#### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox fell in the series opener to Erie by a final score of 10-6. Enrique Bradfield Jr. returned from the injured list and hit a three-run homer in the second. Creed Willems and Max Wagner both recorded multi-hit games and a double each. Albert Suárez threw two innings but gave up four runs in a Major League rehab start. Blake Money fanned a Double-A high nine batters in six innings of relief. The Baysox have now lost 11 of their last 12 games.

#### **BRADFIELD IS BACK**

In his first game back off the injured list, OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. hit a three-run homer in the second inning, his first career three RBI game at Double-A. The Orioles No. 4 prospect has missed 53 games this season due to hamstring injuries. In July, Bradfield was selected to the MLB All-Star Futures Game along with former **Baysox RHP Keagan Gillies.** 

#### SMOOTH LIKE BUTTER

IF Brandon Butterworth has adjusted to his new scenery just fine. One of six prospects received in the Ryan O'Hearn/Ramon Laureano trade, Butterworth has reached base in his first nine games since joining the Baysox. The 22-year-old had the sixthmost extra-base hits (35) and the most triples (7) in the Midwest League during his time with High-A Fort Wayne (SD).

#### SOMEWHERE OVERN THE RAINBOW

OF Austin Overn made his Double-A debut with Chesapeake last Tuesday. The No. 30 Orioles prospect leads the Orioles farm with 49 stolen bases this season between High-A and Double-A. In his first Double-A series in Akron, Overn hit safely in four of five games and swiped six bases without getting caught.

#### ESTRADA IS ELECTRIC

IF Aron Estrada was promoted to Double-A Chesapeake two weeks ago. In his first Double-A series against New Hampshire, Estrada homered in each of his first two games at the level and registered hits in five of six contests. The 20-year-old led High-A Aberdeen in AVG, H, 2B, 3B, RBI and OBP at the time of his promotion.

Chesapeake has won just 15 games at home this season, which is tied for the fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. The Baysox have dropped 26 of their last 34 home games since May 27. The last time the Baysox finished a season at least 10 games below .500 at home was in 2016 (30-41). Chesapeake has yet to win a series at home this season.

#### **CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL**

Chesapeake has won 21 games in one-run fashion - which is tied for the most in the Eastern League and is tied for the second most in all of Double-A. Chesapeake has 11 extra inning wins, which is the most in full-season MiLB. The Baysox have played 38 one-run games this season, which is tied for the second-most in all of Double-A.

#### SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie SeaWolves - Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers - are playoff bound for a fourth straight season after clinching the first half in the Southwest Division with a 45-24 record. Erie is seeking its third straight Eastern League title. Erie's active roster includes seven of the Tigers' top 30 prospects (MLB.com) - IF Kevin McGonigle (No. 1), OF Max Clark (No. 2), C Josue Briceno (No. 3), C Thayron Liranzo (No. 5), RHP Jaden Hamm (No. 11), LHP Andrew Sears (No. 15) and IF John Peck (No. 17).

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Garrett Burhenn makes his 20th start of the season for Erie. The 25-year-old leads the Eastern League in wins (11), is seventh in WHIP (1,22) and is 10th in ERA (3.94) and strikeouts (87). Burhenn is coming off arguably his worst start of the year where he gave up a career-high 11 hits and matched his career-high with six runs allowed. The Indianapolis native holds a 1.50 ERA in four outings this season against the Baysox.

Ranked No. 11 Orioles prospect (via FanGraphs)

Touched 100.3 mph, struck out five and collected 3.0 inning save vs NYY in Spring Training

2025: Threw 3.2 IP and gave up 6 R (5 ER) on 6 H and 3 BB with 4 K in most recent start on 8/6 @ AKR. Since coming off IL, has recorded a 8.62 ERA in 15.2 IP in four outings (three starts). Looking to go five innings for the first time this season. Tallied a season-high 6 K on 7/30 vs NH. Was on IL from 4/23 - 7/17 with a lat strain. Made two rehab starts with High-A Aberdeen and gave up just 1 R in 8.0 IP with 12 K over 1 BB. Struck out seven in 4.0 IP in final rehab start on 7/11 vs Jersey Shore. Pitched 4.2 shutout innings with season-high 4 K in first and only start vs ALT on 4/5. Enters first season with Chesapeake.

**2024:** Spent first full season in Minors in High-A Aberdeen primarily as a starter. Pitched team-high 107.0 IP with 113 K over 55 BB to a 3.03 ERA. Tied for 5th-most IP, tied for 8th-most K while allowing 3rd-most BB in South Atlantic League. Held 2nd-lowest ERA by an O's Minor League qualified pitcher and threw 7th-most IP. Performed better in second half (2.20 ERA) than first half (3.99 ERA). July was his best month: 1.54 ERA in five starts with 23 K over 23.1 IP. Also registered a 0.81 WHIP. Had nine outings with at least six or more strikeouts. Struck out a career-high eight batters over 4.2 innings on 7/11 at Asheville. Dealt 4.2 shutout, hitless innings as the starting pitcher in Aberdeen's combined no-hitter, the third in franchise history and the first in Aberdeen, on 7/19 vs Wilmington.

Career Notes: Did not pitch in '23 after getting drafted.

**College:** Struck out 92 batters over 69.2 IP at a whopping rate of 11.9 K/9 in lone season at Troy. Began collegiate career at Lansing CC (MI) for two seasons before transferring to Eastern Michigan for two seasons. Pitched for Frederick Keys, former Class-A Advanced affiliate of Orioles, in MLB Draft League in summer of 2022. Led Draft League first-half pitchers with 36 K.

Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 9th round of the 2023 Draft out of Troy. Grew up in Ann Arbor, MI. Favorite pitcher growing up was Justin Verlander.

#### **ROBERTO MERCADO**

#### Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

#### **CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE**



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
