YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels pulled out to an early lead and held off a late charge by the Baysox for a 7-5 win to open the 2022 season. Sean Roby opened the scoring with an RBI single in the top of the third inning. Tyler Fitzgerald added a sacrifice fly and Brandon Martorano drove in a run with a single to extend the lead to 3-0 against Bowie starter Drew Rom. Richmond starter Jake Dahlberg worked 4.1 scoreless innings in his Double-A debut. In the sixth, Jacob Heyward drove an RBI double and Brett Auerbach followed with a two-run homer to push the Richmond advantage to 6-0. The Baysox broke the shutout in the sixth inning with an RBI single by J.D. Mundy. Bowie added a run on a fielding error in the eighth, but Frankie Tostado extended the Flying Squirrels lead to 7-2 with an RBI single in the top of the ninth. In the bottom of the ninth, the Baysox plated three runs with two outs against Flying Squirrels reliever R.J. Dabovich. He recovered to strike out Mundy for the final out, stranding the potential tying run at the plate.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Richmond is looking to start a season 2-0 for the third time in franchise history, a mark previously reached in 2015 and 2019. Today's game is the first of back-to-back day games at Prince George's Stadium. This series is the first of three trips to Prince George's Stadium for the Flying Squirrels. The Baysox will come to Richmond for two series this season. For the year, the two teams will face each other 24 times, including 15 games in Bowie.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are back in action after posting a 57-56 record in 2021, the first winning season for the franchise since 2015. That mark placed the team fourth in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division standings, 13 games behind first-place Akron for the year. This year marks the Flying Squirrels' 12th season.

THE BAYSOX finished the 2021 season in second place in the Double-A Northeast, earning one of the league's two postseason spots. Bowie played in the Double-A Northeast Championship Series last year but was swept by Akron. This year's Baysox roster includes six of MLB.com's Top-30 Orioles prospects, including Gunnar Henderson (3), Jordan Westburg (6), Joseph Ortiz (15), Hudson Haskin (16), Drew Rom (17) and Adam Hall (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his Double-A debut. He spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-handed pitcher Brandon Young makes his Double-A debut. In his first professional season in 2021, Young combined to go 4-3 with a 3.52 ERA in 23 outings, including 20 stats, between Low-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen. He was not selected in the shortened MLB Draft in 2020 and signed as a free agent with the Baltimore Orioles. After two junior college seasons, he spent two years with the Ragin' Cajuns at Louisiana Lafayette, finishing his career with a 12.42 K/9 IP ratio.

WINNING AWAY: Friday's win was the Flying Squirrels' first Opening Day road win in franchise history and the first opener on the road since 2018. Richmond previously lost season-openers on the road in 2010, 2012, 2014 and 2018, and it was the road team in its own stadium in 2016 against Hartford as the Yard Goats' new stadium construction was being completed.

MARK IT EIGHT, DUDE: Flying Squirrels' Opening Day starter **Jake Dahlberg** struck out eight batters over his 4.1 innings on Friday night. The 28-year-old left-hander made his Double-A debut and did not allow a run. His eight strikeouts evened the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for punch-outs on Opening Day, matching **Dan Slania's** outing in the team's season-opener in 2017 against Hartford. Dahlberg's eight strikeouts was tied for second-most in the Eastern League on Friday night.

WHIFFS: The Richmond pitching staff combined for 15 strikeouts on Friday night, the most in an Opening Day game in franchise history. The previous high was 13, set in 2018 at Trenton. **Jake Dahlberg** had eight strikeouts in his start, **Ryan Walker** struck out two, **Chris Wright** had two strikeouts and **R.J. Dabovich** struck out the side in the ninth inning. Fifteen strikeouts was tied for the most on the Eastern League's first night of the new season, matching Bowie, Akron and Binghamton.

STARTING WITH A BANG: With his two-run homer on Friday night, **Brett Auerbach** became the sixth player in team history to hit a home run on Opening Day. **Mario Lisson** was the first with a two-run homer in 2014 at New Britain. **Ryder Jones** and **Ricky Oropesa** each homered in a loss at Hartford in 2016, the only multi-homer game for Richmond in a season-opener. **Chris Shaw** hit a two-run homer at The Diamond in 2017 against the Yard Goats. The most recent homer on Opening Day for a Richmond hitter before Friday was by **Dylan Davis** at Trenton in 2018.

THREE KNOCKS: **Brandon Martorano** picked up a Double-A career-high three hits on Friday night. It tied the most hits for a Flying Squirrels player on Opening Day in franchise history, evening performances by **Charlie Culberson** in 2011 and **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2015. Martorano was one of five players in the Eastern League to collect at least three hits on Friday.

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: On March 3, **Dennis Pelfrey** was named the new manager for the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Last year in his first season as a manager in affiliated baseball, he led the Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Pelfrey, 44, played six professional seasons in independent baseball from 1999-2004. He began his coaching career at South Grand Prairie High School in Texas in 2006, a position he held through 2015. He continued that role as he began his professional coaching career in 2011 with the Gary SouthShore RailCats, where he spent four seasons. Pelfrey landed his first managerial job in 2015 with the Florence Freedom of the independent Frontier League, a role he held for five seasons through 2019. He was hired by the Giants entering the 2020 season to manage High-A San Jose before the season was canceled due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. Under his direction last year, the Emeralds went 69-50 before topping Spokane in the High-A West Championship Series.

WHATS OLD IS NEW AGAIN: This year, Minor League Baseball's 11 leagues returned to their historical names after using regional names for the 2021 season. With the restructuring of the player development system prior to last season, the former Eastern League was referred to as the Double-A Northeast. This year, the circuit was renamed back to the Eastern League, which dates back to 1923. However, the league's divisions will continue with the new names adopted last year. The Flying Squirrels play in the Southeast Division, which was previously called the Western Division. The former Eastern Division was renamed the Northeast Division last year.

REWRITING THE RULES: New experimental rules are in effect during the Flying Squirrels' season. With runners on base, pitchers will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. The size of the bases has increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square in an attempt to reduce injuries. Defensively, teams must have a minimum of four players on the infield and two infielders complete on either side of second base.

SQUIRRELS AROUND THE WORLD: The Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster features players from four different countries, including 25 players who were born in the United States, spanning 14 states. Eight players are from California, three are from Washington, two are from Florida and North Carolina and one each hail from Alabama, Arkansas, Colorado, Connecticut, Georgia, Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Rhode Island and Texas. **Kai-Wei Teng** will become the second player born in Taiwan to play for the Flying Squirrels. **Franklin Labour** is a native of the Dominican Republic and **Diego Rincones** was born in Venezuela.

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's Opening Day roster includes 12 returning players from last year's squad, including pitchers **Tristan Beck**, **R.J. Dabovich**, **Matt Frisbee**, **Frank Rubio**, **Patrick Ruotolo** and **Ryan Walker**, catcher **Brandon Martorano**, infielders **Shane Matheny**, **Frankie Tostado** and **Will Wilson** and outfielders **Jacob Heyward** and **Diego Rincones**.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tristan Beck** (30), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes **Dabovich** (17), **Wilson** (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
