The Fightin Phils finish a six-game series tonight against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. It is the sixth-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and final-of-six in Reading. The teams did not face off in 2023, as the last time Reading and Akron played was in Akron from Apr. 12-16, 2022. This is the first time the RubberDucks are in Baseballtown since Aug. 10-15, 2021. Akron leads the season series 4-1.

The Fightin Phils snapped a four-game losing streak thanks to a 1-0 shutout victory over Akron. It marked the fourth shutout of the season for Reading and first since June 9 against Harrisburg. Lachlan Wells was excellent, going seven innings and allowing three hits, one walk and striking out three. Cristian Hernandez posted a scoreless eigth for the hold and Andrew Schultz earned his second save with a scoreless ninth. Carson Taylor provided Reading's offense with a solo home run in the fourth inning and that was all the Fightin Phils needed in their first win of the series. The 2:10 game was the shortest home game this season.

### Here Comes Crawford

The Phillies announced that No. 3 Prospect Justin Crawford was promoted to Reading from High-A Jersey Shore on Friday. Crawford will begin his Reading tenure on the Development List as himself, and Aidan Miller, participated in the All-Star Futures Game in Arlington, Texas on Saturday. With Jersey Shore, Crawford slashed .301/.349/.438, with a .787 OPS. He added 54 runs, 14 doubles, four triples, six homers, 35 RBI and 27 stolen bases over 70 games. Crawford hit .344 over 69 games with Single-A Clearwater last season, earning a late-season promotion to Jersey Shore. He was named the Florida State League MVP after the 2023 campaign. The Phillies selected Crawford in the first round (17th overall) of the 2022 draft out of Bishop Gorman High School in Las Vegas. Crawford's father is former big leaguer Carl Crawford, who played from 2002-16 and was on the 2008 Rays team the Phillies beat in the World Series.

### "Locked In" Wells

Lachlan Wells continued his recent hot stretch with his best outing of the season. The southpaw went seven innings, allowing just three hits, and striking out three in Saturday's win over Akron. It marked the third win in four starts for Wells and also the seventh-straight he went five innings or more. Wells also has gone six innings or more in seven of his last nine starts. So far in July, wells is 2-0, with a 2.00 ERA, while striking out 13 hitters over 18 innings. Wells currently ranks second amongst qualifiers in the Eastern League with a 1.06 WHIP. Wells also ranks second in the Eastern League with a 6.60 strikeout-to-walk ratio, trailing only teammate Robinson Pina. Wells' outing marked the fourth time a Reading starter has gone seven innings this season, which Reading is 4-0.

### Taylor Back on Track

After a recent slow stretch, Carson Taylor has picked up where he had been for most of the season this week. Over four games this week, Taylor is slashing .417/.533/.750, with a 1.283 OPS. He's added three runs, a double, home run and three RBI. He's also walked three times and not struck out once.

Sine June 1, the Fightin Phils lead the Eastern League in home runs hit at 48. That recent surge has propelled the Fightin Phils to second in the Eastern League in home runs with 90. They trail Somerset by five and are ahead of third-place Erie by 10. That stretch featured a team-best home runs in 13-straight games from June 13-28, which tied a mark set by the 2016 Fightin Phils. Currently, Reading has homed in nine-straight games, dating back to July 3.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

July 14, 2023: At Reading, the R-Phils beat Portland 9-2. David Parkinson starts and strikes out ten, setting a season-high for him and the team in punchouts. Reading hits five homers, including two from Baron Radcliff and back-to-back blasts from Carlos De La Cruz and Matthew Kroon. Oliver Dunn also chipped in three extra-base hits. Earlier in the day, Johan Rojas is called up to the Philadelphia Phillies.

Akron enters tonight after finishing in third place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for the first half with a 37-32 record. They are first in the Southwest Division with a 13-4 record in the second half of the season. Akron most recently took four-of-six in their split series with Erie. Following this week, Akron hosts Richmond in their first series after the break. Akron's roster features six players ranked amongst the Cleveland Guardians' top-30 prospects: Chase DeLauter (1), Kahlil Watson (14), Peter Halpin (15), Parker Messick (21), CJ Kayfus (27) and Dayan Frias (28).

### Duck on the Bump

Righty Tommy Mace makes the start tonight for Akron. This season, Mace is 7-3, with a 3.59 ERA over 17 appearances and 16 starts (92.2 IP, 84 H, 27 BB, 69 SO). Mace took a win in his last start on Tuesday against, allowing one run on two hits over six innings, with one walk and four strikeouts. Mace split 2023 between High-A Lake County and Akron, combining to go 6-6, with a 4.63 ERA over 24 games and 17 starts. He made his pro debut in 2022 with Lake County, going 1-5, with a 4.55 ERA over 22 games and 21 starts. The Guardians selected Mace in the CB-B Round of the 2021 draft out of Florida. Mace went 22-7, with a 4.37 ERA over his four seasons at Florida. He participated with the 2019 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team, as well.
