this season...Recorded first win by a Baysox starter this year...Has a 7.47 ERA at home in four starts...2.77 ERA in three career starts vs AKR.

**2023:** Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. 1.63 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

**2022:** Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

**2021:** Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

**Personal:** Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

#### CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of Mil.B's "Copa de la Diversión<sup>TM</sup>" or "Fun Cup<sup>TM</sup>" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX**

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s
