Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Scott Moss** to the mound tonight, looking to pick up the pieces after last night's blowout loss. Louisville will counter with RHP **Riley O'Brien**. The Clippers are 2-1 (.667) against right handers this year. O'Brien will be making his Triple-A debut tonight.

vs. the Bats

Columbus was 13-11 and -7 in the run department against Louisville in 2019 (15-9 with a +6 differential in 2018; 12-13, +4 in 2017; 11-12, +12 in 2016). **Daniel Johnson** has hit .340/.414/.700 with 3HR and 11RBI in 13 games against the Bats in his career. **Bobby Bradley** has 3HR and 14RBI in 25G opposing the Bats, including a pair of bombs at Louisville Slugger Field.

Road to the Cup

The Clippers were far and away the best road team in the IL in 2019, posting a record of 49-24 (.671), including the playoffs (18-4-3 in road series, 9-0 in sweeps). They won eight straight road contests over the end of the season and the playoffs, clinching the Governors' Cup in Durham (ran win streak to 10 before last night). Louisville was the only team to beat the visiting Clippers more than three times.

Spent Early

Columbus opened the season with five runs on four hits through the first seven batters of 2021, but in 101 plate appearances since, the Clippers have hit just .165 (15x91) and managed to push across only three runs (22 scoreless innings since the opening frame of the opening game). Last night's shutout loss was the fifth in the last eight losses, including playoffs, dating to 8/24/19 (three to Louisville).

Nail Biters

Wednesday night's 1-run game was the first of the season for Columbus and, as has been their nature, the Clippers came away with the victory. The Clippers were 2nd in the IL with a .649 winning percentage in 1-run games last year (24-13), after pacing the circuit in 2018 (23-14, .622). The last time the Clippers had a losing record in single tally games was in 2014 (21-22, still won the IL West).

Hole in the Heart

Owen Miller was bumped to the 3rd spot in the order last night, following a 4x7 showing in his first two games batting 5th. He promptly turned in an 0x4, marking the third straight game that the 3rd and 4th hitters in the lineup have gone hitless. **Bradley Zimmer** (3AB) and **Oscar Mercado** (4AB) have also manned the 3-hole, while **Bobby Bradley** (13AB) has taken all of the at bats at cleanup.

Struggles Continue

In 43 games since getting optioned on 7/16/19, **Bobby Bradley** has hit .196/.297/.405 with just 9HR and 20RBI while posting a strikeout in 37% of his PA (68 of 182). Only 8RBI since the option are on non-HR and he has accumulated 72LOB in 43 games. In 43 games immediately prior to getting recalled (5/3-6/21/19), Bradley hit .310/.373/.732 with 21HR and 44RBI (32% strikeout rate, 59K in 185PA).

Back at It

Over his last 51G with Columbus, dating to 8/16/18, **Oscar Mercado** is hitting .300/.398/.463 with 4HR and 21RBI, after having hit .119 (5x42) through his first 14 games as a Clipper. His hot streak includes an 11G hit streak in early 2019 (4/11-4/25) that came immediately after an 0x10 series vs. Louisville (4/8-4/10). He has been successful in 76% of his steal attempts in that time (19 of 25).

Quick Feet

The Clippers have swiped a bag in each of the first three games, totalling 4SB in as many chances, putting them on pace for 160SB in this shortened season. In 2019, they hit triple digits in steals (104) for the first time since 2013 (have increased steal total each year since 2016). Unfortunately, only one thief (**Bradley Zimmer**) has come around to score after improving his station on the basepaths.

Shutting It Down

The Clipper bullpen has yet to allow a run in the final third of a ballgame, allowing only four batters to reach base (walk, hit by pitch, single, double; only two of those batters have made it to second base). In the 9th inning, **Blake Parker** and **DJ Johnson** have sent the Bats down in order, registering 5K between the two (opposing hitters have 11K and a GDP in innings 7-9).

This Date in Clipper History

5/7/1979

Bobby Brown, a native of Norfolk, VA, went 3x5 with a home run and 3RBI to lead the Clippers to a 9-5 win over his hometown team, the Tidewater Tides. Brown went on to win the International League MVP that season, the first of eight MVPs for the Columbus Clippers. Since the Clippers began play in 1977, they have tallied the most MVPs in the league, two ahead of 2nd place Norfolk (Tidewater).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game, totaling 2.25 per contest (1,763HR, 783 games). Last year, HP averaged over three per game for the first time ever (seventh time averaging over a pair), as the Clippers surrendered a record 127HR and just missed out on triple digits themselves (97HR was second highest team total). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (923 to 894).

Record Destruction

The Clippers broke the established mark for homers in a season (182 in 1983) on 8/7/19 and finished with a total of 213 (most in the IL). From 5/14-6/2, they homered in 20 straight games (44HR total) and they had seven straight multi-HR games from 6/14-6/21 (22HR). On the mound, they broke the record for homers allowed (156 in 1998) on 7/31/19, giving up 198 for the year (2nd most in the IL).

Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

Since the start of the 2014 season, no team has had more come from behind victories than the 210 posted by Columbus (35 last season) and no team has produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .353 of the Clippers (Scranton/WB ranks 2nd in win percentage at .338 and wins, 192).

Walk-Off Magic

Columbus was 5-2 in walk-off games last season, winning four thanks to the courtesy runner in extra innings (Columbus pitching did not allow a run through first 9.0IP in extras last year). On 6/29/19 at Louisville, they suffered their first walk-off loss of the year, snapping an 81 game streak without (previous loss was 5/31/18 at Buffalo). Additionally, the Clippers ranked 1st in the IL with a 16-8 (.667) record in games decided in the last at bat.

