LAST OUTING: Hall went 2.2 innings with zero runs allowed in his fifth rehab start. It was his longest outing and the most pitches he has thrown on rehab (46 pitches).

AGAINST OPPONENT: Hall has faced Jacksonville a whopping nine times (five in 2022, three in 2023). Four of the his eighth appearances have been starts and he holds a 3-2 overall record against the Jumbo Shrimp. His most recent appearances before the series opener against Jacksonville came on August 11, 2023 where he allowed two earned runs across 1.2 innings in a loss. He set his career-high in strikeouts with 14 on July 6, 2022.
