**FROG FRIDAY:** After picking up back-to-back close wins over the Shorebirds to take a 2-1 lead in the series, the FredNats become the Fredericksburg Frogs for the second time this year in game four with the Shorebirds. RHP Davian Garcia starts tonight looking to build on a very solid first professional season. He faces Shorebird lefty Chipper Menard, who has struggled in a small sample size this year.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats got going immediately on offense in last night's game, ambushing Shorebird starter Chase Allsup early to take a 2-0 lead. The Shorebirds rallied for four runs with two outs in the 5th inning against FredNat starter Angel Roman to take a 4-2 lead in the middle innings, but the FredNat offense had another big inning in the 6th. Fredericksburg got a game-tying two-run single from Yoander Rivero, and then Luke Dickerson drove in the eventual winning run with an RBI single. The FredNat bullpen allowed no hits and just one base runner in four innings, with Merritt Beeker earning the win and Robert Cranz picking up his second straight save.

HOME COOKIN': Fredericksburg is 16-11 at home this season compared to 7-19 on the road. In home games, the FredNat offense has a slash line of .229/.317/.326 for an OPS of .643, compared to a .209/.300/.308 line on the road for an OPS of just .608. On the mound, the FredNat pitching staff has an ERA of 3.67 at home compared to 4.34 on the road. Fredericksburg has played 19 total one-run games this year, with 11 of those coming on the road. In those 11 games, Fredericksburg is 2-9.

THIS GUY IS AMAZING: After picking up another outfield assist last night, Cristhian Vaquero is now tied for the Minor League Baseball lead in outfield assists with seven. Vaquero has four assists as a center fielder since he's taken over that role on daily basis for Fredericksburg, and also has three assists as right fielder.

**STARTING PITCHING REBOUND**: After finishing 10th out of 12 teams in the Carolina League in ERA in the month of April, the FredNat starting rotation turned it around in a big way in May. Fredericksburg's starters had an ERA of 3.85, which was ninth in all of Single-A and fourth in the Carolina League. In an eight-game time frame last road trip at Delmarva into last home stand, FredNat starters posted a 1.43 ERA - six earned runs in 47.2 innings - which was the second best mark in Minor League Baseball in that time frame. The first time the FredNat starters faced Delmarva, the group allowed four earned runs in 29.2 IP, which is an ERA of 1.21.

**THAT'S QUALITY:** Yoel Tejeda Jr. turned in the longest and potentially best start of the season for the FredNats Wednesday night, pitching seven innings of one-run ball with no walks and five strikeouts. Tejeda Jr. only needed 77 pitches to get through seven innings, and against the Shorebirds this year, he's pitched 13 innings of two-run ball with 11 strikeouts and no walks. Tejeda has not allowed more than three earned runs in any of his starts this year in his first professional season.

**USE THE FORCE**: Shortstop Luke Dickerson is off to a strong start for the FredNats since his promotion from the FCL three weeks ago. Washington's 6th-best prospect hit his second home run of the season and first at home Wednesday night, and he's hitting .273 with an OPS of .853. The 19-year-old already has nine extra-base hits in 19 games played for Fredericksburg. Since his call-up on 5/13, Dickerson has the third-most doubles (8) among all Single-A hitters and leads the FredNats in RBI (13).

**DON'T EVEN TRY IT:** The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach has been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 37% of base runners this year, which is one of the best rates in MiLB among qualified catchers and he ranks second in all of MiLB with 21 caught stealings. Rombach has 17 caught stealings, a top-10 mark in Single-A, and is throwing out 33% of potential base stealers this year.

**2024 CHAMPIONS**: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014.

**NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

**WELCOME TO FXBG:** Davian Abdiel Garcia...was selected by the Nationals with the 170th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Florida Gulf Coast last summer...this is his debut season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Garcia threw a career-high 94 pitches in his start last week at Lynchburg, dominating the Hillcats across 4.2 IP. He relied on his fastball for all seven strikeouts and didn't allow a hit until the last batter he faced. All in all, it was his first scoreless start since April 22 against Charleston.

**GOOD LUCK:** Garcia has not allowed more than four hits in eight consecutive starts since he allowed six in his first professional start. Across his last three starts, the righty has allowed just seven total hits in 16.1 IP with a combined 20 strikeouts. The one hit he gave up in his last start is a career best. Opponents are batting just .221 againt Garcia this year, tied for the fifth-best mark in the Carolina League.

**COLLEGE EDUCATED:** Garcia threw for two different schools over the course of his collegiate career. He was an All-ASUN First Team selection at Florida Gulf Coast University as a junior in 2024 after transferring in from Pasco Hernandez State. He finished the 2024 college season as FGCU's Friday night starter after starting the season as a reliever. All in all, he went 6-3 for the Eagles last year, spinning a 3.10 ERA across 61.0 IP and striking out 71 batters. He led the ASUN with a 2.89 conference ERA.

### **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



#### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



#### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
