

Moreno twirled five nohit frames on Tuesday at Akron in the series opener with just one walk and nine strikeouts. On Sunday in the series finale, he threw four scoreless frames out of the bullpen. He combined to strike out 11 batters over nine innings of work with two hits and two walks allowed in his two appearances last week. Moreno has 28 strikeouts over 22 innings across his last four outings, with just three runs allowed.

**Mike Vasil to 2023 All-Star Futures Game:** Right-hander **Mike Vasil** was named to the 2023 All-Star Futures Game in Seattle during MLB's All-Star week. Vasil will be the lone Mets prospect in the game representing the Mets and National League. Vasil made 10 starts for Binghamton before being promoted to Triple-A Sryacuse on June 12. He held a 3.71 ERA with a 57-to-8 strikeout-to-walk ratio with the Ponies. Vasil was the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May. Former Ponies Francisco Álvarez and Mark Vientos were named to the All-Star Futures Game last year at Dodger Stadium and Álvarez and Brett Baty played in it in 2021 at Coors Field.

**Stellar Scott:** Ponies right-hander **Christian Scott** has been dominant for Binghamton. In his first two Double-A starts, Scott has combined for 17 strikeouts over 12.2 innings. He has allowed just three runs and three walks over that span. Scott has combined for 26 strikeouts in 17.2 innings over his past three starts overall. He is coming off a career-high 6.2 innings pitched at Akron last Wednesday. He holds a 47-to-6 strikeout-to-walk ratio this season across two levels.

**First Half Recap:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies went 35-34 over the first half of the season, finishing in fourth place in the Northeast Division and 7.5 games back from the first-half champion Somerset. In the first half, Matt Rudick finished top 10 in the Eastern League in four offensive categories: 1st in OBP (.435), 5th in BB (46), 6th in R (45), and 6th in OPS (.913). In the first half, Jose Peroza led the team in batting average (.294), RBIs (40), doubles (16) and tied for the team lead with Brandon McIlwain in hits (60). Among active Ponies batters, Peroza tied for the team lead with Matt Rudick with nine homers. Former Ponies pitchers Josh Walker and Grant Hartwig also made their major league debuts with the New York Mets so far this season. 13 former Binghamton players have appeared for the Mets this year.

**Last Start:** Coming off a career-high six innings and nine strikeouts in his Double-A debut against Portland, Scott set a new career high with 6.2 innings at Akron on Wednesday. He struck out eight batters over 6.2 innings and allowed two runs on four hits with two walks. In his first two Double-A starts, Scott has 17 strikeouts over 12.2 innings with just three runs and two walks allowed. Over his past three starts, Scott has 26 strikeouts over 17.2 innings and just three runs and three walks allowed.

**2022**: Scott made 18 appearances and nine starts across two levels at Class-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn. He held a 3.80 ERA in his five starts and six appearances for the Cyclones last season. Across the two levels, Scott held a 77-to-22 K-to-BB ratio.

BACKGROUND: Scott was drafted by the Mets in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Florida. Scott made four starts for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League this past fall, alongside Rumble Ponies outfielder Brandon McIlwain and pitcher Mike Vasil. He currently ranks as the Mets' No. 27 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. He totaled a 12-5 career record in 55 appearances and five starts with a 3.72 ERA, three saves, and 111 strikeouts across 121 innings pitched for the Gators across three seasons from 2019-2021. As a redshirt sophomore in 2021, Scott went made 26 appearances and one start going 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA and 51 strikeouts in 54 innings. He ranked in the top 10 in the SEC in appearances in 2021, leading the Gators. Led Calvary Christian Academy to the 2018 4A State Title in Floriday and was a First Team All-American selection by MaxPreps. Was a member of the USA Baseball 2016 17U National Team Development Program.

#### Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.
