OFF TO SUGAR LAND

The Round Rock Express dropped its series to the Oklahoma City Baseball Club, four games to two, after a 14-5 loss on Sunday afternoon at Dell Diamond, Oklahoma City RF Andy Pages hit a solo home run in the top of the first inning before a bases-loaded walk scored CF Drew Avans in the third for a 2-0 lead. The Baseball Club put up a big inning for the second straight game, scoring eight runs in the fifth to make it a 10-0 game. Both teams put one run on the board during the sixth inning to make it an 11-1 game. Oklahoma City kept things going at the plate when LF Ryan Ward launched a three-run home run in the seventh inning. The shot to left field made it a 14-1 contest. The Express put two more runs on the board in the eighth inning as RF Trevor Hauver blasted his first home run of the season and brought DH Sam Huff, who had knocked a single, home with him. Another two-run blast from Round Rock made it 14-5 in the ninth inning. C Matt Whatley hit a 427-foot longball to score 2B Jax Biggers, who had reached base on a walk. The next three batters were retired by Oklahoma City LHP Drew Pomeranz to hold the 14-5 score final

Express RHP Florencio Serrano is scheduled to make his Triple-A debut with a start on Tuesday. The 24-year-old was promoted from Double-A Frisco on Tuesday. The righty owns a 4.29 ERA (74 ER/155.1 IP) with 136 strikeouts in 59 games and 14 starts in his minor league career. This season, he has posted a 1.80 ERA (1 ER/5.0 IP) with four strikeouts and a WHIP of 1.00 in two games out of the High-A Hickory and Double-A Frisco bullpen.

BIG LEAGUER IN THE LINEUP

Texas Rangers INF Nathaniel Lowe had his Major League rehab assignment transferred to Round Rock on Tuesday. The first baseman played three rehab games with Double-A Frisco, hitting .111 (1-9), with his lone hit being a two-run home run. Lowe is expected to hit second on Tuesday night.

MORE NEW FACES

Round Rock welcomed three more faces to the clubhouse on Tuesday. In addition to Serrano, RHP Damian Mendoza was promoted from Rookielevel ACL Rangers and RHP Yerry Rodríguez was optioned to Round Rock. Mendoza, 23, signed a minor league contract with Texas in 2017. Since 2018, Mendoza has posted a 20-11 record, with a 4.15 ERA (119 ER/258.0 IP) and 243 strikeouts in 100 games and 22 starts. His highest level of minor league action came in 2022 when he pitched in one game for High-A Hickory. Rodríguez has been in the organization since 2015 and holds a career minor league record of 28-13 with a 3.51 ERA (149 ER/382.1 IP) in 157 games and 55 starts. Rodriguez returns to Round Rock, where he has pitched in 100 games across three seasons.

TEXAS-SIZED RUN

Round Rock is 12-1 against Sugar Land dating back to last July. Sugar Land's only victory came in the 2024 season opener as they defeated Round Rock, 4-2. The E-Train is outscoring the Space Cowboys 92-44 during this 13-game stretch.

The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped

the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.


