SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 6-4, for their fifth win in the six-game series. The Senators took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning, but the Flying Squirrels responded with five runs in the bottom of the frame. Andy Thomas hit an RBI single, Victor Bericoto brought in a run with a groundout and Logan Wyatt hit a three-run homer. The Senators closed the score to 5-2 in the fourth with an RBI groundout by Frankie Tostado. Bericoto singled home a run in the bottom of the fifth to open a 6-2 lead. Trey Lipscomb hit a two-run homer in the seventh to pull the Senators within two runs. Sam Delaplane and Evan Gates held the Senators off the board over the final 2.1 innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the first of a six-game road series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series marks the second time these two teams have faced off this season. They met at The Diamond from July 25-30, with Richmond winning five-of-six. Richmond is 4-1 in their last five series openers.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 32-20 in their last 52 games since June 18. They went 5-1 in this week's series at home against the Senators and have won four consecutive games. Over the last 57 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.93 ERA (70 ER/215.1 IP) with 254 strikeouts. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.78 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 416.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 570.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.63 ERA, which is the third-lowest in Double-A and the 11th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE SEA DIGS entered their series at The Diamond on July 25 with the best record in the Eastern League and led the Northeast Division in the second-half standings. Since then, they have gone 7-17, the worst record in the league in that span. The Sea Dogs split last week's six-game series in Binghamton but lost three-of-the-last-four. Portland's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including SS Marcelo Mayer (No. 1, No. 15 overall), 2B Nick Yorke (No. 5), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 8), C Nathan Hickey (No. 10), SS Brainer Bonaci (No. 11), 2B Chase Meidroth (No. 14), 1B Blaze Jordan (No. 15) and RHP Hunter Dobbins (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospect list includes seven Portland players, including Mayer (No. 1, No. 11 overall), Yorke (No. 6), Gonzalez (No. 9), Bonaci (No. 11), Jordan (No. 12), Hickey (No. 15) and Meidroth (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his seventh Double-A start and his second against the Sea Dogs. He last pitched on Wednesday against the Senators and was charged with a loss after allowing three runs (two earned) over five innings with five strikeouts. He previously pitched against Portland on July 29 at The Diamond and surrendered three runs (two earned) in five innings in a no-decision. In his last three starts, since August 4, Bertrand has a 1.80 ERA (3 ER/15.0 IP/13 SO/5 BB). He has allowed two-or-less earned runs in five-of-his-six Double-A starts. During his time with the High-A Eugene Emeralds from May 9-July 13, Bertrand led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.95) and BAA (.196), held the second-best ERA (2.92), was second in wins (5) and ranked fourth in innings pitched (49.1). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five relief appearances. Bertrand pitched three seasons at Furman before spending his final two seasons at Notre Dame. Last year, he was an All-American with the Irish before being selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Hunter Dobbins makes his eighth Double-A start and his second against Richmond. Last time out, Dobbins threw a Double-A-high seven innings and allowed one run with eight strikeouts in a win at Binghamton on Wednesday. In his previous three starts from July 27 through August 10, Dobbins went 0-3 with a 9.98 ERA (17 ER/15.1 IP). He faced Richmond on July 27 at The Diamond and allowed five runs (four earned) in five innings of work. Dobbins was selected in the eighth round of Leven Section 19 by the Red Sox out of Texas Tech. He made his professional debut last year with Low-A Salem, going 0-5 with a 5.22 ERA in 17 starts. Dobbins began this season with High-A Greenville and went 4-1 with a 2.63 ERA in seven starts before being promoted to Double-A on June 23.

**STARTING STRONG:** Flying Squirrels starters have a 2.37 ERA (18 ER/68.1 IP) over the last 17 games since August 2. In that stretch, **Carson Seymour** is 1-0 with a 1.90 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP), **Spencer Bivens** has a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) and **John Michael Bertrand** has a 1.80 ERA (3 ER/15.0 IP). **Wil Jensen** also threw four scoreless innings in his start on August 10.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 24 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are tied for first place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, even with the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half. Bowie is in third, one game back. Harrisburg is four games back in fourth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 51 times in his last 24 games since July 25 (27 hits, 23 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .346 (27-for-78) with five homers, five doubles, two triples and 21 RBIs adding a .490 on-base percentage. In last week's series against the Senators, Matheny hit .412 (7-for-17) with three homers, one double, nine RBIs and three walks. Last Tuesday night against the Senators, Matheny homered twice, a three-run shot in and a solo home run, and added a double in a three-hit, four-RBI performance. It was the third two-homer game of his Richmond career, joining performances on May 1, 2022 against Bowie and May 12, 2022 at Harrisburg. On Thursday, he entered off the bench and collected a pinch-hit, RBI single in the seventh. On Saturday, he hit a three-run homer and added a sac fly, his second four-RBI game of the series. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 131 walks, ahead of Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last five games, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .353 (6-for-17) with a double and four RBIs. He went 2-for-4 last Thursday, including a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback in the last inning, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. On Friday, Bericoto had a single and a sacrifice fly. He drove in two runs in Sunday's 6-4 win. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 19 homers (16 with Eugene and three with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 67 RBIs.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt hit a three-run homer on Sunday afternoon, his 13th home runs this year between Richmond and Eugene, which is tied for the sixth-most in the Giants organization this year. Over his last five games since August 15, Wyatt is batting .333 (6-for-18) with a homer, a double, a walk and five RBIs. He has three multi-hit games in his last six games played.

ROBUST: On Saturday, Sean Roby hit his first Double-A homer of the year. It was the 26th of his Richmond career, which is the fifth-most in franchise history. Last year, Roby set a single-season franchise record with 25 home runs in his 89 games. Roby also holds the franchise record for the most home runs at The Diamond with 22. This year, Roby missed the start of the season with an injury. He played 19 games on a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League before playing 22 games with the High-A Eugene Emeralds. On the year between the three levels, Roby has 13 home runs, which is tied for the sixth-most in the Giants system.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