Trending Downward

While ranking in the top three of the IL with a 4.71ERA (3rd), the 2019 Clippers registered their worst mark since the 1998 season (4.85ERA). In 2018, they ranked dead last in the IL with a 4.34ERA, marking the third straight (now fourth) season that the team ERA had gotten worse. From 2011-16, the Clipper staff turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times in six seasons (zero such seasons from 1993-2010), including the best two ERAs of the past 30 years (3.33 in 2015 and 3.65 in 2016).

Doing Damage

In 2019, the Clippers ranked tied for 5th in the IL with 112RBI with the bases loaded, while carrying a .252 average (10th, 36x143, 4HR). In both 2017 and 2018, the Clippers led the IL in RBI with the bases loaded (243RBI total) and paced the circuit in grand slams (16 total, no other team had more than eight).

Free Swingers

After two straight seasons leading the IL in strikeouts, the Clipper lineup was atop the IL again in 2019 (1,392K, 60 more than 2nd place). They obliterated the franchise record (1,297, set in 2017; 2018's total of 1,290 was 2nd worst in franchise history), passing it on 8/22/19 (reduced strikeout rate to 8.3 per game after setting record, 10.1 prior). On the season a Clipper was punched out at least four times in a game on 15 occasions (**Eric Haase** led the team with three golden sombreros).

That's More Like It

In 2019, the Clippers were 50-30 (.625) when playing errorless baseball, while turning in a 31-29 (.517) mark with at least one error. Contrary to logic, in 2018 they actually had a worse winning percentage when playing mistake free (.514), than when committing at least one error (.530). The Clipper defense finished 1st in 2019 (.983) after falling to 6th in the IL in 2018, ending a run of three consecutive seasons ranked among the top three (2015-17 resulted in the three best seasons in franchise history).

One On, No Out Success

When the leadoff batter of an inning reached base in 2019, the Clippers plated him nearly 60% of the time (over 51% only once in the last six seasons, 55% in 2016). Getting more than one base was a specialty of Clipper hitters, as they led the IL with 136XBH to lead off the inning, including 54HR (led the IL, had 28 leadoff homers in 2018). From 4/13-4/20/19, the Clippers hit 16 leadoff doubles over 72 innings, including four straight innings in a win at Louisville on 4/15/19.

Good Baseball

Bradley Zimmer advanced a runner with a sac bunt on 8/29/19 at Louisville and he came around to score in the win. During 2019, the Clippers struggled in the bunt department (12 successes), but when the advanced runners did score, they were 7-1. During 2018, Columbus was 23-2 in games in which a run was scored after a good bunt attempt (54 successes; won 17 in a row from 4/12-7/31/18).

International Accolades

Bobby Bradley was named International League Player of the Month for May 2019, reaching base in 24 of 25 games during the month while hitting .302/.374/.740 with 12HR (led IL) and 28RBI. **Brandon Barnes**, **Eric Haase**, **Josh Smith** and **Asher Wojciechowski** were named to the 2019 IL All-Star Team and Bradley, Barnes and Haase were selected to the postseason squad.

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy makes his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's second year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 32-47 (.405), 2-1 with Columbus (.667).

Trade Worthy:

Although dwarfed by names like **Trevor Bauer**, **Yasiel Puig**, **Franmil Reyes** and **Taylor Trammell**, Moss showed why he was included in the 7/31/19 deal among Cleveland Cincinnati and San Diego, turning in a 1.46ERA (24.2IP, 4ER) after joining the Cleveland organization. During his week in the Eastern League, Moss was the only pitcher to record more than 7.0IP with 0ER and he ranked tied for 3rd in the league with 13K. He then made four starts in the IL and did not allow more than 2ER in any of them (two scoreless appearances, including 5.0IP win vs. Louisville on 8/22/19).

Southern League All-Star:

Prior to getting traded, Moss had pitched the entire season with Chattanooga in the Southern League, earning his second career All-Star selection (2017 with Dayton, Midwest League). Moss made 20 starts and at the time of the trade was one of 13 SL pitchers with at least 100.0IP. His 123K ranked 3rd in the circuit, as did his 57BB.

Hot Steaks:

After a rough start to the 2019 season (17.0IP, 12ER), Moss turned in consecutive scoreless outings, including a no-hit bid on 5/6/19 vs. Tennessee (6.0IP, lost by **Joe Manti** with two out in the 7th; held opponents hitless for 8.0IP from 5/1-5/6/19). Additionally, Moss struck out 10 Smokies on 5/6/19, his fourth career game with double-digit strikeouts. Combined between Chattanooga, Akron and Columbus, Moss has a 1.75ERA (36.0IP, 7ER) over his last seven starts.

Not Hot Steaks:

Moss started the 2019 season with multiple walks in each of his first eight starts, averaging 7.82BB/9IP (38.0IP, 33BB). That included a career-worst 6BB in his season debut, vs. Montgomery on 4/6/19 (4.0IP; since tied with 6BB in 4.2IP vs. Mobile on 6/2/19). Also, the last Moss victory with the Lookouts, on 7/4/19 vs. Jacksonville, was the last win for Chattanooga until 7/22/19, as the team suffered a 14 game losing streak (lost 20 of 22 from 7/5-7/29/19).
