Kayfus, has been in a strong rhythm at the plate recently. The 2023 third-round pick is currently on six- game hitting and RBI streaks, and his RBI streak is tied for the longest active streak in the Midwest League. During this span, Kayfus is hitting 11-for-24 (458) with 3 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, 1 walk, 2 stolen bases, and a 1.272 OPS. Kayfus' four hits on Saturday night were a season-high.
				LIKE MAICK: After going 2-for-5 with a solo home run and a run scored on Saturday night, Lake County INF Maick Collado has now reached base in 16 of his 3 plate appearances so far this season, giving him a .500 OBP. Collado is just the third Captains hitter since 2005 to post a .500-or-higher OBP with 30-or-more plate appearances, joining Bo Greenwell (2010, .525 OBP, 60 PA) and LeVon Washington (2012, .563 OBP, 60 PA).

LAST TIME OUT: Trenton Denholm makes his second start of the series on four days rest against Lansing. In the series opener against the Lugnuts on Tuesday, Denholm (ND) threw the first quality start by a Captains pitcher in 2024 (6-or-more innings, 3-or-less earned runs), and did not record a decision. The right-hander went 6 innings, allowing 4 hits, 2 earned runs, and no walks, while throwing 7 strikeouts in 80 pitches (61 strikes). Denholm's two earned runs were allowed on a pair of solo home runs in the fifth and sixth innings.

IN THE ZONE: Denholm and Cedar Rapids RHP Zebby Matthews are the only pitchers in the Midwest League to not walk a batter in 10+ innings. The Lake County right-hander's 11.00 K/BB ratio ranks eighth among Midwest League pitchers with 10+ innings pitched. In two starts, **Denholm** has thrown 109 of his 152 pitches for strikes (71.7%).

AGAINST LANSING IN '23: Denholm made 3 appearances (2 starts) against the Lugnuts last season, going 0-0 with a 1.93 ERA and 1.14 WHIP. The right-hander allowed 14 hits, 5 runs (3 earned), 2 home runs, and 2 walks, while throwing 10 strikeouts in 14 innings of work.

CAPTAIN ON THE MOUND: In 2023, **Denholm** played a versatile role in his first season with Lake County's pitching staff. The right-hander made 23 appearances (six starts), recording 3 wins and 3 saves in 5 opportunities out of the Captains' bullpen. He was also very efficient on the mound last year, tallying 67 strikeouts to just 18 walks, and compiling a 1.14 WHIP.

HILLCAT ON THE HILL: Denholm pitched his first professional season in 2022, making 23 starts for the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. The right-hander finished the season with a 5-5 record, 4.79 ERA, and 107 strikeouts in 97.2 innings pitched.

AWESOME ANTEATER: Denholm had a strong collegiate career in his four seasons at UC Irvine. As a sophomore in 2019, the right-hander was named the 2019 Big West Pitcher of the Year, as well as a *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper* 3rd Team All-American, after finishing the campaign with a 9-4 record, 1.81 ERA, and 93 strikeouts in 99.2 innings pitched. This season resulted in **Denholm** being invited to the USA Collegiate National Team training camp, and being named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List prior to both the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

BASEBALL IN THE FAMILY: Denholm is related to former MLB catcher Rod Barajas. He played 14 MLB seasons with seven different teams, notably winning a World Series with the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks. Barajas hit .235 in his MLB career, with 812 hits, 136 home runs, 480 RBI, and 187 doubles.
