## RIDERS OUTLAST MISSIONS IN EXTRA INNINGS TO OPEN SERIES:

The Frisco RoughRiders used late offense to best the San Antonio Missions 4-2 in 10 innings on Tuesday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. Pitching dominated early from San Antonio as both teams went scoreless through the first six innings. Frisco (17-11, 61-36) starter **Ben Anderson** tossed the first six innings, allowing just two hits while striking out six and walking one in a no-decision. The Riders found the scoreboard first in the top of the seventh when **Josh Hatcher** plated **Keyber Rodriguez** on a sacrifice fly to make it 1-0. Frisco then added in the eighth with another sacrifice fly, this time from **Maximo Acosta**, to push the lead to 2-0, but the Missions (14-13, 45-50) came back to tie the game on a two-run home runs from Ray-Patrick Didder in the bottom of the eighth inning. In the top of the tenth, Frisco scored the first extra-innings run on an RBI fielder's choice, plating **Cody Freeman** from third on a ground ball to second off the bat of **Abimelec Ortiz** to give the Riders a 3-2 lead against Ethan Routzahn (4-2). **Cooper Johnson** then delivered an RBI single to pad the lead. Frisco turned to **Seth Clark** in the bottom of 10th, who struck out two in a 1-2-3 inning to earn his third save of the season. Clark was one of three Riders relievers (**Skylar Hales** and **Robby Ahlstrom**) who threw scoreless innings. Offensively, Frisco was led by three-hit games from Rodriguez and Hatcher while **Alejandro Osuna** contributed two hits of his own.

## ABIMELE-LECTRIC:

Riders slugger **Abimelec Ortiz** has been crushing the baseball recently. While he is hitting well over his last 13 games, batting .353 (18-for-51)/.411/.608/1.019 with four doubles, three home runs, eight RBIs and nine runs scored, the success goes back even further. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting just .176/.241/.309/.550, but has hammered the ball in 24 games since, batting .305/.389/.488/.877. He has raised his average 42 points (.213), his slugging percentage 51 points (.360) and his OPS 95 points (.645) in the last 24 games.

## MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders face their division opponents for the third time this season, but the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2023, Frisco went 13-11 against San Antonio and have gone 53-26 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021, including 30-8 at the Wolff. In the 13 games, in which they are 12-1, they have a 2.61 team ERA, outscoring the Missions 58-33. **Josh Hatcher** has driven in 12 runs over his 11 games against the Missions, hitting .366 with an .879 OPS.

## HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-15 at Riders Field this season. Their 35 wins and .700 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +74 run differential, a 3.73 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .761 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 26-21 with a 3.37 ERA, but a +19 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .634 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing .339/.398/.594/.992 at home this season with nine of his 12 home runs. His .339 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

## OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

**Alejandro Osuna** has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 22 games, he is hitting .317 (26-for-82)/.418/.573/.991 with eight doubles, two triples, three home runs and 14 RBIs. Over his last 19 games, he is batting .333 (23-for-69)/.447/.609/1.056 with six doubles, two triples, three home runs and 14 RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with three doubles and a .955 OPS for the Riders.

## THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.08 ERA, which is also the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.56), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .229 BAA is on pace to be the second-best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

## WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

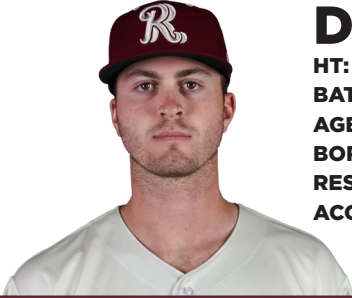

### ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schries College Classic on March 1st against No. 11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

### 2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 28 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In first start at Wichita on Opening Day, threw 3.2 no-hit innings before allowing his first hit. Finished with 4.2 innings, allowing just one run in a 6-4 Riders win.

-Pitched first two quality starts in MiLB career on 6/15 and 6/22. On 6/22, he went 5.0 scoreless before allowing three runs in the sixth.

### 2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

-Made best start of MiLB career on August 30th against CC with 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 8 K.

### 2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

### 2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Kris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
